

Regional Land Use Monitoring Report (2008)

UPWP Task #4220

Executive Summary

Project Purpose:

The Genesee Transportation Council (GTC) provides funding annually for the *Regional Land Use Monitoring Report* under its Unified Planning Work Program. This report provides information on the issuance of building permits in 2008 to identify areas of growth within the Genesee-Finger Lakes Region (G-FL Region) that might require transportation planning and service modifications.

The G-FL Region is comprised of Genesee, Livingston, Monroe, Ontario, Orleans, Seneca, Wayne, Wyoming, and Yates Counties. The report analyzes the number of permits issued, total square footage, and total value for buildings for each municipality within the region as well as the Transportation Management Area (TMA). The TMA covers Monroe County and the municipalities adjacent to Monroe County in Livingston, Ontario, and Wayne Counties, as well as the Town and City of Canandaigua. The analysis looks at the following categories and respective subcategories: “residential” (single-family, two-family, three or four-family, five-or- more family, mobile/manufactured homes); “industrial;” “commercial” (offices/banks, retail/service, service stations, hotels/motels); “community service” (hospitals/health facilities, schools/churches, public works/safety, utilities); and “not elsewhere classified.”

A three-year trend analysis is provided for permitted residential units in all nine counties; industrial, commercial, and community service building permits are analyzed over the three-year period as well. In addition, a time series (or historical trend) analysis is provided for residential, industrial, and commercial development, as well as subdivision approvals in the Transportation Management Area (TMA).

This year’s LUMR survey included additional questions for municipalities to provide further insight to the data inventory of each municipality. The questions related to historical building permit data, permit data by location and year, total count units, and zoning.

Project Methodology:

The building permit data included in this report was collected through surveys sent to the municipal or county officials responsible for the collection and dissemination of such data in the nine counties. In six counties, these officials were, in most municipalities, the code or zoning enforcement officers. In some cases they were municipal clerks. In Seneca and Wyoming Counties building permit application approval and inspection are the responsibility of the respective county building departments. Those two departments provided the data for their counties. The Monroe County Planning and Development Department’s Division of Planning administered the surveys, received the responses from municipal officials in the County, and forwarded the data to the Genesee/Finger Lakes Regional Planning Council.

Surveys were distributed in January of 2009 asking for the requested data. The initial survey was followed up with a reminder postcard along with a telephone reminder to those municipalities that had yet to respond. In some cases, several calls were made to the appropriate parties in an effort to acquire the requested information. Complete data was collected for all 192 municipalities in the nine-county G-FL Region.

Analysis Overview:

The highest number of residential permits in the G-FL Region in 2008 was in the Towns of Penfield, Greece, Henrietta, Victor and Webster. The Town of Penfield issued 135 residential building permits. The Town of Greece issued 121 permits totaling the largest number of units (142). The Town of Henrietta issued 117 permits. The Town of Victor issued 114 permits and the Town of Webster issued 96 permits. The highest number of residential permits issued by municipalities outside of Monroe County (except for the Town of Victor) were the Towns of Canandaigua and Farmington in Ontario County issuing 89 and 72 permits respectively, and in the Towns of Macedon and Ontario in Wayne County issuing 42 and 27 respectively. It is important to note however, that while these towns have had a large number of residential permits issued in the past two to three years, their total number of permits (as well as units permitted) have fluctuated during this same period. This general pattern is also apparent in other municipalities such as in the Towns of Avon, Barrington, Chili, Gates, Geneva, Palmyra, Pembroke, and the City of Rochester. There are a few cases of slight increases of permits issued and/or units in the Towns of Arcade, West Bloomfield and the Village of Spencerport.

The majority of industrial and commercial permits were issued in municipalities comprising the TMA.

Over the past fifteen years (1994 – 2008), the majority of residential units in the TMA have been in Monroe County. In the TMA outside of Monroe County, the Towns of Victor, Canandaigua, and Farmington in Ontario County, and the Towns of Ontario and Walworth in Wayne County issued permits for the largest numbers of residential units over the same fifteen year time frame.

The data on permitted building activity and demolition tables are provided in appendices at the end of this report. Overall, the report serves as an information resource for the GTC and others to view and analyze permit activity in the G-FL Region to identify potential growth areas, and anticipate increased transportation needs.

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Introduction

The Genesee Transportation Council (GTC) provides funding annually for the *Regional Land Use Monitoring Report* under its Unified Planning Work Program. The purpose of this report is to provide information of building permits by type, size, and value to identify areas of growth within the Genesee-Finger Lakes (G-FL) Region that may, as a result, require increased transportation planning and services.

The *Regional Land Use Monitoring Report* includes residential, industrial, commercial, and community service building permit data for all nine counties in the G-FL Region. Prior to 2000, the number of permits issued for commercial, industrial, and community service buildings was not available for Monroe County, and data on industrial and community service permits was not available for Wyoming County. The categories (and associated subcategories) for building permits data are as follows:

- Residential (single-family, two-family, three-or-four-family, five-or-more-family, and mobile homes/trailers)
- Industrial
- Commercial (offices/banks, retail/service, service stations, hotels/motels)
- Community Service (hospitals, schools)
- Not Elsewhere Classified

A three-year trend analysis is provided for permitted residential units in all nine counties and industrial and community service building permits are analyzed over the three-year period. This time-series analysis is based on this year's and the two previous years' Land Use Monitoring Reports pro-

duced by the Genesee/Finger Lakes Regional Planning Council (G/FLRPC).

In addition, a time series (or historical trend) analysis is provided for residential, industrial, and commercial development and subdivision approvals in the Transportation Management Area (TMA).

The TMA includes Monroe County and the adjacent municipalities to the south and east as well as the City and Town of Canandaigua. Table 1 represents the municipalities that, along with Monroe County, comprise the Transportation Management Area.

An analysis of the collected data on the number, value, and size of buildings permitted in 2008 is provided for each county as well as the TMA. Given that many conclusions can be drawn from the data on permitted building activity, tables are provided in appendices at the end of this report for the reader to use for their own needs and analysis.

Methodology

The building permit data included in this report was collected through surveys sent to the municipal or county officials responsible for the collection and dissemination of such data in the nine counties. In six counties these officials were, in most cases, the code or zoning enforcement officers; in some cases the municipal clerks. In Seneca and Wyoming Counties building permit application approval and inspection are the responsibility of the respective county building departments. Those two departments provided the data for their counties. The Monroe County Planning and Development Department's Division of Planning administered the surveys, received the responses from municipal officials in the County, and forwarded the data to G/FLRPC.

As noted above, each municipality other than Seneca and Wyoming Counties received a survey in January of 2009 asking for the requested data. The initial survey was followed up with a reminder postcard along with a telephone reminder to those municipalities that had yet to respond. In some cases, several calls were made to the appropriate parties, in an effort to acquire the requested information. Overall, (100%) of the data was collected from all 192 municipalities within the nine-county G-FL Region.

The survey requested information on the number of permits issued, total square footage and total value for buildings in the defined categories and associated subcategories. In addition, the same building permit information for buildings outside of these categories was requested along with a description of the type of building(s) in the "Other" category.

This year the LUMR survey included additional requests from municipalities. All analysis conducted in this report is based on data provided by each LUMR survey contact.

The instructions for completing the survey as printed on the first of the two-page document were as follows:

"Include only permits for the construction of buildings in 2008. Do not include additions, repairs, decks, in-ground pools, etc. or buildings used for storage such as sheds and pole barns. Do not include permits for construction that was completed in 2008 but permitted in 2007. If the responses below include a town and a village on the same sheet, please denote this by listing them separately on the same line (example: T - 8/ V - 12)."

For each of the nine counties, there is a discussion of permitted building activity in 2008 and county maps of residential units permitted in 2008 by municipality (Maps 1 - 9, Map 10 represents Permits for Residential Units for the nine-county G-FL Region). Data of industrial, commercial, and community service building permits issued in 2008 are presented on maps of the nine-county G-FL Region (Maps 11-13).

The information and data provided for permitted building activity in Monroe County and the remaining portion of the TMA follows the same format. Maps 14 through 17 present the number of permitted residential, industrial, commercial, and community service buildings in the TMA in 2008. Map 18 shows the distribution of residential building permits among the Transportation Analysis Zones (TAZ) within the TMA outside of Monroe County.

The residential data for TMA municipalities were used in a time series analysis of number of residential units by municipality for the years 1994 through 2008. The number of permits issued for industrial and commercial buildings from 1994 to 2008 in the TMA outside of Monroe County is also presented and discussed in the same manner.

A three-year time series analysis of permits issued by municipalities in the G-FL Region that responded to the survey all three years are provided for permits that were issued for buildings across all categories. Data for Wyoming County between 2006 and 2008 are provided for all but industrial and community service buildings.

The data gathered on number of building permits issued, square footage, and value in each category/subcategory by municipality in and for the Rural TMA are presented in Appendices A through H. The Appendices are as follows:

2008 County Building Permit Analysis

Genesee County

Residential Permits:

- Fifty three (53) residential building permits were issued in Genesee County in 2008. The largest number of permits (13) was issued in the Town of Batavia. Permits issued totaled 25,156 square feet with a combined value of \$2,416,000. The Towns of Pembroke, Darien, and Pavilion issued seven, five, and four permits respectively. Also, the Towns of Alabama, Alexander, LeRoy, Stafford and the Village of Corfu all issued three residential permits individually.
- Over 45% of all the fifty three residential building permits issued were from the Towns of Batavia, Darien, and Pembroke; 25 permits were issued in total between the three towns.
- The number of permits issued in Genesee County in 2008 for mobile/manufactured homes was six.
- There were no permits issued for multi-units, down from seven that were issued in 2007.

Map 1 shows the number of residential unit permits in Genesee County in 2008.

Industrial Permits:

- Two industrial building permits were issued in 2008: one in the Town of Bergen, and one in the Town of Byron.

Map 11 shows the number of industrial building permits by municipality in the G-FL Region in 2008.

Commercial Permits:

- Seven commercial building permits were issued in Genesee County. The City of Batavia issued four permits totaling \$9,850,000. The Town and Village of LeRoy, and the Town of Pembroke, each issued a single permit.

Map 12 shows the number of commercial building permits by municipality in the G-FL Region in 2008.

Community Service Permits:

- No permits for community service buildings were reported for Genesee County municipalities in 2008.

Map 13 shows the number of community service building permits by municipality in the G-FL Region in 2008.

Not Elsewhere Classified Permits:

- Five permits that did not correspond to the above-described categories were included as not elsewhere classified. Three of these permits were issued in the Town of Oakfield in 2008 for various projects, including a pipeline and a compressor station.

Demolition Permits:

- Nineteen (19) residential demolitions were permitted in Genesee County in 2008.

Livingston County

Residential Permits:

- Eighty seven (87) residential permits, for 88 units, were issued in Livingston County in 2008. The largest number of single-family homes was permitted in the Town of Livonia (13). The Town and Village of Avon issued eight and six permits respectively.
- The Town of Leicester issued seven permits including four mobile/manufactured homes. The Town of York issued six residential permits with a total value at \$776,000.
- The Town and Village of Avon and the Towns of Geneseo, Leicester, Livonia, Portage and York, constitute seven out of 26 municipalities in Livingston County and they account for nearly 60% of all total residential permits reported in Livingston County in 2008.

Map 2 shows the number of residential unit permits in Livingston County in 2008.

Industrial Permits:

- In 2008, municipalities in Livingston County issued three permits for industrial buildings.

Map 11 shows the number of industrial building permits by municipality in the G-FL Region in 2008.

Commercial Permits:

- Ten (10) permits were issued for commercial building permits. The Town and Village of Geneseo issued two and one office/bank permit respectively totaling \$1,650,000. Six permits were issued for retail/service, one each for the Village of Dansville, the Town and Village Geneseo, and the Towns of Livonia, North Dansville and Springwater.

Map 12 shows the number of commercial building permits by municipality in the G-FL Region in 2008.

Community Service Permits:

- No permits for community service buildings were issued in Livingston County in 2008.

Map 13 shows the number of community service building permits by municipality in the G-FL Region in 2008.

Not Elsewhere Classified Permits:

- Two permits were issued that did not correspond to the above-described categories were included as not elsewhere classified for Livingston County in 2008. They were in the Town of North Dansville.

Demolition Permits:

- Thirty three (33) demolitions were permitted in Livingston County in 2008, all were issued for residential structures.
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Monroe County

Residential Permits:

- Municipalities in Monroe County issued 876 residential building permits for a total of 1,067 residential units in 2008. The largest number of single-family unit permits issued was in the Town of Penfield (128), for a total value of \$30,305,000.

