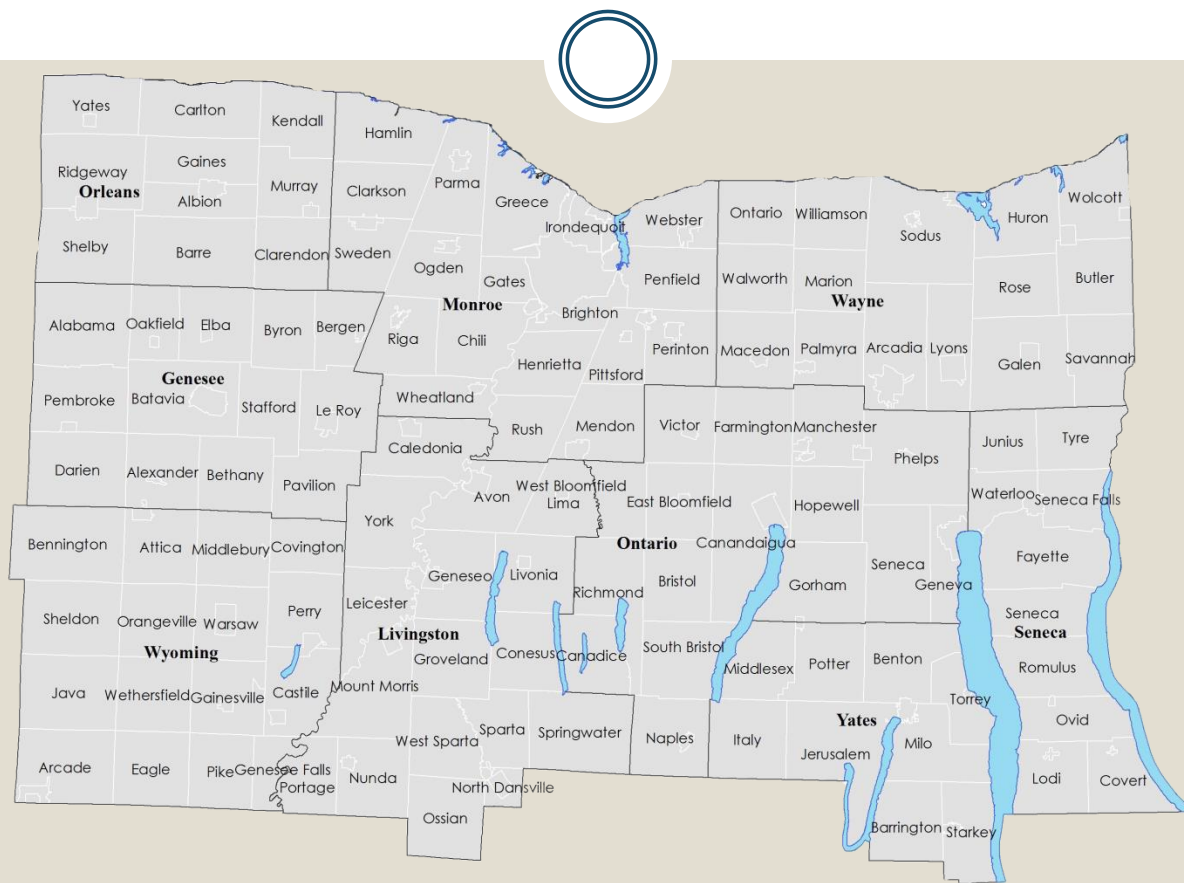

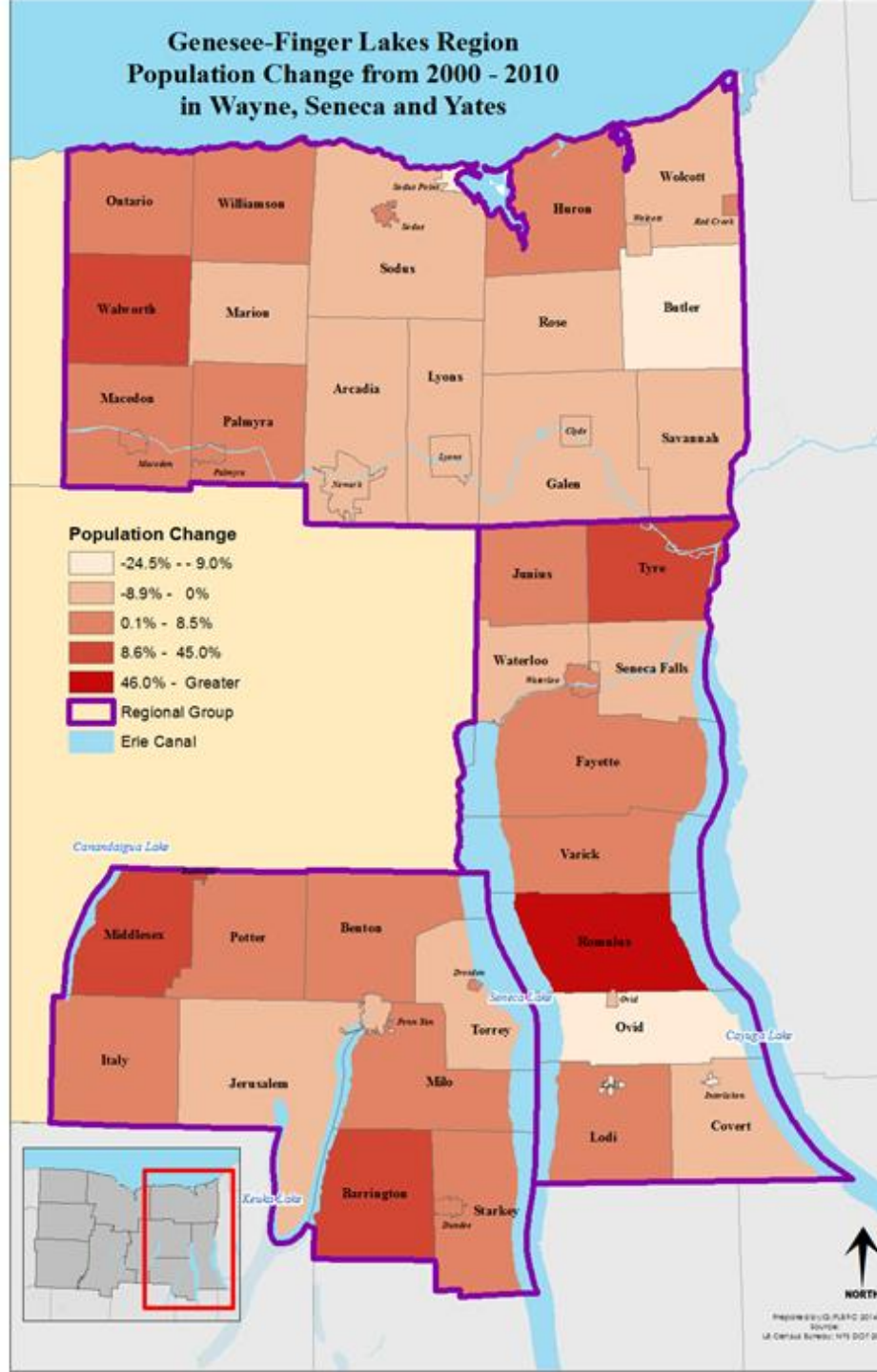
- Individual county meetings held with stakeholders from each of the nine counties

