

# Regional Land Use Monitoring Report (2009) UPWP Task #4220

## Executive Summary

### **Project Purpose:**

The Genesee Transportation Council (GTC) provides funding annually for the *Regional Land Use Monitoring Report* under its Unified Planning Work Program. This report provides information on the issuance of building permits in 2009 to identify areas of growth within the Genesee-Finger Lakes Region (G-FL Region) that might require transportation planning and service modifications.

The G-FL Region is comprised of Genesee, Livingston, Monroe, Ontario, Orleans, Seneca, Wayne, Wyoming, and Yates Counties. The report analyzes the number of permits issued, total square footage, and total value for buildings for each municipality within the region as well as the Transportation Management Area (TMA). The TMA covers Monroe County and the municipalities adjacent to Monroe County in Livingston, Ontario, and Wayne Counties, as well as the Town and City of Canandaigua. The analysis looks at the following categories and respective subcategories: “residential” (single-family, two-family, three or four-family, five-or- more family, mobile/manufactured homes); “industrial;” “commercial” (offices/banks, retail/service, service stations, hotels/motels); “community service” (hospitals/health facilities, schools/churches, public works/safety, utilities); and “not elsewhere classified.”

A three-year trend analysis is provided for permitted residential units in all nine counties; industrial, commercial, and community service building permits are analyzed over the three-year period as well. In addition, a time series (or historical trend) analysis is provided for residential, industrial, and commercial development, as well as subdivision approvals in the Transportation Management Area (TMA).

This year’s LUMR survey included additional questions for municipalities to provide further insight into their data inventory. The questions related to zoning and total count units for residential, industrial, commercial and other structures within the municipality as of 2009.

### **Project Methodology:**

The building permit data included in this report was collected through surveys sent to the municipal or county officials responsible for the collection and dissemination of such data in the nine counties. In six counties, these officials were, in most municipalities, the code or zoning enforcement officers. In some cases they were municipal clerks. In Seneca and Wyoming Counties building permit application approval and inspection are the responsibility of the respective county building departments. Those two departments provided the data for their counties. The Monroe County Planning and Development Department’s Division of Planning administered the surveys, received the responses from

municipal officials in the County, and forwarded the data to the Genesee/Finger Lakes Regional Planning Council.

Surveys were distributed in January of 2010 asking for the requested data. The initial survey was followed up with a reminder postcard along with a telephone reminder to those municipalities that had yet to respond. In some cases, several calls were made to the appropriate parties in an effort to acquire the requested information. Complete data was collected for all 192 municipalities in the nine-county G-FL Region.

### **Analysis Overview:**

The highest number of residential permits in the G-FL Region in 2009 was in the Towns of Henrietta (169), Penfield (99), Greece (97), Chili (74) and Farmington (64). The Town of Henrietta issued 169 permits totaling the largest number of units (349). The highest number of residential permits issued by municipalities outside of Monroe County was the Towns of Victor, Farmington and Canandaigua in Ontario County issuing 66, 64 and 49 permits respectively and in the Towns of Ontario and Macedon in Wayne County issuing 27 and 25 respectively. The Town of Farmington issued 64 permits totaling the largest number of units (187) outside of Monroe County.

The majority of industrial and commercial permits were issued in municipalities in the TMA.

Over the years (1994 – 2009), the majority of permits for residential units in the TMA have been in Monroe County. In the TMA outside of Monroe County, the Towns of Victor, Canandaigua, and Farmington in Ontario County, and the Towns of Ontario and Walworth in Wayne County issued permits for the largest number of residential units over the same sixteen year time frame.

The data on permitted building activity and demolition tables are provided in appendices at the end of this report. Overall, the report serves as an information resource for the GTC and others to view and analyze permit activity in the G-FL Region to identify potential growth areas, and anticipate increased transportation needs.