The Town of Henrietta issued the next largest number of single-family unit permits (117) valued at \$26,499,700. The Town of Greece issued 100 permits for single-family-homes valued at \$20,346,681 as well as issuing 21 permits for two-family homes valued at \$5,061,000.

The Town of Webster issued 75 single-family permits and 21 two-family unit permits, for a total of 117 units with a value of \$19,980,115.

The City of Rochester issued 66 residential building permits, all single-family units that totaled \$5,907,000 and the Town of Chili issued 63 single-family unit permits as well as 14 multi-family permits totaling 63 units with a total value \$18,823,910.

- A total of 79 multi-family unit permits were issued for 280 units in the county. The most multi-family units permitted were 21 by both the Town of Greece and Webster. The Town of Chili issued 14 multi-family unit permits containing a total of 63 units valued at \$5,865,000. The Village of Hilton issued eight multi-family permits totaling 40 units valued at \$2,080,000. The Town of Irondequoit issued one multi-family permit consisting of 39 units.

- Ten (10) mobile/manufactured home permits were issued in the county with the Town of Penfield issuing the highest amount of permits (7) valued at \$155,600.

Map 3 shows the number of residential unit permits in Monroe County in 2008.

Industrial Permits:

- The largest number of industrial permits was issued in the Town of Perinton (60) with a value of \$7,593,335 (the Town indicated that these permits were related to agriculture). The Town of Henrietta issued 15 industrial permits.

Map 11 shows the number of industrial building permits by municipality in the G-FL Region in 2008.

Commercial Permits:

- In the category of commercial buildings, 58 permits with a total value of \$69,228,166 were issued in Monroe County. The Town of Perinton issued the most with 13. The Town of Greece issued nine commercial permits valued at \$16,342,986. The City of Rochester and the Town of Webster both issued six commercial permits.

Map 12 shows the number of commercial building permits by municipality in the G-FL Region in 2008.

Community Service Permits:

- Three permits were issued for community service buildings in Monroe County. The City of Rochester issued two permits valued at \$1,835,000, as well as the Town of Pittsford issuing one permit covering 16,887 square feet.

Map 13 shows the number of community service building permits by municipality in the G-FL Region in 2008.

Not Elsewhere Classified Permits:

- Eleven (11) permits were issued in Monroe County that did not correspond to the above-described categories and were included as not elsewhere classified. The Town of Greece issued five permits. Towns of Chili, Penfield, and Sweden, as well as the Villages of Churchville, Hilton and Webster all issued one permit each.

Demolition Permits:

- Of all the counties in the G-FL Region, the most demolitions in 2008 were permitted in Monroe County. 344 demolition permits were issued.

Fifty seven percent of the county's demolition permits were issued in the City of Rochester, 197 demolition permits were issued for 347 units in the City of Rochester for residential structures.

Ontario County

Residential Permits:

- Ontario County municipalities permitted 421 residential structures in 2008, for a total of 553 units. The Town of Victor issued the most permits. The Town of Canandaigua's permits totaled the most units. The Town of Victor issued the most permits (114). The permits issued were valued at a total of \$24,840,529. The Town of Canandaigua issued 89 permits consisting of 173 units. The Town of Farmington issued 72 with a total value of \$16,033,461.

The Towns of Victor, Canandaigua, and Farmington comprised 65% of all permits issued in Ontario County. The Towns of West Bloomfield, Manchester, Geneva and Phelps each issued 21, 16, 14, and 14 permits respectively. Excluding the Town of Canandaigua's 89 residential permits, Ontario County's total value was over \$66 million.

Map 4 shows the number of residential unit permits in Ontario County in 2008.

Industrial Permits:

- There were no industrial building permits issued in Ontario County in 2008.

Map 11 shows the number of industrial building permits by municipality in the G-FL Region in 2008.

Commercial Permits:

- Eleven commercial building permits were issued in Ontario County. The Towns of East Bloomfield and Victor issued three each, with a value at \$150,000 and \$10,000,000 re-

spectively. The Town of Seneca issued two commercial permits in the retail/service category.

Map 12 shows the number of commercial building permits by municipality in the G-FL Region in 2008.

Community Service Permits:

- Three permits were issued for community service buildings in Ontario County in 2008. The City of Canandaigua and The Village of Clifton Springs both issued one permit for the development of a hospital. The Town of Victor issued a permit for a school/church totaling 26,665 square feet.

Map 13 shows the number of community service building permits by municipality in the G-FL Region in 2008.

Not Elsewhere Classified Permits:

- Fifteen (15) permits were issued in Ontario County that did not correspond to the above-described categories and were included as not elsewhere classified. The Town of Phelps issued eleven of these permits for agriculture related buildings, valued at \$745,472. The Towns of Farmington and Geneva each issued one permit.

Demolition Permits:

- Eighty (80) residential demolitions were permitted in Ontario County in 2008.
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Orleans County

Residential Permits:

- A total of 35 residential building permits were issued in Orleans County in 2008 consisting of 19 single-family structures and 16 mobile homes. The Town of Carlton issued the largest number of permits in the County with nine, with a value of \$1,600,000. The Town of Clarendon issued the next largest number of permits with six.

Map 5 shows the number of residential unit permits in Orleans County in 2008.

Industrial Permits:

- No industrial building permits were reported in Orleans County in 2008.

Map 11 shows the number of industrial building permits by municipality in the G-FL Region in 2008.

Commercial Permits:

- Orleans County issued one commercial building permit in 2008, in the Town of Yates.

Map 12 shows the number of commercial building permits by municipality in the G-FL Region in 2008.

Community Service Permits:

- No community service building permits were reported for Orleans County in 2008.

Map 13 shows the number of community service building permits by municipality in the G-FL Region in 2008.

Not Elsewhere Classified Permits:

- Six permits were issued in Orleans County that did not correspond to the above-described categories and were included as not elsewhere classified. The Towns of Gaines and Murray both issued two permits each with a combined value of \$400,000.

Demolition Permits:

- Orleans County permitted 21 residential demolitions in 2008.
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Seneca County

Residential Permits:

- Fifty eight (58 residential building units) were reported in Seneca County in 2008. The largest number of permits (7) was issued by the Towns of Covert, Fayette and Lodi. Each municipality issued permits for six single-family and one mobile home. The Town of Romulus issued six permits, five single-family and one mobile home. The Towns of Junius and Ovid issued five permits each. There were no multiple-family unit permits reported in the County.

Map 6 shows the number of residential unit permits in Seneca County in 2008.

Industrial Permits:

- One industrial building permit was issued in Seneca County in 2008; the location of the permit was in the Town of Fayette.

Map 11 shows the number of industrial building permits by municipality in the G-FL Region in 2008.

Commercial Permits:

- One commercial building permit was issued in Seneca County in 2008. It was located in the Town of Waterloo.

Map 12 shows the number of commercial building permits by municipality in the G-FL Region in 2008.

Community Service Permits:

- No community service buildings were reported in Seneca County for 2008.

Map 13 shows the number of community service building permits by municipality in the G-FL Region in 2008.

Not Elsewhere Classified Permits:

- Permits that did not correspond to the above-described categories were included as not elsewhere classified. Only one permit was issued in this category and that was in the Town of Waterloo.

Demolition Permits:

- Fifteen (15) demolition permits were issued in Seneca County in 2008. All demolition permits issued were for residential buildings, except for one 25,000 square foot commercial building.
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Wayne County

Residential Permits:

- Municipalities in Wayne County issued 165 permits for 235 residential units in 2008. As with recent years, trends showed that the western portion of Wayne County experienced the most permits issued. The Town of Macedon issued 42 permits, 37 single-family structures, two two-family structures and three mobile homes valued at \$6,197,000. The Town of Ontario issued 27 permits. The Town of Walworth issued 20 permits for a total of 81 units, totaling \$6,621,800, while the Towns of Wolcott, Williamson, Palmyra and Huron issued 11, 9, 9, and 8 permits respectively. Of the 165 permits issued in the county, 128 were for single-family homes, seven were for multi-family homes, and 30 were for mobile homes.

Map 7 shows the number of residential unit permits in Wayne County in 2008.

Industrial Permits:

- Ten (10) permits were issued for industrial buildings in Wayne County in 2008. Two permits each were issued in the Town and Village of Lyons as well as in the Town of Williamson. One permit was issued in each of the Towns of Butler, Galen, Macedon, and the Village of Wolcott, with a combined total of \$1,079,000

Map 11 shows the number of industrial building permits by municipality in the G-FL Region in 2008.

Commercial Permits:

- Nine permits were issued for commercial buildings in 2008. The Village of Newark issued three permits with a value totaling \$10,490,000. The Village of Lyons issued three permits. The Town of Macedon issued two commercial building permits with values totaling \$3,458,535.

Map 12 shows the number of commercial building permits by municipality in the G-FL Region in 2008.

Community Service Permits:

- One permit was issued for a community service building in Wayne County for 2008. The Town of Wolcott was the location of the permit issued, covering 5,232 square feet.

Map 13 shows the number of community service building permits by municipality in the G-FL Region in 2008.

Not Elsewhere Classified Permits:

- Permits that did not correspond to the above-described categories were included as not elsewhere classified. One such permit was issued in Wayne County in 2008 for a nursing home in the Town of Arcadia, covering 32,000 square feet.

Demolition Permits:

- Thirty eight (38) demolition permits were reported in Wayne County in 2008.

Wyoming County

Residential Permits:

- In 2008, municipalities in Wyoming County issued 75 permits for residential structures. The Towns of Arcade and Pike issued the most permits with 14 and seven respectively. The Towns of Bennington, Perry and Sheldon issued six permits each. The Towns of Attica, Covington and Eagle all issued five permits each. The rest of Wyoming County's residential permits were spread evenly throughout the county's municipalities. In total, 53 of the 75 permits were for single-family homes and the remaining 22 were for mobile homes.

Map 8 shows the number of residential unit permits in Wyoming County in 2008.

Industrial Permits:

(Wyoming County does not categorize Industrial permits)

- The Information reported by Wyoming County for permits issued, does not correspond directly to the survey categories. Information related to industrial permits is not categorized by Wyoming County but it is categorized under commercial permits. Therefore it is unclear how many permits were issued for industrial buildings in the County in 2008.

Map 11 shows the number of industrial building permits by municipality in the G-FL Region in 2008.

Commercial Permits:

- A total of 77 permits were issued for commercial buildings in the County in 2008. 10 permits were issued in the Town of Sheldon, eight permits were issued in both the Village of Arcade and Town of Java, and seven were issued in the

Village of Wyoming. The remaining 44 permits were issued among 12 municipalities.

Map 12 shows the number of commercial building permits by municipality in the G-FL Region in 2008.

Community Service Permits:

(Wyoming County does not categorize community service permits)

- The Information reported by Wyoming County for permits issued, does not correspond directly to the survey categories. Information related to community service permits is not categorized by Wyoming County. Therefore, it is unclear how many permits were issued for community service buildings in the County in 2008.

Map 13 shows the number of community service building permits by municipality in the G-FL Region in 2008.

Not Elsewhere Classified Permits:

(Wyoming County does not specify not elsewhere classified permits)

- The Information reported by Wyoming County for permits issued, does not correspond directly to the survey categories. Therefore it is unclear how many permits were issued for not elsewhere classified in the County in 2008.

Demolition Permits:

- Nineteen (19) unspecified demolition permits were issued in Wyoming County in 2008.
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Yates County

Residential Permits:

- Municipalities in Yates County issued 83 permits for 86 residential units in 2008. The Towns of Barrington and Jerusalem issued the most permits with 24 and 17 respectively. Eleven permits were issued in Milo totaling over \$1,400,000. The Town of Barrington's permits consisted of seven single-family unit structures and 17 mobile homes with a combined value of \$2,430,500.

Map 9 shows the number of residential unit permits in Yates County in 2008.

Industrial Permits:

- Five industrial building permits were issued in 2008; three permits were issued in the Town of Torrey valued at \$1,500,000.

Map 11 shows the number of industrial building permits by municipality in the G-FL Region in 2008.

Commercial Permits:

- Two permits were reported for commercial buildings in Yates County for 2008.

Map 12 shows the number of commercial building permits by municipality in the G-FL Region in 2008.

Community Service Permits:

- Three community service building permits were issued in Yates County in 2008, two in the Town of Starkey, and one in the Town of Benton.

Map 13 shows the number of community service building permits by municipality in the G-FL Region in 2008.

Not Elsewhere Classified Permits:

- One permit was issued in Yates County for buildings not elsewhere classified. The Town of Benton issued a permit for a storage facility.

Demolition Permits:

- Yates County permitted 31 residential demolitions in 2008.
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3-Year Building Permit Analysis (2006 – 2008)

Genesee County

Data for the following municipalities was not available for one or two years (2006 – 2007): the Towns of Alexander, Batavia, Bethany, Byron, Pavilion, and the Village of Oakfield. Data was reported for all municipalities in Genesee County for 2008.

