



Severe Thunderstorms Today in the Southern Plains; Critical Fire Weather in the Southern Rockies and High Plains

Severe thunderstorms capable of large hail, strong/damaging wind gusts, and a couple of tornadoes are possible across parts of the southern Great Plains this afternoon and evening. 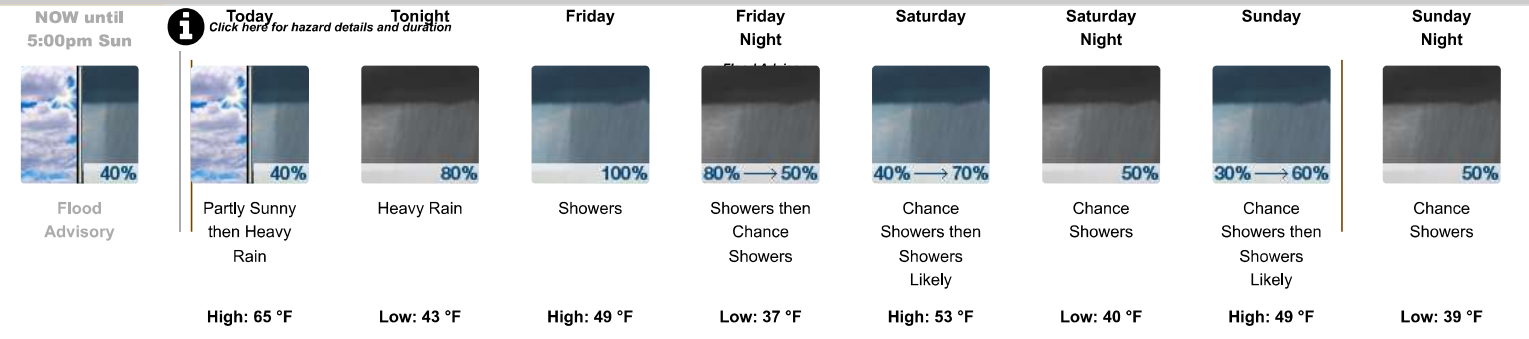

Detailed Forecast

Today
 Scattered showers and thunderstorms after noon. Some of the storms could produce gusty winds and heavy rain. Mostly cloudy, with a high near 65. South southeast wind 5 to 7 mph becoming east northeast in the afternoon. Winds could gust as high as 39 mph. Chance of precipitation is 40%.

Tonight
 Showers likely and possibly a thunderstorm, then showers after midnight. Some of the storms could produce gusty winds and heavy rain. Low around 43. Northeast wind 6 to 8 mph becoming south southeast after midnight. Winds could gust as high as 37 mph. Chance of precipitation is 80%.

Friday
 Showers. High near 49. South southeast wind 7 to 13 mph, with gusts as high as 28 mph. Chance of precipitation is 100%. New precipitation amounts between a quarter and half of an inch possible.

Friday Night
 Showers, mainly before midnight. Low around 37. Southwest wind 8 to 13 mph becoming light after midnight. Chance of precipitation is 80%. New precipitation amounts between a tenth and quarter of an inch possible.

Saturday
 Showers likely, mainly after noon. Mostly cloudy, with a high near 53. Light and variable wind. Chance of precipitation is 70%.

Saturday Night
 A 50 percent chance of showers. Mostly cloudy, with a low around 40.

Sunday
 A chance of showers, then showers likely and possibly a thunderstorm after noon. Partly sunny, with a high near 49. Chance of precipitation is 60%. New rainfall amounts between a tenth and quarter of an inch, except higher amounts possible in thunderstorms.

Sunday Night
 A 50 percent chance of showers. Mostly cloudy, with a low around 39.

Monday
 A chance of showers, then showers likely and possibly a thunderstorm after noon. Mostly cloudy, with a high near 50. Chance of precipitation is 70%.

Monday Night
 A 50 percent chance of showers. Mostly cloudy, with a low around 38.

Tuesday
 A 50 percent chance of showers. Partly sunny, with a high near 52.



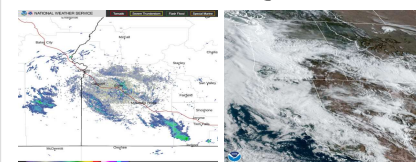