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## Introduction

The Genesee Transportation Council (GTC) provides funding annually for the *Regional Land Use Monitoring Report* (LUMR) under its Unified Planning Work Program. The purpose of this report is to provide information for building permits by type, size, and value to identify areas of growth within the Genesee-Finger Lakes (G-FL) Region that may, as a result, require increased transportation planning and services.

The *Regional Land Use Monitoring Report* includes residential, industrial, commercial, and community service building permit data for all nine counties in the G-FL Region. Prior to 2000, the number of permits issued for commercial, industrial, and community service buildings was not available for Monroe County, and data on industrial and community service permits was not available for Wyoming County. The categories (and associated subcategories) for building permit data are as follows:

- Residential (single-family, two-family, three-or-four-family, five-or-more-family, and mobile/manufactured homes )
- Industrial
- Commercial (offices/banks, retail/service, service stations, hotels/motels)
- Community Service (hospitals, schools)
- Not Elsewhere Classified

A three-year trend analysis is provided for permitted residential units in all nine counties and industrial, commercial and community service building permits are analyzed over the three-year period. This time-series analysis is based on this

year's and the two previous years' Land Use Monitoring Reports produced by the Genesee/Finger Lakes Regional Planning Council (G/FLRPC).

In addition, a time series (or historical trend) analysis is provided for residential, industrial, and commercial development and subdivision approvals in the Transportation Management Area (TMA).

The TMA includes Monroe County and the adjacent municipalities to the south and east as well as the City and Town of Canandaigua. Table 1 represents the municipalities that, along with Monroe County, comprise the Transportation Management Area.

An analysis of the collected data on the number, value, and size of buildings permitted in 2009 is provided for each county as well as the TMA. Given that many conclusions can be drawn from the data on permitted building activity tables are provided in appendices at the end of this report for the reader to use for their own needs and analysis.

## **Methodology**

The building permit data included in this report was collected through surveys sent to the municipal or county officials responsible for the collection and dissemination of such data in the nine counties. In six counties these officials were, in most cases, the code or zoning enforcement officers; in some cases the municipal clerks. In Seneca and Wyoming Counties building permit application approval and inspection are the responsibility of the respective county building departments. Those two departments provided the data for their counties. The Monroe County Planning and Development Department's Division of Planning administered the surveys, received the responses from municipal officials in the County, and forwarded the data to G/FLRPC.

As noted above, each municipality other than Seneca and Wyoming Counties received a survey in January of 2010 asking for the requested data. The initial survey was followed up with a reminder postcard along with a telephone reminder to those municipalities that had yet to respond. In some cases, several calls were made to the appropriate parties in an effort to acquire the requested information. Overall, 100% of the data was collected from all 192 municipalities within the nine-county G-FL Region.

The survey requested information on the number of permits issued, total square footage and total value for buildings in the defined categories and associated subcategories. In addition, the same building permit information for buildings outside of these categories was requested along with a description of the type of building(s) in the "Other" category. This year the LUMR survey included an additional request

from municipalities. All analysis conducted in this report is based on data provided by each LUMR survey contact.

The instructions for completing the survey as printed on the first of the two-page document were as follows:

*"Include only permits for the construction of buildings in 2009. Do not include additions, repairs, decks, in-ground pools, etc. or buildings used for storage such as sheds and pole barns. Do not include permits for construction that was completed in 2009 but permitted in a previous calendar year. If the responses below include a town and a village on the same sheet, please denote this by listing them separately on the same line (example: T - 8/ V - 12)."*

For each of the nine counties, there is a discussion of permitted building activity in 2009 and county maps of residential units permitted in 2009 by municipality (Maps 1 - 9, Map 10 represents Permits for Residential Units for the nine-county G-FL Region). Data of industrial, commercial, and community service building permits issued in 2009 are presented on maps of the nine-county G-FL Region (Maps 11-13).

The information and data provided for permitted building activity in Monroe County and the remaining portion of the TMA follows the same format. Maps 14 through 17 present the number of permitted residential, industrial, commercial, and community service buildings in the TMA in 2009. Map 18 shows the distribution of residential building permits among the Transportation Analysis Zones (TAZ) within the TMA outside of Monroe County.