Residential Units:

- During the three-year period from 2006 through 2008, the total number of units permitted was 248. In 2006, 58 units were permitted and that number increased to 137 in 2007 and decreased to 53 in 2008.
- The City of Batavia permitted the most residential units in Genesee County with 54. However, in 2008 the City of Batavia did not report any residential permits. The Town of Batavia issued the next highest number of units (48). The Towns of LeRoy, Darien and Pembroke had the next highest number of units with 24, 20, 20 respectively, and the Towns of Alabama and Stafford followed with 17 and 13 units respectively.

Industrial Units:

- A total of nine units were permitted for industrial buildings in Genesee County from 2006 to 2008. The Town of Bergen permitted two of these units in 2006, one in 2007, as well as one in 2008. The Town of Stafford permitted two industrial units in 2007.
- Industrial building permits increased from three in 2006 to four in 2007, then slightly decreasing to two units in 2008.

Commercial Units:

- Nineteen (19) commercial permits were issued in Genesee County from 2006 to 2008. The Town of Batavia issued the most permits with nine. The City of Batavia, the Town and Village of LeRoy and the Town of Pembroke each issued two commercial permits from 2006-2008. The total number of commercial permits increased over the three year period: four in 2006, seven in 2007 and eight in 2008.

Community Service Units:

- Four permits were reported for community service building permits from 2006 to 2008, all four permits were reported in 2008.
-

Livingston County

Data for the following municipalities was not available for one or two years (2006 – 2007): the Towns of North Dansville, Portage, Sparta, Springwater, and the Villages of, Leicester, and Livonia. Data was reported for all municipalities in Livingston County for 2008.

Residential Units:

- The number of residential units permitted in Livingston County has steadily declined over the past three years, from 154 in 2006, to 136 in 2007, and to 88 in 2008. Of the 378 units permitted over the three years, 34% (129) were issued in the Towns of Avon and Livonia and the Village of Nunda.
- The Town of Livonia issued permits for 66 residential units from 2006 to 2008, more than any other municipality in Livingston County. The Town of Avon permitted the next largest number of residential units with 38, followed by the Village of Nunda with 25.

Industrial Units:

- Thirteen (13) industrial permits were reported in Livingston County from 2006 to 2008. The Towns of Livonia and York both permitted the most industrial units with three. The Village of Livonia permitted two industrial units. Five other municipalities (the Towns of Caledonia, Leicester, Lima, North Dansville, and the Village of Avon) permitted a single unit each from 2006 to 2008.
- The number of industrial units permitted in Livingston County has varied slightly over the last three years, with a drop in 2007. In 2006, five units were permitted followed by two in 2007 and six in 2008.

Commercial Units:

- Twenty three (23) commercial units were issued from 2006 to 2008. The number of units issued for commercial structures in Livingston County has steadily increased in the past three years: five in 2006, seven in 2007 and 11 in 2008.
- The Village of Dansville permitted the largest number of commercial units with seven. The Towns of Geneseo and Livonia permitted four commercial buildings from 2006-2008. The Villages of Geneseo and Livonia permitted three and two commercial units respectively.

Community Service Units:

- Eight community service units were permitted in Livingston County from 2006-2008. The Town of Conesus issued the largest number of units (4). Four other municipalities permitted one community service unit each from 2006-2008.
-

Monroe County

Data for the Town/Village of East Rochester was not available for 2007. Data was reported for all municipalities in Monroe County for 2008.

Residential Units:

- Three thousand six hundred fifty six (3,656) residential units were permitted in Monroe County between 2006 and 2008. Monroe County issued the most residential permits and totaled the most units in the region. Much of the permits issued occurred to the east and south of Rochester: nearly 60% of the residential units were located on the east side of Monroe County (using the Genesee River as the dividing line). Municipalities on the east side combined to permit 2,195 units, those on the west side combined to permit 1,461 units, and the City of Rochester permitted 227 units over the three-year period. The number of units permitted has decreased over the past three years from 1,429 in 2006, to 1,160 in 2007, and down to 1,067 in 2008.
- The Town of Henrietta permitted the largest number of residential units (556) followed by the Towns of Greece (452), Webster (445), Penfield (373), Chili (314), Perinton (151), the Village of Hilton (148), and the Town of Pittsford (129).
- The most notable increases in units between 2007 and 2008 occurred in the Town of Chili, the Town of Irondequoit and the Village of Hilton. These increases were due largely to multi-family structures. In the Town of Chili, 14 permits were issued for a total of 63 units. In the Town of Irondequoit one permit was issued for 39 units, and in the

Village of Hilton four permits were issued for a total of 24 units.

Industrial Units:

The Towns of Chili and Penfield do not categorize industrial and commercial permits.

- During the last three years, a total of 127 industrial units were permitted in Monroe County. The Town of Perinton permitted the most (60), all of which were issued in 2008. The Town of Henrietta permitted 56 units during 2006-2008, and experienced a steady decline of permits issued with 22 in 2006, 19 in 2007 and 15 in 2008. The number of industrial building units permitted in Monroe County rose sharply from 25 in 2007, to 75 in 2008.

Commercial Units:

The Towns of Chili and Penfield do not categorize industrial and commercial permits.

- A total of 218 commercial building permits were issued from 2006 to 2008. During the period from 2006-2008, the Town of Penfield permitted the greatest number of commercial units with 78. The Town of Chili issued 28, and the Town of Greece permitted 27.

Community Service Units:

- Fourteen (14) community service building units were issued in Monroe County from 2006 to 2008. The Town of Greece issued the most with seven over the three year period.
-

Ontario County

Data for the Village of Naples was not available for 2007. Data was reported for all municipalities in Ontario County for 2008.

Residential Units:

- One thousand seven hundred ninety four (1,794) residential units were permitted in Ontario County from 2006 to 2008. Ontario County issued the second most residential permits and totaled the second most units in the region. Almost 66% of the units permitted were in three municipalities, the Towns of Canandaigua, Farmington, and Victor.
- Residential units have fluctuated over the past three years from 546 in 2006, to 695 in 2007, and to 553 in 2008.

Industrial Units:

- Eleven (11) industrial units were permitted in Ontario County from 2006 to 2008. The Town of Victor permitted six of these units. The Town of Phelps issued two, and the Towns of Bristol, East Bloomfield and the Village of Manchester permitted the remaining three units.

Commercial Units:

- Forty five (45) commercial units were permitted in Ontario County from 2006 to 2008. Ontario County's commercial units have fluctuated over the three-year period from 14 in 2006, to 20 in 2007, and 11 in 2008.
- The Town of Farmington permitted 13 units, the most of any municipality in Ontario County. The Town of Victor permitted 10 of these units. The Town of Hopewell permitted five over the three-year period. These three munici-

palities account for 57% of all commercial units permitted in Ontario County from 2006-2008.

Community Service Units:

- Five community service units were permitted in Ontario County, one each by the City of Canandaigua, Village of Clifton Springs and the Towns of Farmington, Geneva, and Victor. All were permitted in 2008.
-

Orleans County

Data for the following municipalities was not available for one or two years (2006 – 2007): the Towns of Barre, Clarendon, and Murray; Villages of Albion and Holley. Data was reported for all municipalities in Orleans County for 2008.

Town of Murray and the rest distributed evenly among three other municipalities.

Residential Units:

- Residential units permitted fluctuated during the last three years (2006 – 2008). In 2006, Orleans County municipalities permitted a total of 44 residential units. That number increased to 63 units in 2007 and then decreased to 35 in 2008.
- A total of 142 residential units were permitted. Forty three percent (43%) of the units permitted (61 of 142) were located in the Village of Medina (33) and the Town of Carlton (28). The Towns of Clarendon and Gaines permitted 15 and 12 units respectively over the three year period, while the Town of Ridgeway and the Town of Albion permitted 10 units each.

Industrial Units:

- No industrial permits were reported from 2006-2008.

Commercial Units:

- A total of six commercial building units were permitted in Orleans County from 2006 to 2008. Two permits were issued in the Town of Gaines and the rest were distributed evenly among four other municipalities.

Community Service Units:

- Five community service buildings were permitted in Orleans County from 2006 to 2008. Two were issued in the

Seneca County

Data for the following municipalities was not available for one or two years (2006 – 2007): the Villages of Interlaken, Lodi, and Ovid. Data was reported for all municipalities in Seneca County for 2008.

Residential Units:

- Three hundred thirty (330) residential units were permitted in Seneca County from 2006 to 2008 (down from 370 from 2005 through 2007). The Village of Waterloo permitted 47 residential units during this period, the most of any municipality. The Towns of Fayette and Waterloo both permitted 43 units each. The Towns of Romulus, Covert, and Lodi permitted 36, 35 and 29 units respectively.
- Permits issued in 2008 were generally spread throughout the County. The Towns of Romulus, Covert, Lodi, and Varick, combined to permit approximately 36% (120 of 330) of all units in Seneca County over the three year period.
- The total number of residential units permitted in Seneca County has steadily decreased over the three year period from 155 in 2006, to 117 in 2007 and 58 in 2008.

Industrial Units:

- There were no industrial building permits reported in Seneca County from 2006 to 2008.

Commercial Units:

- There were a total of 20 commercial building units reported from 2006 to 2008. The Town of Lodi issued the most with five. The Towns of Ovid and Waterloo issued

three. The Towns of Fayette, Junius, Romulus, and Seneca Falls each issued two. The Town of Tyre permitted one unit.

- The total number of units permitted for commercial buildings in Seneca County decreased between 2006 and 2008 from 13 in 2006, to six in 2007 and one in 2008.

Community Service Units:

- Three community service building units permitted in Seneca County from 2006 to 2008. The permits were distributed evenly between the Towns of Lodi, Seneca Falls and Waterloo.
-

Wayne County

Data for the following municipalities was not available for one or two years (2006 – 2007): the Towns of Arcadia, Butler, Lyons, Marion, Walworth, Williamson, Wolcott; and the Villages of Clyde and Lyons. Data was reported for all municipalities in Wayne County for 2008.

Residential Units:

- Five hundred twenty six (526) residential units were permitted in Wayne County from 2006 to 2008.
- In 2006, the total number of residential units permitted was 131. That number increased to 160 in 2007, and increased again to 235 in 2008.
- The Town of Ontario permitted the most units (122). The Towns of Macedon, Walworth, Palmyra, Huron and Wolcott permitted 93, 81, 32, 29, and 27 units respectively. These Towns attributed for nearly 72% of all units permitted in Wayne County from 2006-2008. The remaining municipalities combined to issue the remaining 142 units.

Industrial Units:

- Fifteen (15) industrial permits were issued in Wayne County from 2006 to 2008. The Towns of Galen and Williamson each issued four. The Towns of Macedon, Ontario, Palmyra and the Villages of Lyons and Wolcott each permitted two. Three other municipalities each issued one permit over the last three years.

Commercial Units:

- Municipalities in Wayne County issued 20 commercial permits from 2006 to 2008. The Village of Newark issued the largest number of commercial units with six followed

by the Town of Macedon and Ontario each with five, and the Village of Lyons with four.

- The number of units permitted for commercial buildings in Wayne County has slightly declined over the past three years, from eight in 2006, to seven in 2007 and five in 2008.

Community Service Units:

- Four community service building units were permitted in Wayne County from 2006 to 2008 among the municipalities that reported all three years.
-

Wyoming County

Data was reported for all municipalities in Wyoming County (2006-2008).

Residential Units:

- During the last three years (2006 – 2008), 221 residential units were permitted by Wyoming County municipalities. The County issued 72 in 2006, 74 in 2007 and 75 in 2008.
- The Town of Arcade permitted the largest number of residential units over the three year period with 37. The Town of Bennington permitted 29, the Towns of Java and Eagle permitted 17, and 15 units respectively and the Towns of Perry and Sheldon each issued 13 units.

Industrial Units:

Wyoming County does not categorize Industrial permits.

Commercial Units:

- From 2006 to 2008, Wyoming County municipalities permitted a total of 179 units. The Village of Arcade permitted 20 commercial building units (17 of which were issued in 2007-2008). The Town of Sheldon permitted 18 units, and the Towns of Eagle and Java permitted 16 and 15 units respectively.
 - The number of Wyoming County commercial units permitted has increased over the three year period: 40 in 2006, to 62 in 2007, to 77 issued in 2008.
-

Yates County

Data for the following municipalities was not available for one or two years (2006 – 2007): the Towns of Benton, Jerusalem, Middlesex, and Starkey. Data was reported for all municipalities in Yates County for 2008.