- Comments and feedback will help development of final county strategies



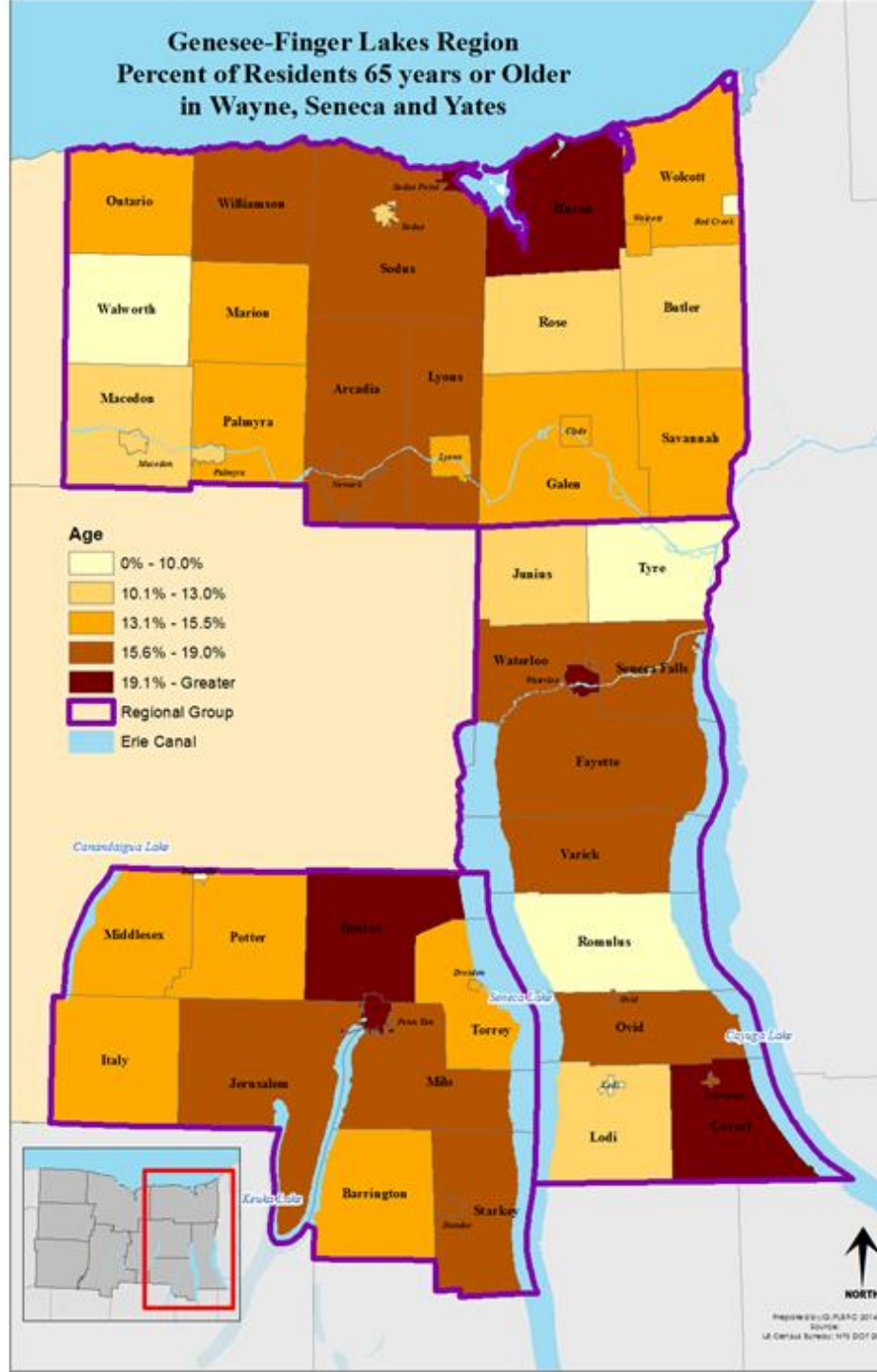

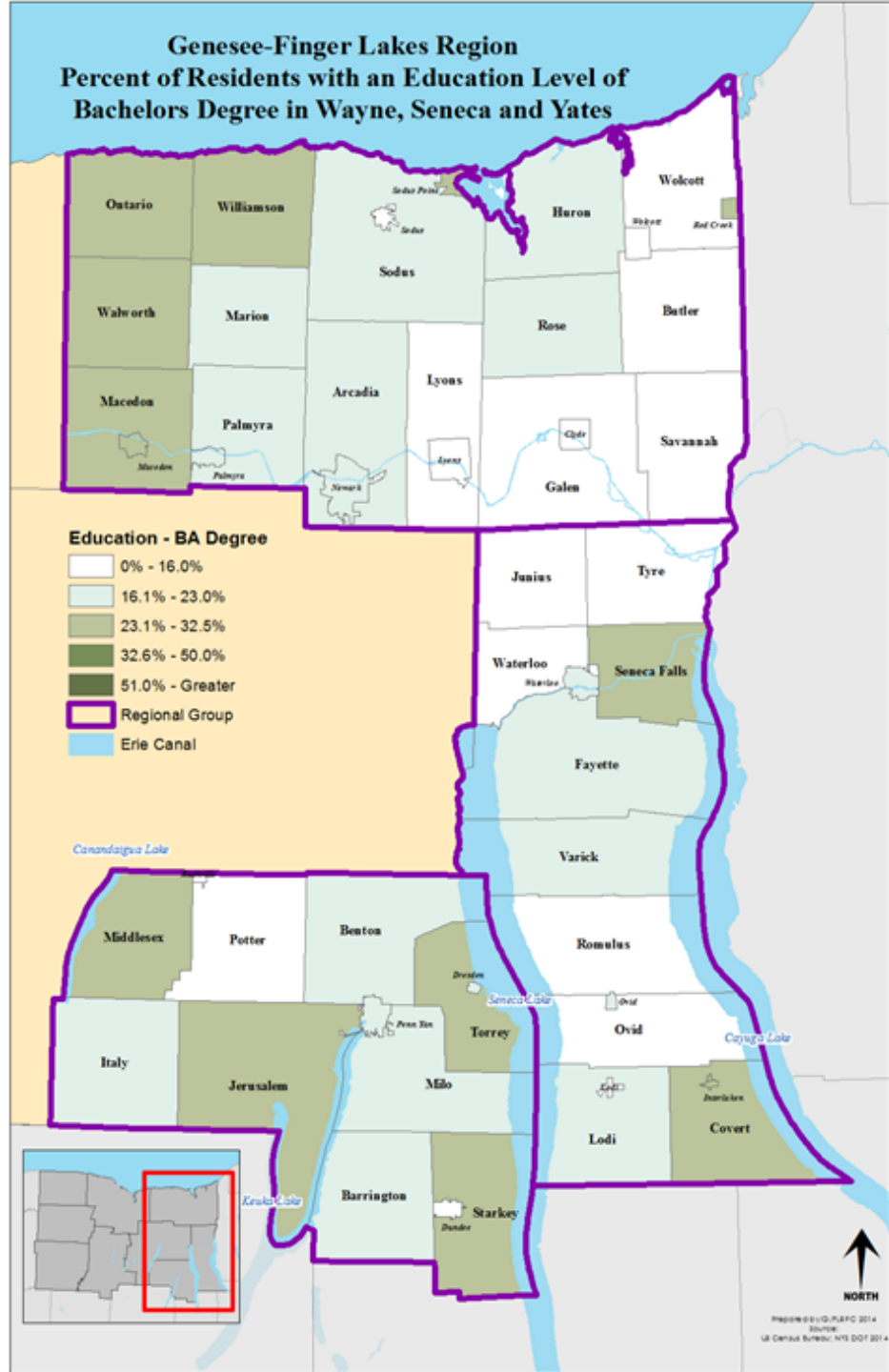

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