The residential data for TMA municipalities were used in a time series analysis of the number of residential units permitted by municipality for the years 1994 through 2009. The

number of permits issued for industrial and commercial buildings from 1994 to 2009 in the TMA outside of Monroe County is also presented and discussed in the same manner.

A three-year time series analysis of permits issued by municipalities in the G-FL Region that responded to the survey all three years are provided for permits that were issued for buildings across all categories. Data for Wyoming County between 2007 and 2009 are provided for all but industrial and community service buildings.

The data gathered on number of building permits issued, square footage, and value in each category/subcategory by municipality in and for the TMA outside Monroe County are presented in Appendices A through H. The Appendices are as follows:

## **2009 County Building Permit Analysis**

### **Genesee County**

#### ***Residential Permits:***

- Thirty seven (37) residential building permits were issued in Genesee County in 2009. The largest number of permits (7) was issued in the Town of Batavia. Permits issued totaled 23,725 square feet with a combined value of \$3,899,000. The Town of Leroy issued the second highest total of permits with six. The City of Batavia issued four permits, two single-family home permits and two multi-unit home permits that were comprised of 79 units with a value of \$23,309,400.
- Approximately 58% of the 37 residential building permits issued were from the City and Town of Batavia, and the Towns of Leroy and Darien.
- The number of permits issued in Genesee County in 2009 for mobile/manufactured homes was five.
- There were two permits issued for multi-units, up from zero that were issued in 2008.

#### ***Industrial Permits:***

- There was no industrial building permits issued in 2009.

*Map 11 shows the number of industrial building permits by municipality in the G-FL Region in 2009.*

#### ***Commercial Permits:***

- Two commercial building permits were issued in Genesee County, one in the Town of Batavia and one in the Town of LeRoy.

*Map 12 shows the number of commercial building permits by municipality in the G-FL Region in 2009.*

#### ***Community Service Permits:***

- No permits for community service buildings were reported for Genesee County municipalities in 2009.

*Map 13 shows the number of community service building permits by municipality in the G-FL Region in 2009.*

#### ***Not Elsewhere Classified Permits:***

- One permit that did not correspond to the above-described categories was included as not elsewhere classified. The Town of Darien issued a permit for a cow barn covering 5,400 square feet.

#### ***Demolition Permits:***

- Twenty eight (28) residential demolitions were permitted in Genesee County in 2009.

## Livingston County

### ***Residential Permits:***

- Seventy four (74) residential permits, for 82 units, were issued in Livingston County in 2009. The largest number of single-family homes was permitted in the Town of Livonia (16). The Town of Avon issued the next highest with 13 permits. The Town of Conesus issued seven permits and the Towns of Leicester and Sparta each issued five permits.

### ***Industrial Permits:***

- In 2009, municipalities in Livingston County issued four permits for industrial buildings. Three of the permits were issued in the Town of Groveland and one in the Town of North Dansville.

### ***Commercial Permits:***

- Three permits were issued for commercial buildings. One permit each was issued in the Villages of Danville and Mount Morris as well as in the Town of York.

### ***Community Service Permits:***

- One permit for community service buildings was issued in Livingston County in 2009 in the Town of Lima.

*Map 13 shows the number of community service building permits by municipality in the G-FL Region in 2009.*

### ***Not Elsewhere Classified Permits:***

- Nine permits were issued that did not correspond to the above-described categories were included as not elsewhere classified for Livingston County in 2009. Four of those permits were issued in the Town of York and one each in the Towns of Avon, Conesus, Groveland, Leicester, and West Sparta.

### ***Demolition Permits:***

- Twenty seven (27) demolitions were permitted in Livingston County in 2009; all were issued for residential structures.