Residential Units:

- Two hundred seventeen (217) residential units were permitted in Yates County from 2006 to 2008. The Town of Barrington reported the largest number of residential units permitted with 74. The Town of Milo issued 44 and the Town of Italy issued 18. The Towns of Jerusalem and Starkey each issued 17.
- Reported residential units permitted have remained steady in Yates County the past three years. The total number of units permitted was 57 in 2006, 76 in 2007 and 84 in 2008.

Industrial Units:

- Seven industrial units were permitted in Yates County. The Town of Torrey permitted four units during 2006-2008, of which three units were permitted in 2008.

Commercial Units:

- Eleven (11) commercial building permits were issued from 2006 through 2008. The Village of Penn Yan issued the most permits with five.

Community Service Units:

- Four community service buildings were permitted from 2006 to 2008; three of the permits were issued in 2008.

Transportation Management Area (TMA)

Residential:

- During the past fifteen year period, the top five municipalities that permitted residential units in Monroe County were:

- Over the fifteen year period, the Town of Webster issued permits for the largest number of residential units in the TMA with an average units per year of 267.5. During the 1994-2003 period the Town of Webster permitted 3,063 units averaging 306.3 units per year, however in the last five years, 2004-2008, 950 units were permitted, averaging 190.0 units per year. The Town of Greece experienced a similar trend of units permitted during the same time frame. During 1994-2003, 2,960 units were permitted averaging 296.1 units per year. During 2004-2008, they issued 870 units averaging 174.1 units per year. The Town of Perinton issued 194.6 residential units per year during the period of 1994-2003. During the 2004-2008 period they issued 58.6 units per year. The Town of Henrietta averaged 169.8 units per year during the 1994-2003 period and that average increased during the 2004-2008 period to 193.4 units per year.

- During the period 1994-2008, the top five municipalities that permitted residential units outside of Monroe County were:

- The Towns of Avon (286) and Lima (209) permitted over half (57%) of the residential units reported in the Livingston County portion of the TMA between 1994 and 2008.
- In 2008, the largest numbers of residential units permitted in the TMA were by the Towns of Canandaigua (173), Greece (142), Penfield (135), Chili (126), and Henrietta (117).

Map 14 shows the number of residential units for which permits were issued by municipalities in the TMA in 2008.

- Subdivision data for Monroe County in 2008 indicates that 32 subdivisions were approved totaling 264 lots in ten municipalities. The following table shows the Monroe County municipalities with the most subdivision approvals and lots:

- In 2008, there were 18 approved subdivisions totaling 287 lots in the municipalities of the TMA outside of Monroe County. Ontario County municipalities approved 11 of these subdivisions totaling 204 lots.

Industrial:

- The largest number of permits issued for industrial buildings in the TMA outside of Monroe County between 1994 and 2008 were in Ontario County with 135. Of these the Town of Victor issued 87.
- Between 1994 and 2008, 26 industrial buildings were permitted in Livingston County. No municipality in Livingston County reported an industrial permit for 2007-2008
- The Towns of Macedon (28) and Ontario (30) issued all of the permits for industrial buildings in the Wayne County portion of the TMA between 1994 and 2008. One industrial permit was issued for 2008 in the Wayne County portion of the TMA which was located in the Town of Macedon.

Map 15 shows the number of permits issued for industrial buildings by municipality in the TMA in 2008.

Commercial:

- The largest number of permitted commercial buildings in the TMA outside of Monroe County between 1994 and 2008 were in Ontario County (399). The Town of Victor issued 269 of these permits.
- Between 1994 and 2008, 66% of all the permits issued for commercial buildings in the Livingston County portion of

the TMA were by the Town of Avon (29). No commercial permits were issued in the Livingston County portion of the TMA in 2008.

- In the Wayne County portion of the TMA, 44 of the 72 permits issued for commercial buildings between 1994 and 2008 were in the Town of Ontario. Two permits were issued for commercial buildings in 2008 in the Wayne County portion of the TMA, both in the Town of Macedon. This was only the second time that the Town of Ontario did not issue a commercial permit in the past 15 years.

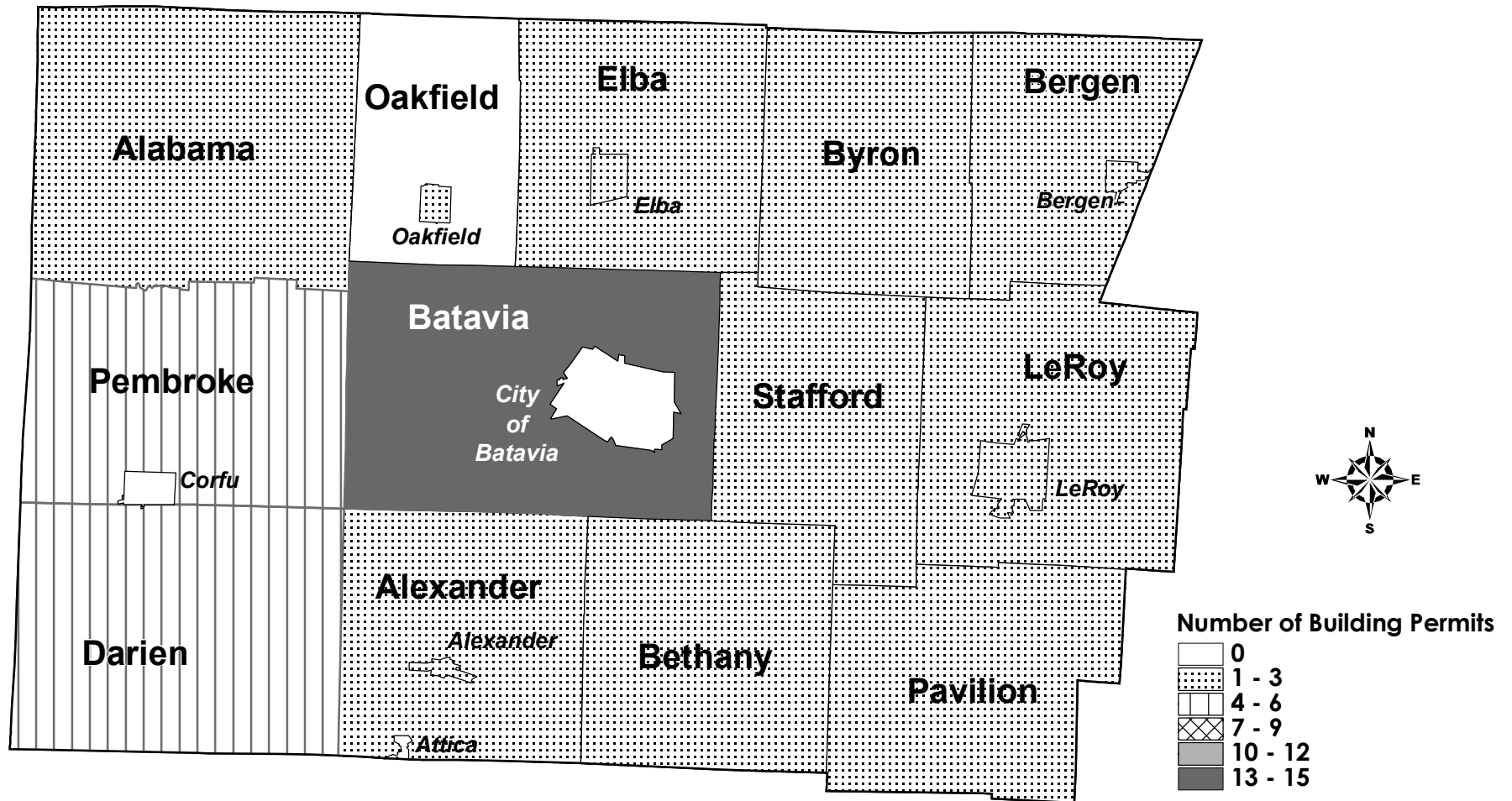

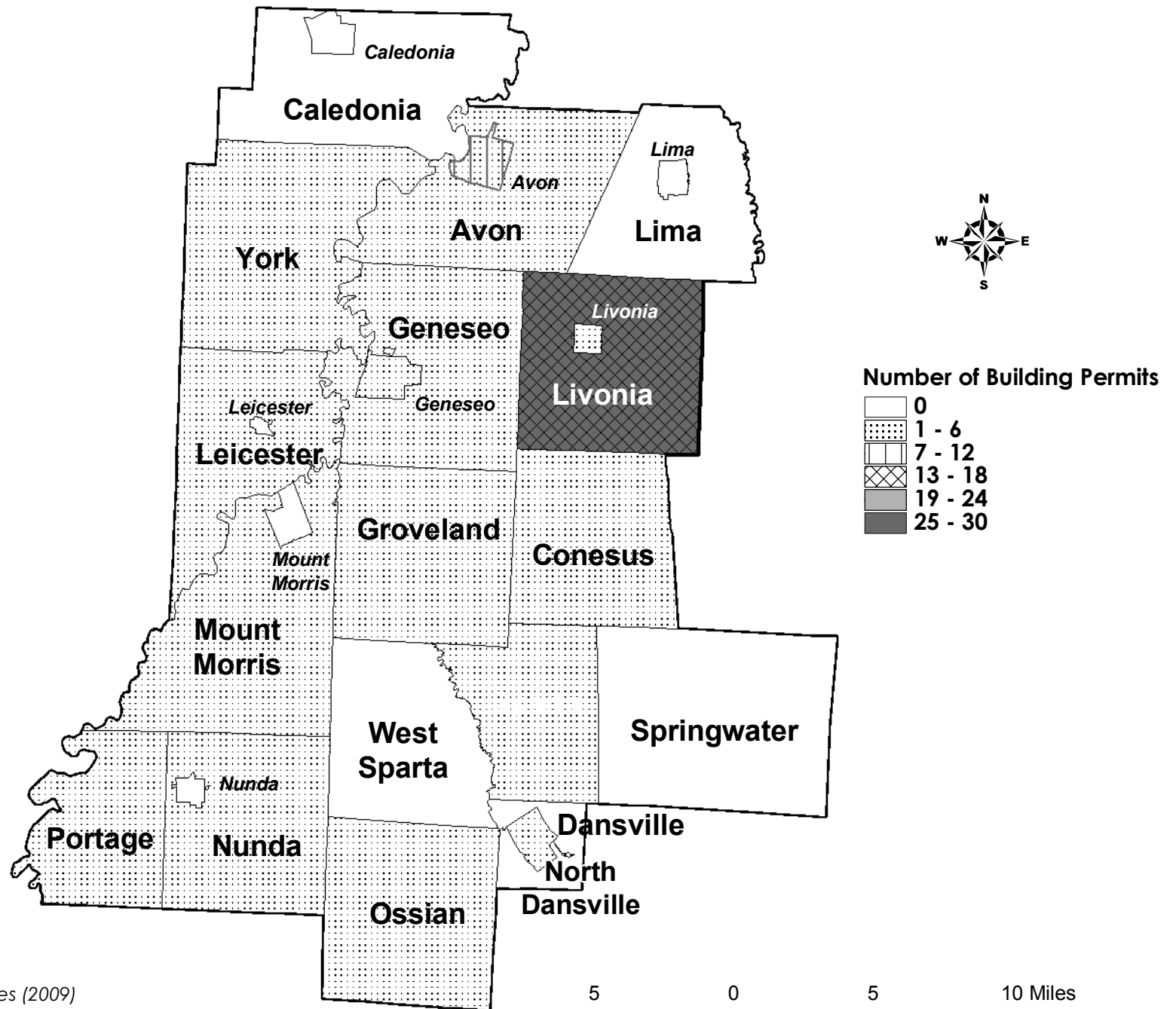

Number of Residential Unit Permits in Livingston County (2008)



