# Frequently Asked Questions – Answers

## Is JAG a Landfill or Transfer Station?

JAG is considered both. Most of our waste is transferred to Clay Peak Landfill in Payette County, We bury sheetrock, concrete and asphalt shingles. Brush is burned in fall and winter.

## Why do we need to be stopped and weighed?

The weight of all waste needs to be reported to Southwest District Health Department.

## What is considered household trash?

Household trash is your kitchen garbage waste.

## What don't you accept?

Hazardous waste, tractor tires, semi (truck) tires. No campers, boats or trailers.

## Why do I need to separate my lumber?

Processed wood is treated and needs to be hauled to Payette County.

## Why do I need to put grass clippings in the barn and not with brush?

Many people treat their lawn with chemicals so we need to haul to Payette County.

## What does JAG recycle?

Newspapers, aluminum cans, metal, cardboard.