## Monroe County

### ***Residential Permits:***

- Municipalities in Monroe County issued 743 residential building permits for a total of 1,275 residential units in 2009. The largest number of permits issued was in the Town of Henrietta (169) with a total value of \$28,064,633. The Town of Henrietta issued 72 multi-family permits for 252 units.

The Town of Penfield issued the next largest number of single-family unit permits (99) followed by the Town of Greece (97), the Town of Chili (74) and the Town of Webster (56).

The City of Rochester issued 38 residential building permits comprised of 186 units with a value of \$25,132,572.

- A total of 146 multi-family unit permits were issued for 678 units in the county.
- Eight mobile/manufactured home permits were issued in the county with the Town of Hamlin issuing the highest amount of permits (5) valued at \$254,000.

***Map 3 shows the number of residential unit permits in Monroe County in 2009.***

### ***Industrial Permits:***

- Twenty seven (27) permits were issued in the entire County. The largest number of industrial permits was issued in the Town of Henrietta (18) followed by the City of Rochester with four.

***Map 11 shows the number of industrial building permits by municipality in the G-FL Region in 2009.***

### ***Commercial Permits:***

- In the category of commercial buildings, 33 permits with a total value of \$26,574,300 were issued in Monroe County. The Towns of Pittsford and Greece both issued five permits.

***Map 12 shows the number of commercial building permits by municipality in the G-FL Region in 2009.***

### ***Community Service Permits:***

- One permit was issued for community service buildings in Monroe County. The permit was issued in the Town of Chili.

***Map 13 shows the number of community service building permits by municipality in the G-FL Region in 2009.***

### ***Not Elsewhere Classified Permits:***

- Ten (10) permits were issued in Monroe County that did not correspond to the above-described categories and were included as not elsewhere classified.

### ***Demolition Permits:***

- Of all the counties in the G-FL Region, the most demolitions in 2009 were permitted in Monroe County. Three hundred eighty six (386) demolition permits were issued. The City of Rochester was the highest with 301.

## Ontario County

### ***Residential Permits:***

- Ontario County municipalities permitted 279 residential structures in 2009, for a total of 402 units. The Town of Victor issued the most permits with 66. The Town of Farmington issued the second most permits with 64 with total units at 187. The Town of Canandaigua issued the next most permits (49).

***Map 4 shows the number of residential unit permits in Ontario County in 2009.***

### ***Industrial Permits:***

- There were four industrial building permits issued in Ontario County in 2009. Three permits were issued in the Town of Victor covering 31,646 square feet with a value of \$3,647,545. The City of Geneva also issued a permit.

***Map 11 shows the number of industrial building permits by municipality in the G-FL Region in 2009.***

### ***Commercial Permits:***

- Eleven commercial building permits were issued in Ontario County. Six of the permits were issued in the Town of Victor with a value of \$12,560,000. The Town of Geneva issued three permits and the City of Canandaigua and the Village of Victor each issued one permit.

### ***Community Service Permits:***

- There were no permits issued for community service buildings in Ontario County in 2009.

***Map 13 shows the number of community service building permits by municipality in the G-FL Region in 2009.***

### ***Not Elsewhere Classified Permits:***

- Three permits were issued in Ontario County that did not correspond to the above-described categories and were included as not elsewhere classified. Two permits were issued in the Town of Hopewell and one in the Town of Seneca.

### ***Demolition Permits:***

- Sixty (60) residential demolitions were permitted in Ontario County in 2009, with the Towns of Manchester, Canadice and South Bristol each issuing nine, seven, and seven respectively.

## Orleans County

### ***Residential Permits:***

- A total of 30 residential building permits were issued in Orleans County in 2009 consisting of 25 single-family structures and 5 mobile homes. The Town of Yates issued the largest number of permits in the County with seven. The Town of Carlton issued the next largest number of permits with five.

### ***Industrial Permits:***

- No industrial building permits were reported in Orleans County in 2009.

### ***Commercial Permits:***

- No commercial building permits were reported in 2009.

### ***Community Service Permits:***

- No community service permits were reported for Orleans County in 2009.