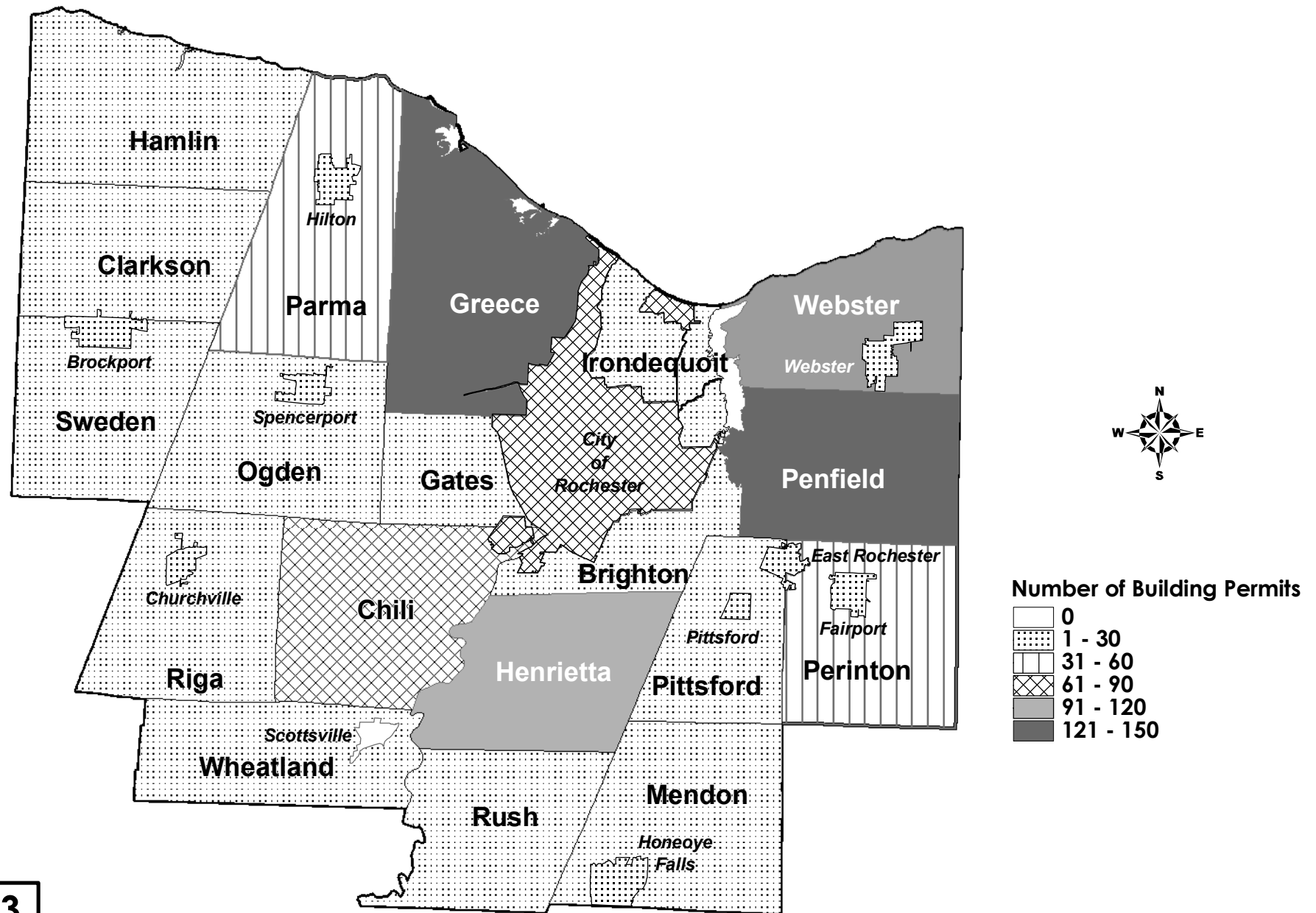

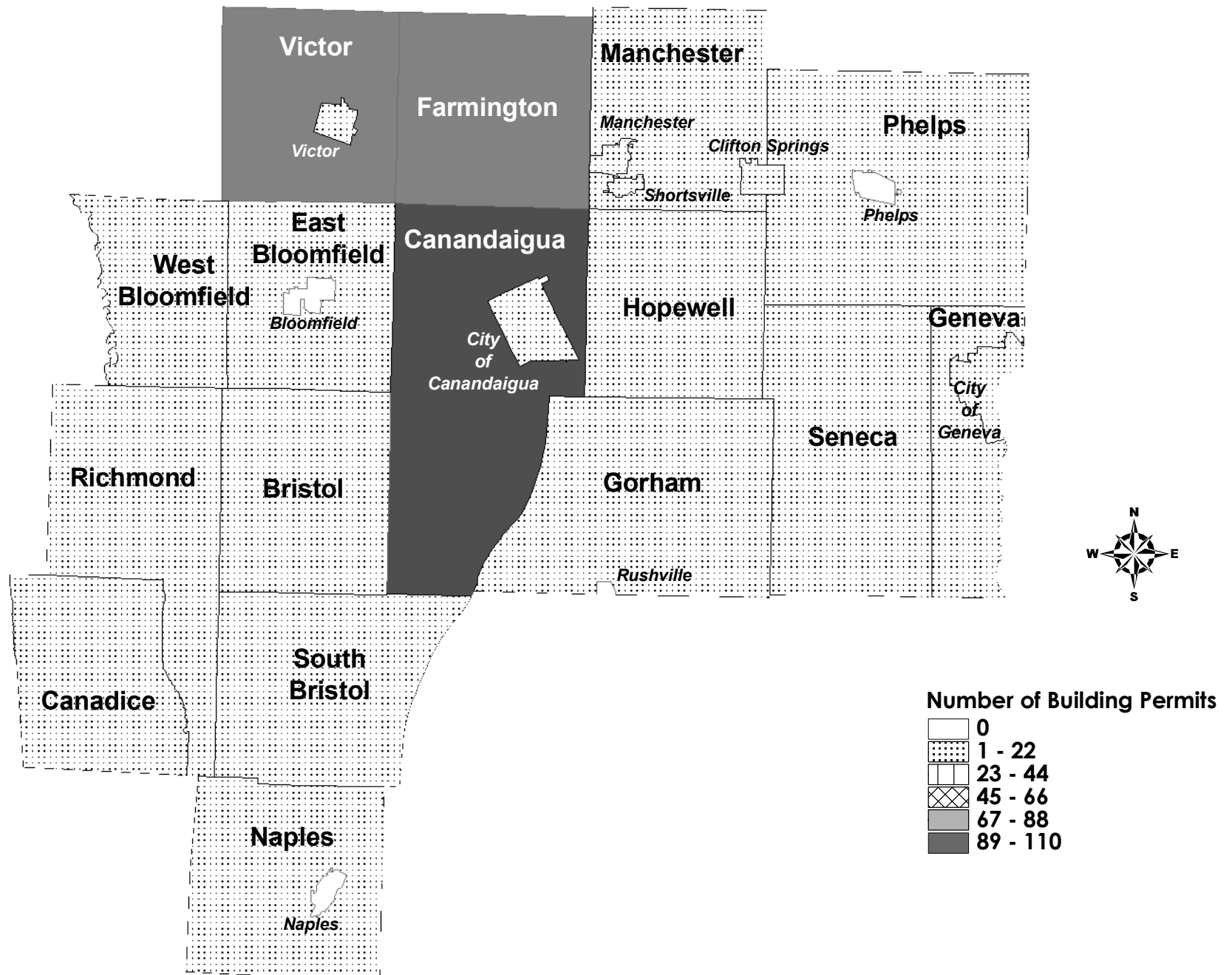

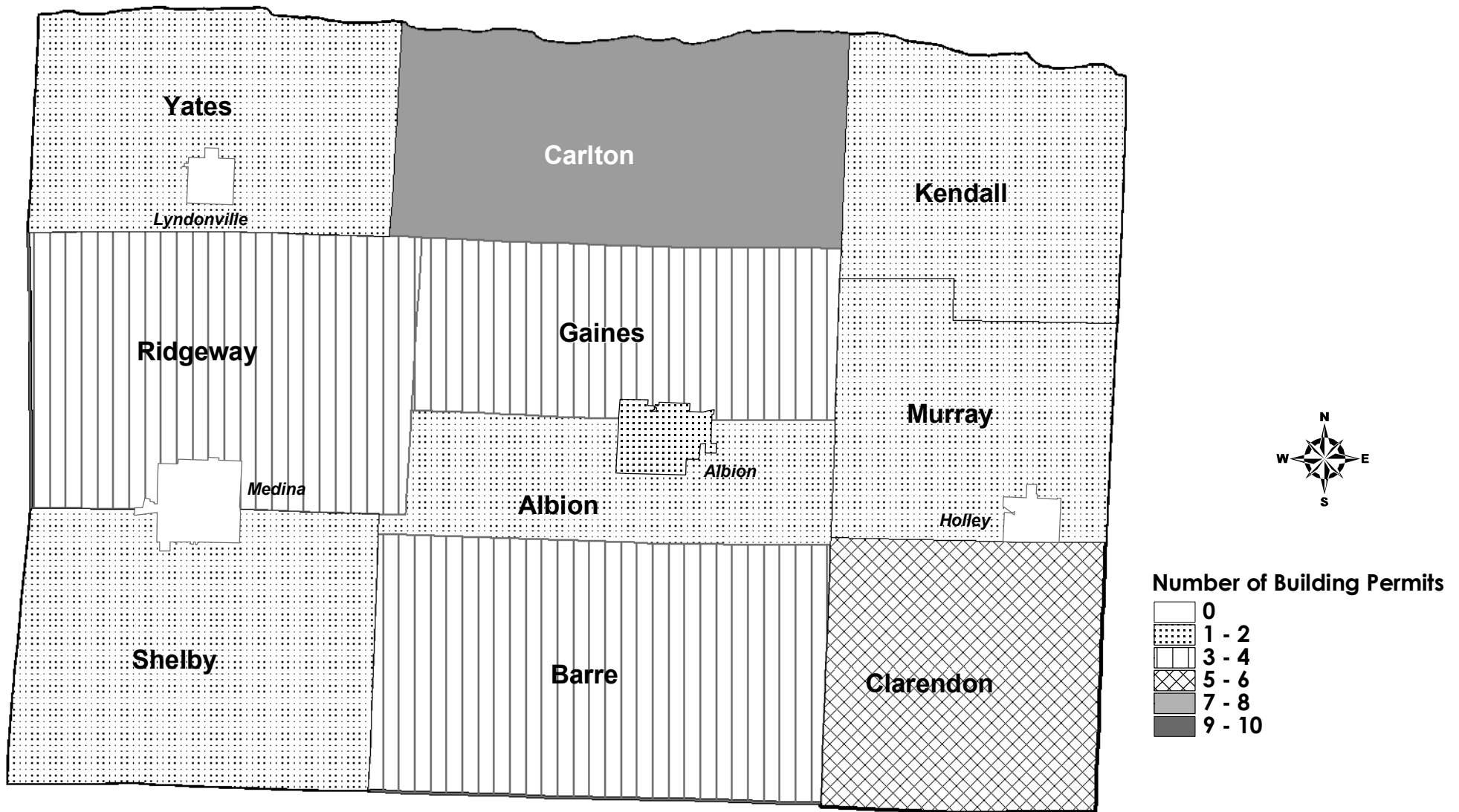

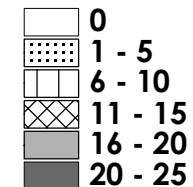
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Number of Residential Unit Permits in Seneca County (2008)

