MIDDLETON FIRE DISTRICT

MIDDLETON RURAL FIRE DISTRICT CANYON AND GEM COUNTIES, IDAHO PERMANENT TAX LEVY OVERRIDE

Shall the Board of Commissioners of the Middleton Rural Fire District be authorized and empowered to permanently increase its annual property tax budget and levy beyond the amount the District is currently authorized to levy pursuant to Idaho Code § 63-802, by the sum of two million two hundred twenty five thousand dollars (\$2,225,000), commencing Districts Fiscal Year 2025, and which amount shall then be added to the Districts current established base budget amount for the purposes of Idaho Code § 63-802.

The purpose of this tax increase is to defray its costs of staffing, equipping, and maintaining the Districts operations to provide protection of property against fire and the preservation of life, throughout the Fire District.

STATEMENT: The levy will be used to fund District operations and will be a tax increase of approximately \$65.84 per \$100,000 of taxable assessed value, per year, based upon current conditions.