*Map 13 shows the number of community service building permits by municipality in the G-FL Region in 2009.*

### ***Not Elsewhere Classified Permits:***

- All reported permits correspond to the above described categories therefore none are included as not elsewhere classified.

### ***Demolition Permits:***

- Orleans County permitted 23 residential demolitions in 2009. The Village of Medina issued the most permits with six followed by the Towns of Gaines and Barre with five each.

## Seneca County

### ***Residential Permits:***

- Fifty two (52) residential building units were reported in Seneca County in 2009. The largest number of permits issued where in the Towns of Junuis and Lodi with eight each followed by the Towns of Waterloo, Romulus, and Ovid each issuing seven, six, and five, respectively.

### ***Industrial Permits:***

- No industrial building permits were issued in Seneca County in 2009.

*Map 11 shows the number of industrial building permits by municipality in the G-FL Region in 2009.*

### ***Commercial Permits:***

- Six commercial building permits were issued in Seneca County in 2009. Two of those permits were issued in the Town of Waterloo as well as one each in the Towns of Fayette, Ovid, Romulus and Seneca Falls.

### ***Community Service Permits:***

- No community service buildings were reported in Seneca County for 2009.

*Map 13 shows the number of community service building permits by municipality in the G-FL Region in 2009.*

### ***Not Elsewhere Classified Permits:***

- One permit each was issued in the Towns of Covert and Fayette.

### ***Demolition Permits:***

- Thirteen (13) demolition permits were issued in Seneca County in 2009. All demolition permits issued were for residential buildings.
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## Wayne County

### ***Residential Permits:***

- Municipalities in Wayne County issued 155 permits in 2009. The highest total of permits issued in the County was in the Town of Ontario (27) followed by the Town of Macedon (25). The Towns of Walworth, Sodus and Williamson issued 14, 13 and 13 permits respectively. There were 34 permits issued for mobile/manufactured homes with the Towns of Sodus and Marion issuing five and four permits respectively.

***Map 7 shows the number of residential unit permits in Wayne County in 2009.***

### ***Industrial Permits:***

- Five permits were issued for industrial buildings in Wayne County in 2009. Two permits were issued in the Towns of Macedon and Marion. One permit was issued in the Village of Newark.

***Map 11 shows the number of industrial building permits by municipality in the G-FL Region in 2009.***

### ***Commercial Permits:***

- Seven permits were issued for commercial buildings in 2009. The Town of Arcadia issued four permits related to retail/service and the Town of Macedon issued the remaining three permits.

***Map 12 shows the number of commercial building permits by municipality in the G-FL Region in 2009.***

### ***Community Service Permits:***

- One permit was issued for a community service building in Wayne County for 2009 in the Town of Galen.

***Map 13 shows the number of community service building permits by municipality in the G-FL Region in 2009.***

### ***Not Elsewhere Classified Permits:***

- Forty Three (43) permits that did not correspond to the above-described categories were included as not elsewhere classified. The Town of Sodus issued 39 of these permits.

### ***Demolition Permits:***

- Fifty one (51) demolition permits were reported in Wayne County in 2009.

## Wyoming County

### **Residential Permits:**

- In 2009, municipalities in Wyoming County issued 66 permits for residential structures. The Town of Arcade issued the most permits with 11. The Towns of Bennington, Castile, and Genesee Falls each issued seven, six and five permits respectively. The Towns of Covington, Java, Orangeville, Pike, Sheldon, and the Village of Wyoming issued four permits each.

*Map 8 shows the number of residential unit permits in Wyoming County in 2009.*

### **Industrial Permits:**

*(Wyoming County does not categorize Industrial permits)*

- The information reported by Wyoming County for permits issued does not correspond directly to the survey categories. Information related to industrial permits is not categorized by Wyoming County but it is categorized under commercial permits. Therefore it is unclear how many permits were issued for industrial buildings in the County in 2009.