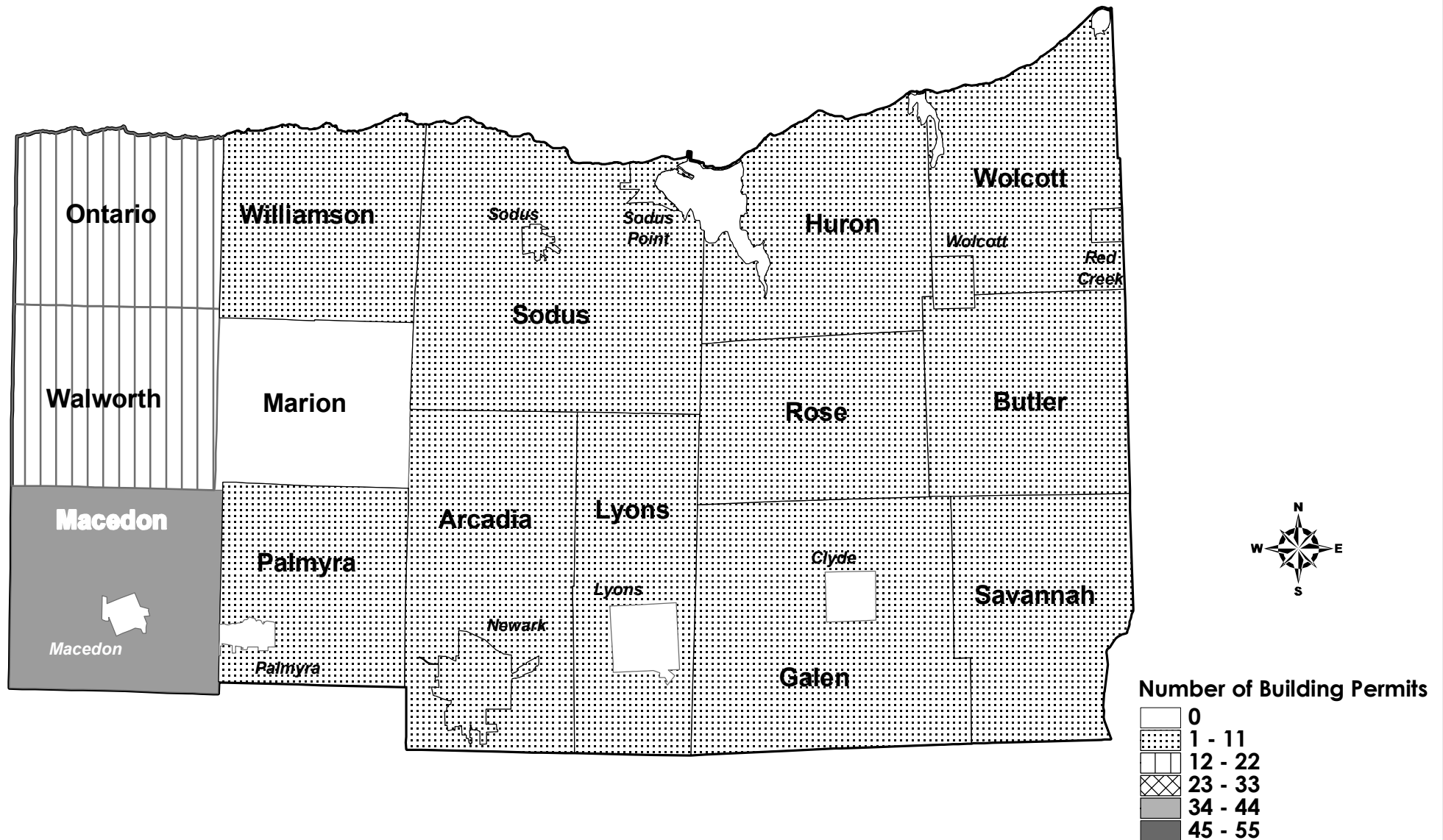

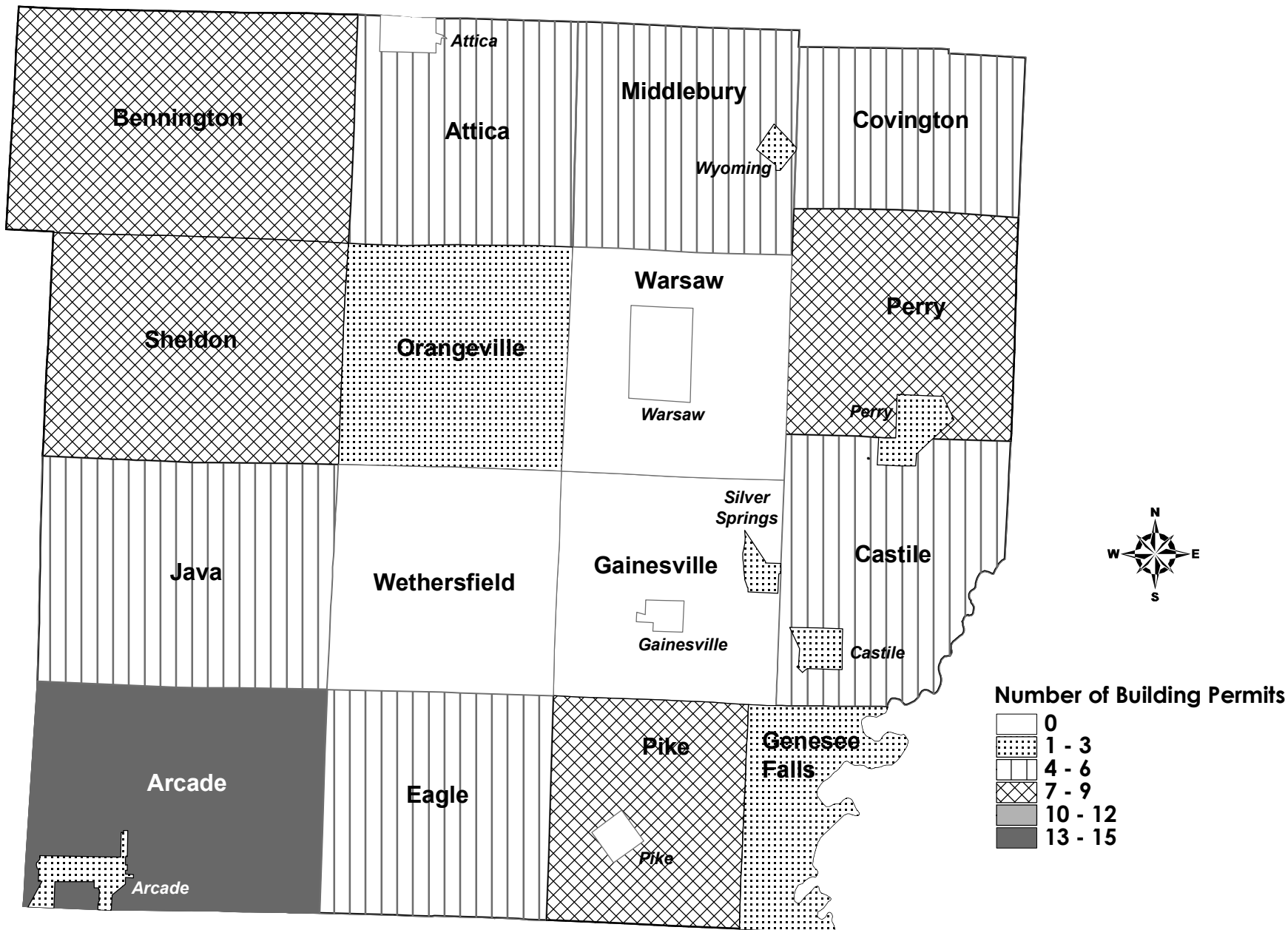

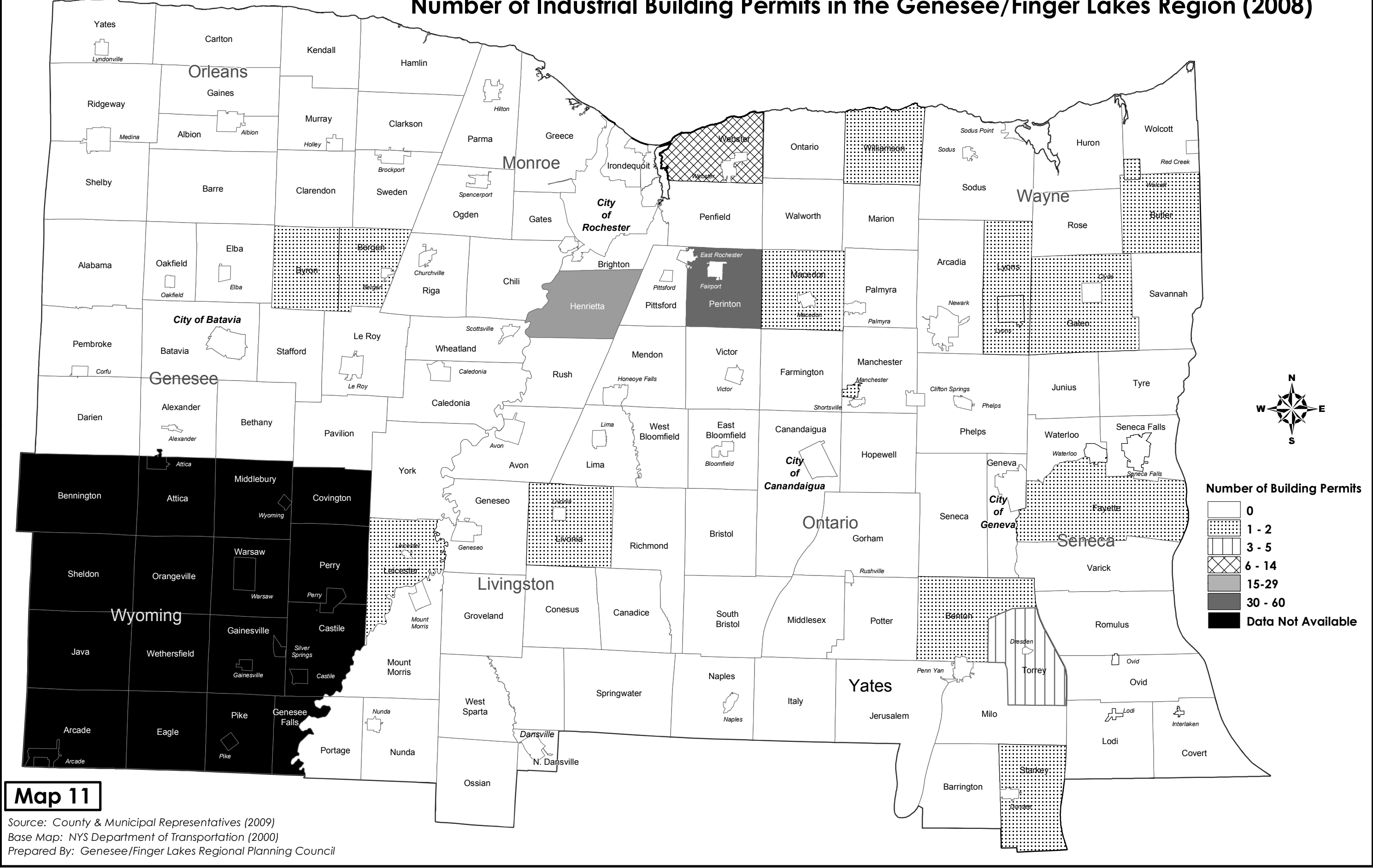
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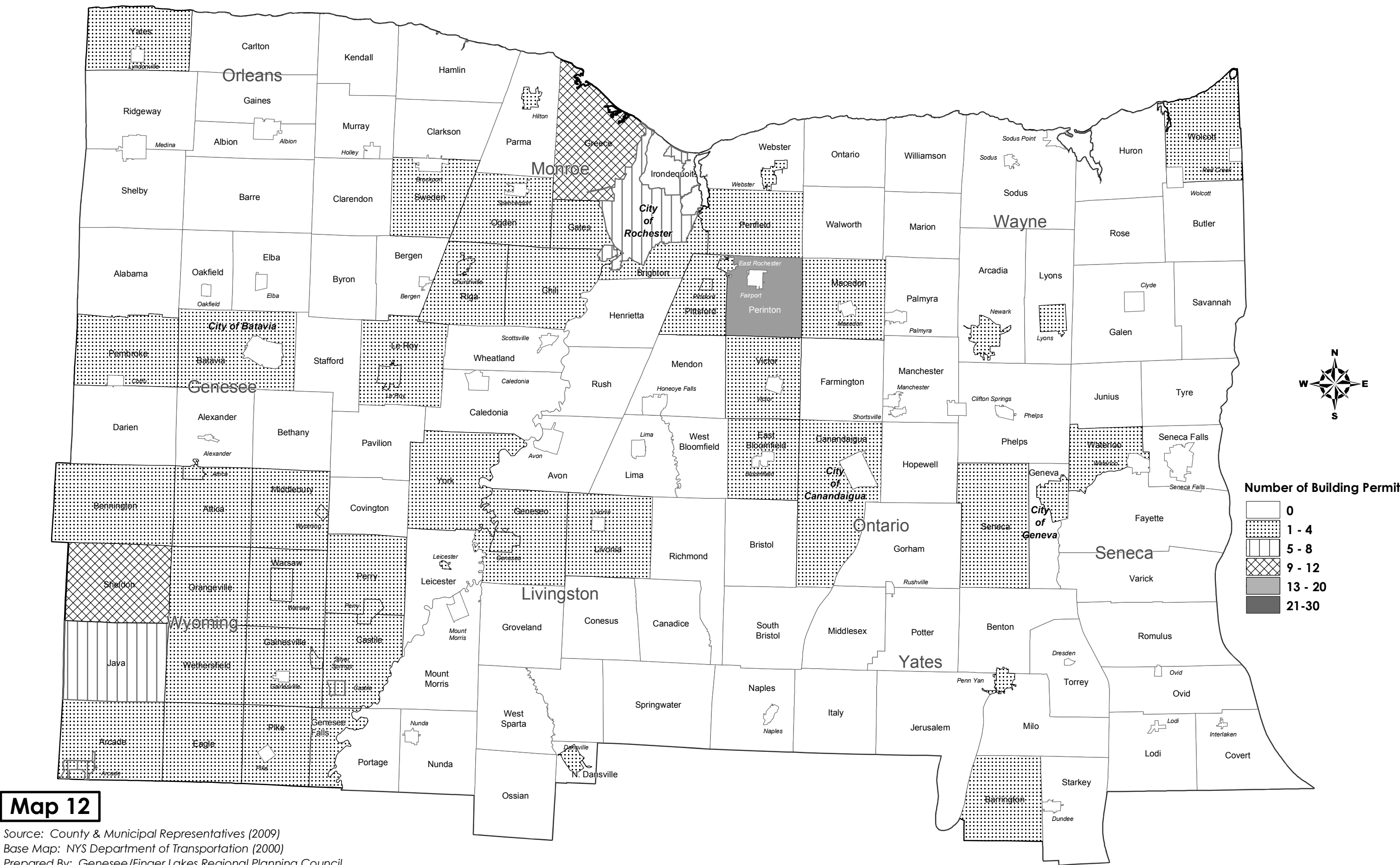
Number of Residential Unit Permits in the Genesee/Finger Lakes Region (2008)