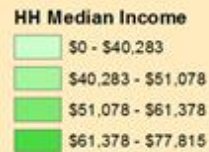
Genesee-Finger Lakes Region Percent of Residents 65 years or Older in Wayne, Seneca and Yates



Genesee-Finger Lakes Region Percent of Residents with an Education Level of Bachelors Degree in Wayne, Seneca and Yates



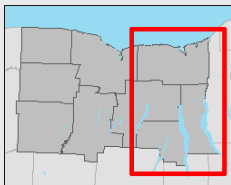
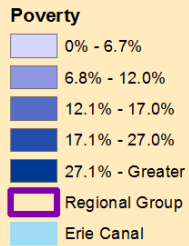
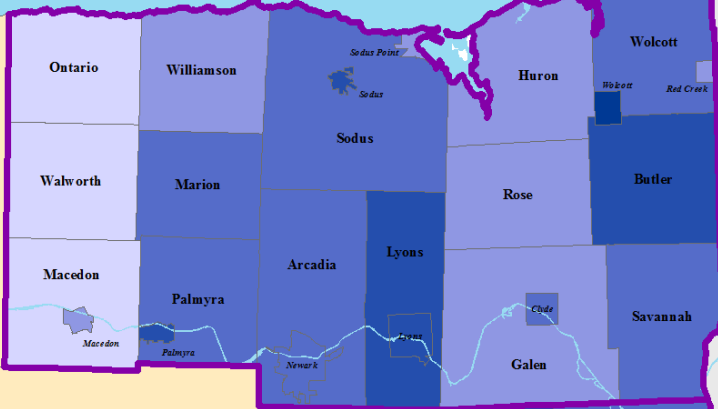
Genesee-Finger Lakes Region Household Median Income in Wayne, Seneca and Yates



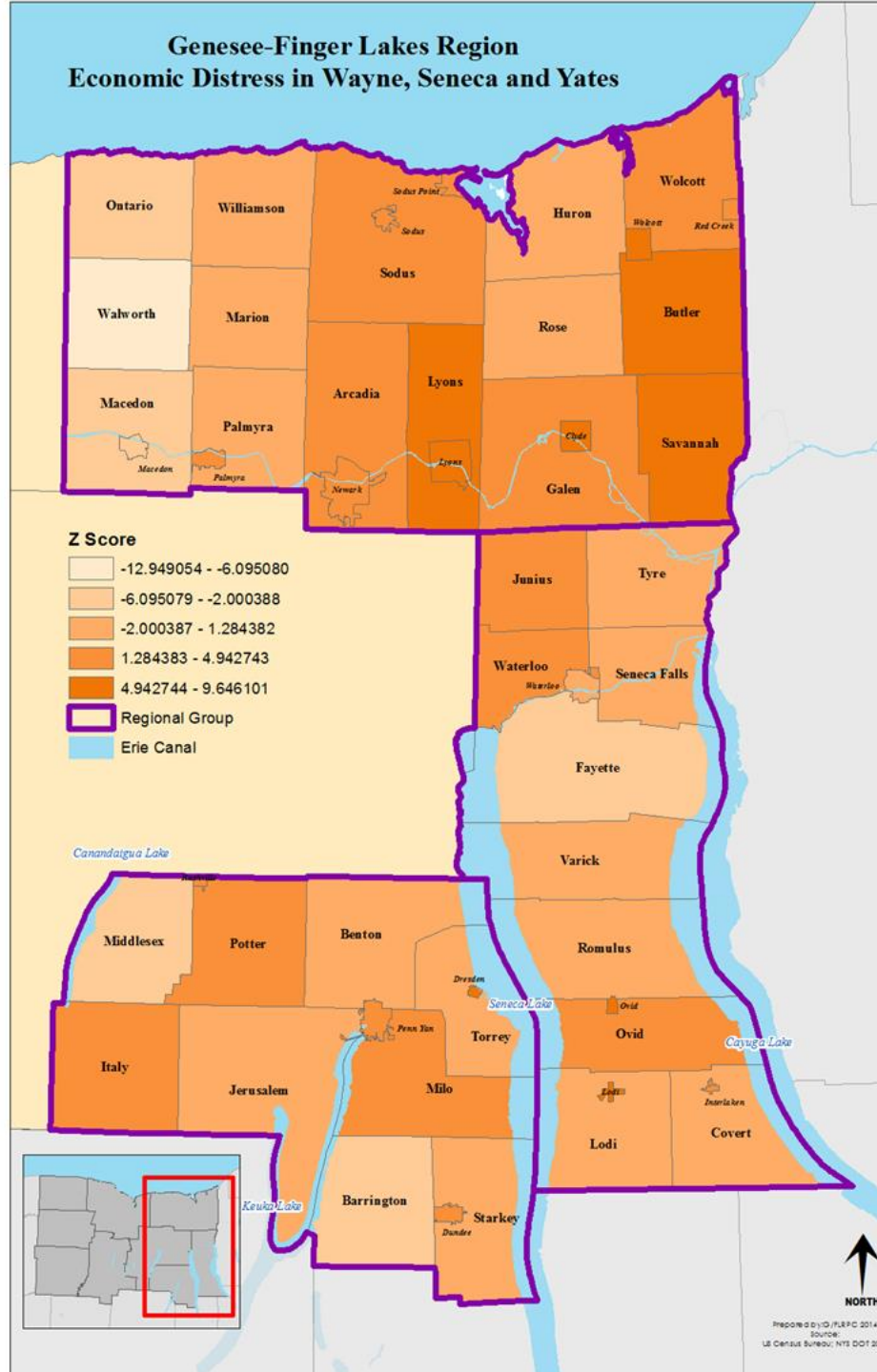
Canandaigua Lake