*Map 11 shows the number of industrial building permits by municipality in the G-FL Region in 2009.*

### **Commercial Permits:**

- A total of 51 permits were issued for commercial buildings in the County in 2009. The Town of Bennington issued the most with 17 permits.

*Map 12 shows the number of commercial building permits by municipality in the G-FL Region in 2009.*

### **Community Service Permits:**

*(Wyoming County does not categorize community service permits)*

- The Information reported by Wyoming County for permits issued does not correspond directly to the survey categories. Information related to community service permits is not categorized by Wyoming County. Therefore, it is unclear how many permits were issued for community service buildings in the County in 2009.

*Map 13 shows the number of community service building permits by municipality in the G-FL Region in 2009.*

### **Not Elsewhere Classified Permits:**

*(Wyoming County does not specify not elsewhere classified permits)*

- The Information reported by Wyoming County for permits issued, does not correspond directly to the survey categories. Therefore it is unclear how many permits were issued for not elsewhere classified in the County in 2009.

### **Demolition Permits:**

- Twelve (12) unspecified demolition permits were issued in Wyoming County in 2009.
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## Yates County

### ***Residential Permits:***

- Municipalities in Yates County issued 97 residential building permits in 2009. The Towns of Jerusalem issued the most permits with 25 followed by the Towns of Milo, Barrington, Benton, and Italy with 15, 14, 10 and 10 respectively.

### ***Industrial Permits:***

- No industrial building permits were issued in 2009.

### ***Commercial Permits:***

- No permits were reported for commercial buildings in Yates County for 2009.

### ***Community Service Permits:***

- No community service building permits were issued in Yates County in 2009.

*Map 13 shows the number of community service building permits by municipality in the G-FL Region in 2009.*

### ***Not Elsewhere Classified Permits:***

- Three permits were issued in Yates County for buildings not elsewhere classified. One each in the Village of Penn Yan and in the Towns of Starkey and Torrey

### ***Demolition Permits:***

- Yates County permitted 11 residential demolitions in 2009.

### **3-Year Building Permit Analysis (2007 – 2009)**

#### **Genesee County**

*Data for the following municipalities was not available for 2007: the Towns of Bethany, Byron, and Pavilion. Data was reported for all municipalities in Genesee County for 2008-2009.*

##### ***Residential Units:***

- During the three-year period from 2007 through 2009, the total number of units permitted was 304. In 2007, 137 units were permitted. That number decreased to 53 in 2008 and increased to 114 in 2009.
- The City of Batavia permitted the most residential units in Genesee County with 131. The Town of Batavia issued the next highest number of units (55). The Towns of LeRoy, Darien and Pembroke had the next highest number of units with 20, 17 and 13 respectively, and the Towns of Alabama and Stafford followed with 12 and nine units respectively.

##### ***Industrial Units:***

- A total of six units were permitted for industrial buildings in Genesee County from 2007 to 2009. The Town of Bergen permitted one unit in 2007 and one in 2008. The Town of Stafford permitted two industrial units in 2007.
- Industrial building units permitted decreased from four in 2007 to two in 2008, with no permits issued in 2009.

##### ***Commercial Units:***

- Seventeen (17) commercial units were permitted in Genesee County from 2007 to 2009. The Town of Batavia issued the most units permitted with 10. The Town of LeRoy issued three commercial unit permits and the Town of Pembroke issued two commercial unit permits from 2007-2009. The total number of commercial unit permits increased from seven in 2007, to eight in 2008, and decreased to two in 2009.

##### ***Community Service Units:***

- Five commercial units were permitted from 2007 to 2009, with the Town of Oakfield issuing the most community service units with three.
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## Livingston County

*Data for the following municipalities was not available for 2007: the Towns of North Dansville, Portage, and the Village of Leicester. Data was reported for all municipalities in Livingston County for 2008-2009.*

### **Residential Units:**

- The number of residential units permitted in Livingston County has steadily declined over the past three years from 136 in 2007, to 88 in 2008, and 83 in 2009.
- The Town of Livonia issued permits for 56 residential units from 2007 to 2009, more than any other municipality in Livingston County. The Village of Nunda permitted the next largest number of residential units with 25, followed by the Town of Avon with 23.