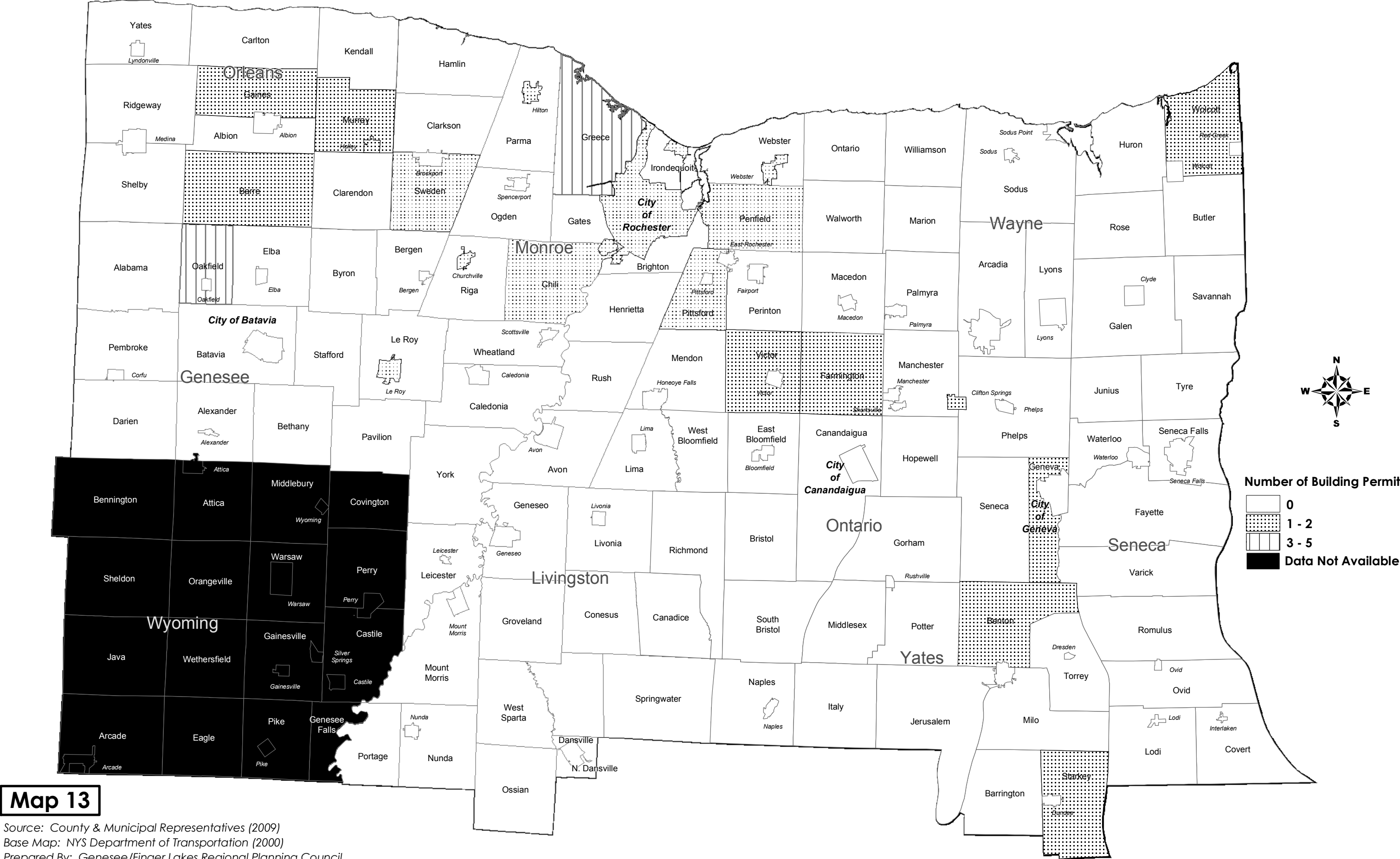

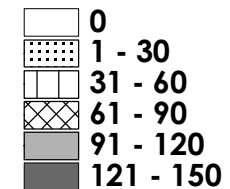

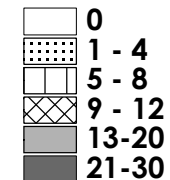

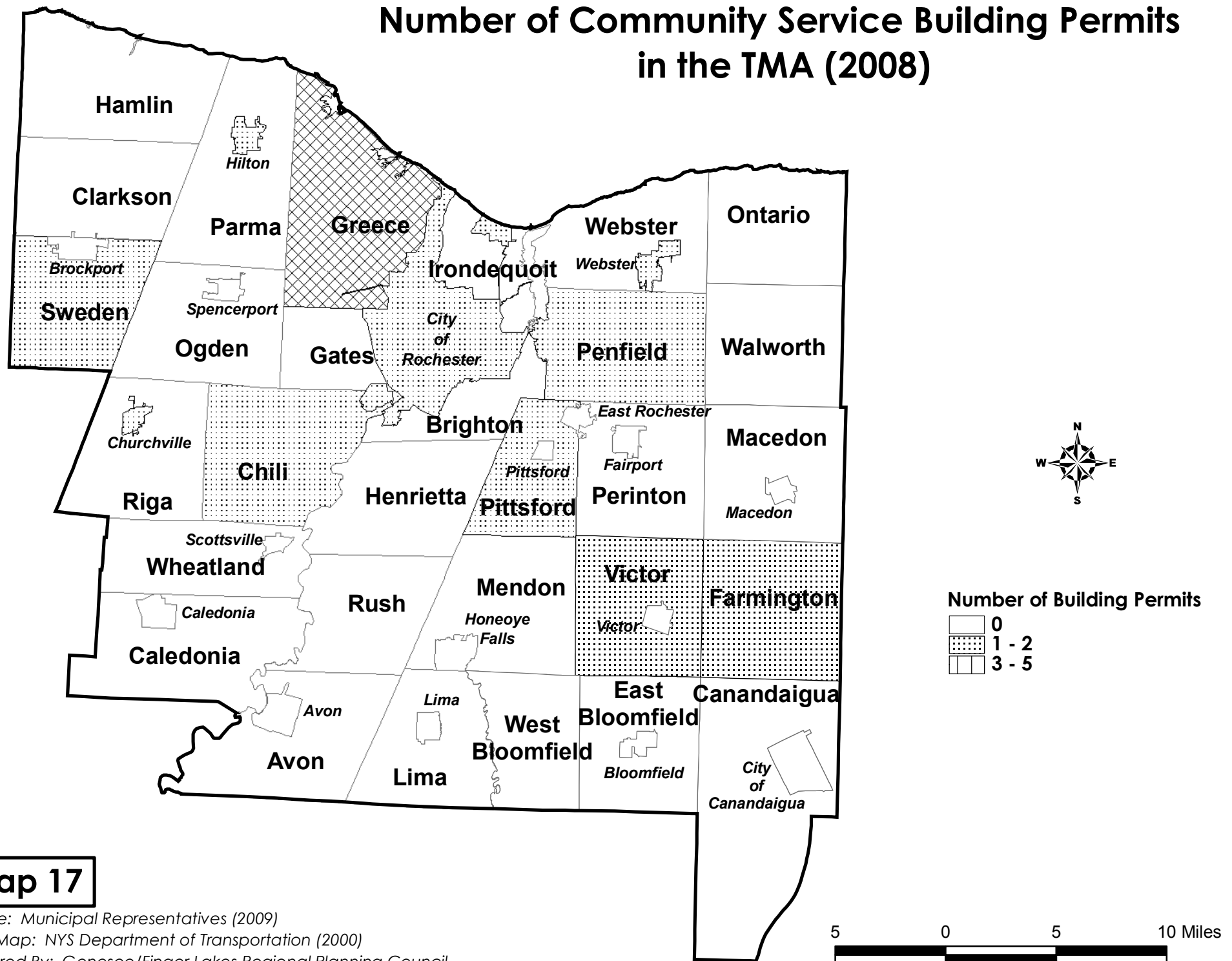

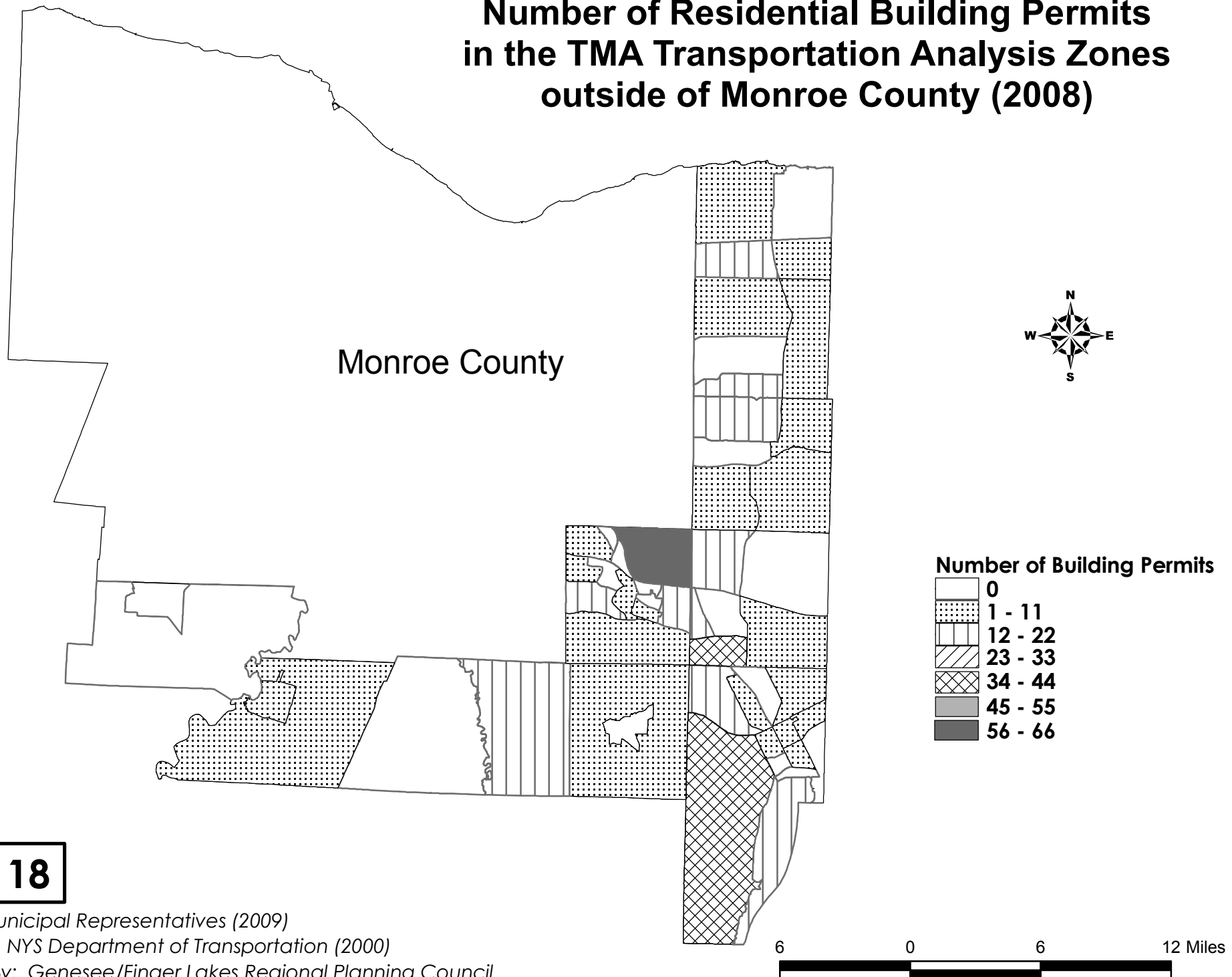

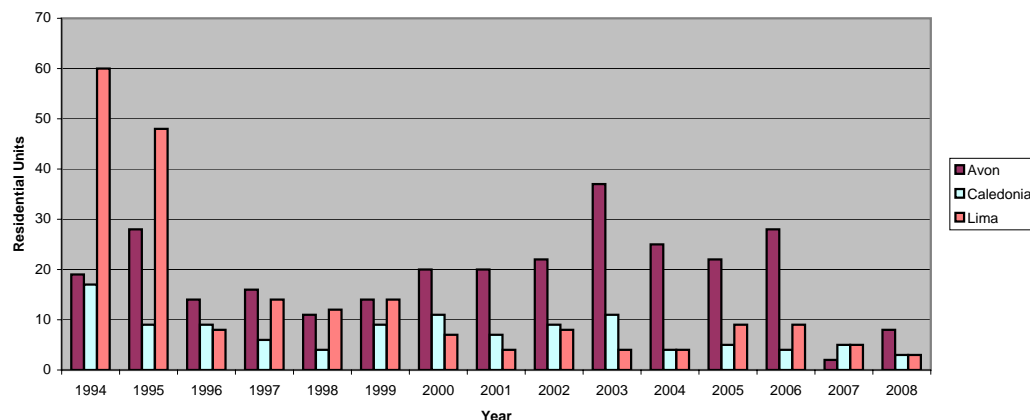

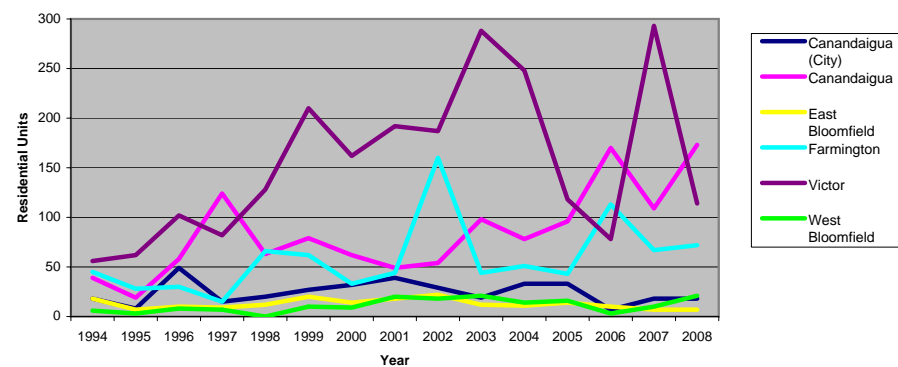
Towns with the Largest Numbers of Permitted Residential Units in Monroe County (1994 - 2008)



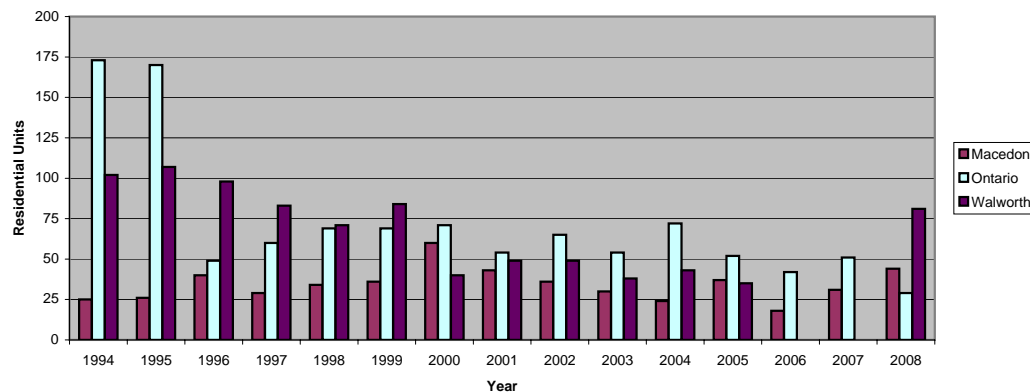
Number of Permitted Residential Units in Livingston County TMA Towns (1994 - 2008)

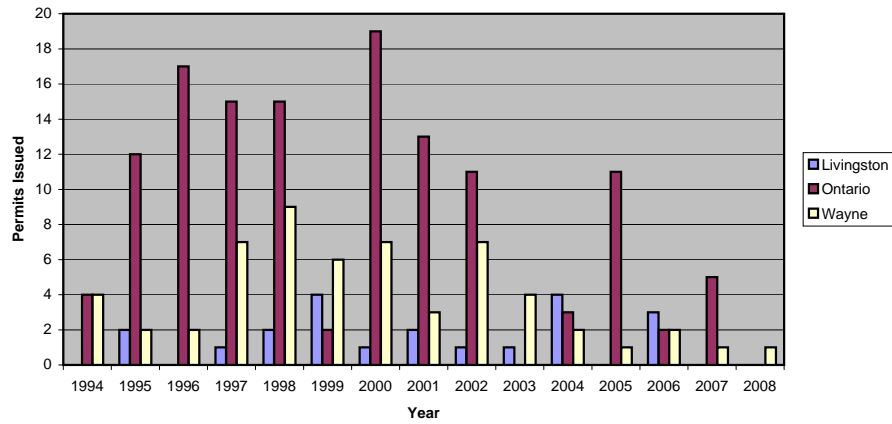

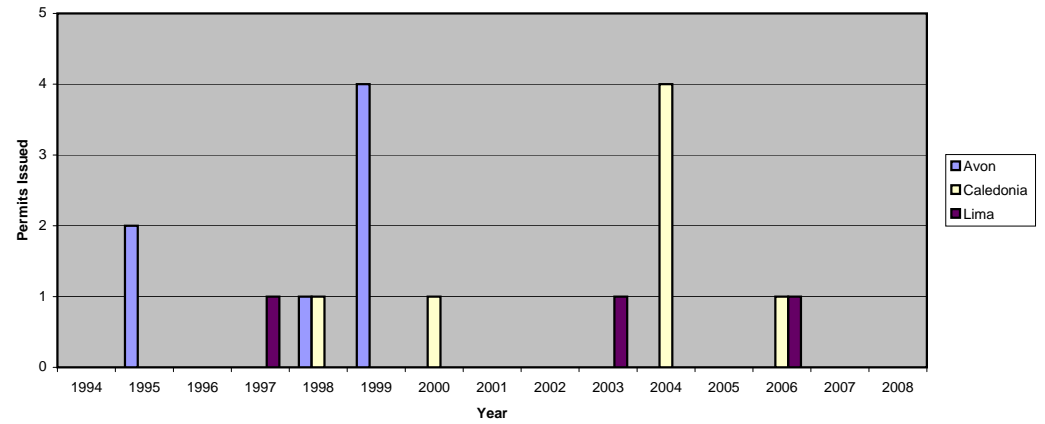

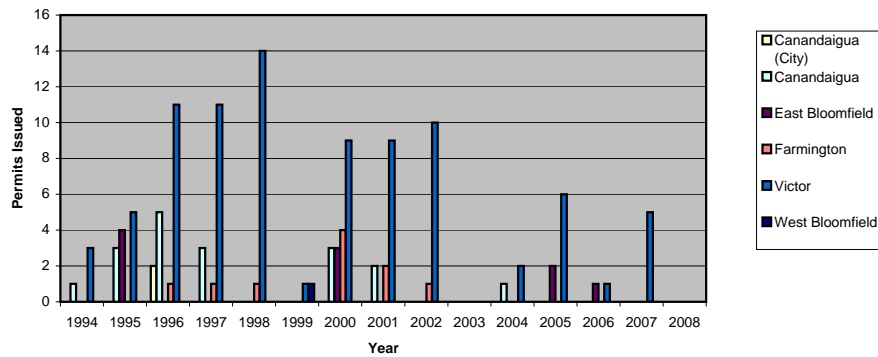

Towns by County (1994 - 2008)**



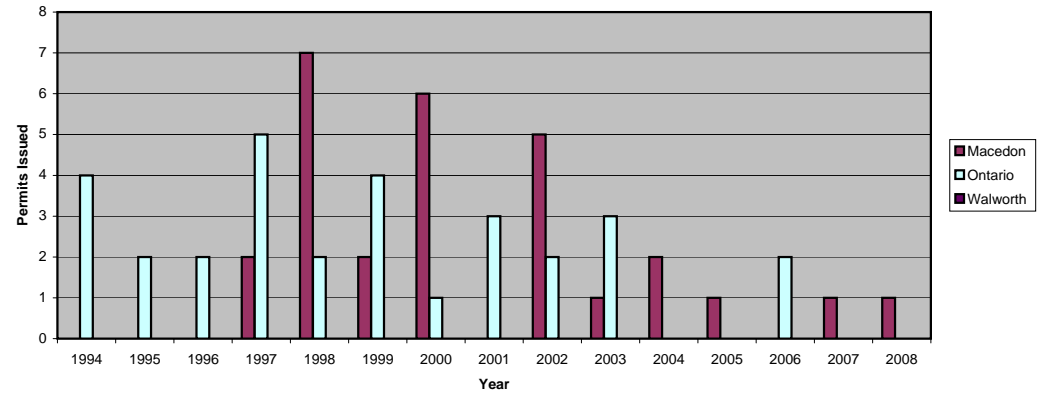
**Permits Issued for Industrial Buildings in Livingston County

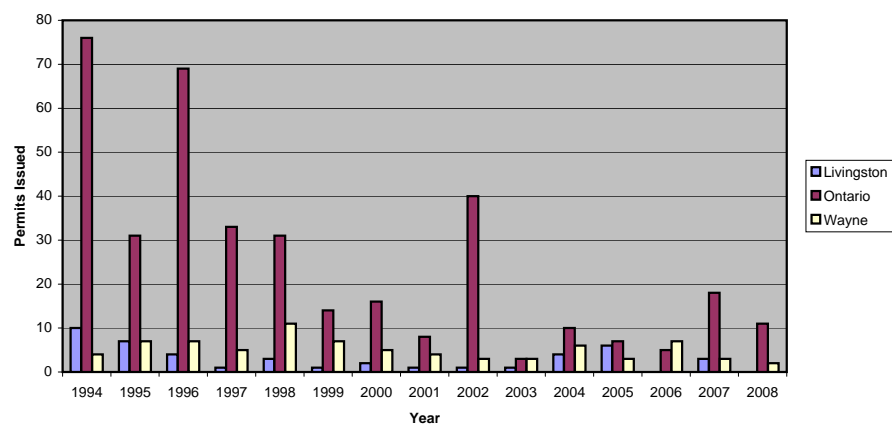

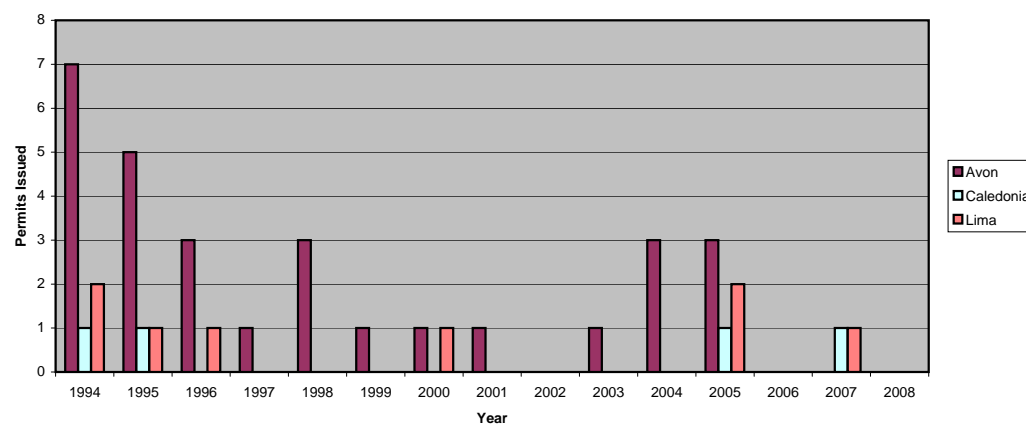

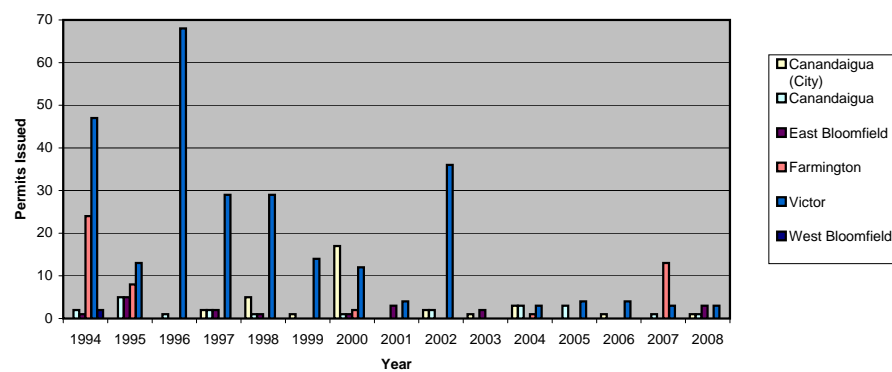
Permits Issued for Commercial Buildings in TMA (outside Monroe County)