### **Industrial Units:**

- Twelve (12) industrial permits were reported in Livingston County from 2007 to 2009. The Towns of Groveland and Livonia both permitted the most industrial units with three. The Village of Livonia and North Dansville permitted two industrial units.
- The number of industrial units permitted in Livingston County has varied slightly over the last three years, with an increase in 2008. In 2007, two units were permitted followed by six in 2008 and four in 2009.

### **Commercial Units:**

- Twenty two (22) commercial units were permitted from 2007 to 2009. The number of units permitted for commercial structures in Livingston County has steadily increased with a drop in 2009. Units permitted include seven in 2007, 12 in 2008 and three in 2009.

- The Village of Dansville permitted the largest number of commercial units with five. The Town and Village of Geneseo permitted four and three commercial units from 2007-2009.

### **Community Service Units:**

- Fifteen (15) community service units were permitted in Livingston County from 2007-2009. The Town of Conesus issued the largest number of units (5) followed by the Town of York with four units permitted.
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## Monroe County

*Data for the Town/Village of East Rochester was not available for 2007. Data was reported for all municipalities in Monroe County for 2008-2009.*

### **Residential Units:**

- Three thousand five hundred one (3,501) residential units were permitted in Monroe County between 2007 and 2009. Monroe County issued the most residential permits and totaled the most units in the region. The number of units permitted over the past three years went from 1,160 in 2007, to 1,067 in 2008, to 1,274 in 2009.
- The Town of Henrietta permitted the largest number of residential units (729) followed by the Towns of Greece (387) and Penfield (362), the City of Rochester (336), and the Towns of Webster (333), Chili (320), Ogden (188), and Perinton (122).

### **Industrial Units:**

*The Towns of Chili and Penfield do not categorize industrial and commercial permits.*

- During the last three years, a total of 127 industrial units were permitted in Monroe County. The Town of Perinton permitted the most (60), all of which were issued in 2009. The Town of Henrietta permitted 52 units during 2007-2009. The number of industrial building units permitted in Monroe County rose sharply from 25 in 2007, to 75 in 2008 but experienced a decline with 27 in 2009.

### **Commercial Units:**

*The Towns of Chili and Penfield do not categorize industrial and commercial permits.*

- A total of 162 commercial building permits were issued from 2007 to 2009. During the period from 2007-2009, the Town of Penfield permitted the greatest number of commercial units with 49. The Town of Greece issued 20, and the Town of Perinton permitted 18.

### **Community Service Units:**

- Twenty three (23) community service building units were issued in Monroe County from 2007 to 2009. The Town of Greece issued the most with five over the three year period.

*Data for the Village of Naples was not available for 2007. Data was reported for all municipalities in Ontario County for 2008-2009.*

### ***Residential Units:***

- One thousand six hundred fifty (1,650) residential units were permitted in Ontario County from 2007 to 2009. Ontario County issued the second most residential permits and totaled the second most units in the region.
- Residential units permitted have steadily declined over the past three years from 695 in 2007, to 553 in 2008, and to 402 in 2009.

### ***Industrial Units:***

- Eleven (11) industrial units were permitted in Ontario County from 2007 to 2009. The Town of Victor permitted eight of these units. The Town of Bristol, the City of Geneva, and the Village of Manchester all permitted one industrial unit.

### ***Commercial Units:***

- Forty four (44) commercial units were permitted in Ontario County from 2007 to 2009. Ontario County's commercial units have steadily declined over the three-year period from 20 in 2007, to 13 in 2008, and 11 in 2009.
- The Town of Farmington permitted 13 units, the most of any municipality in Ontario County. The Towns of East Bloomfield, Geneva, Hopewell and Seneca all issued three permits from 2007-2009

### ***Community Service Units:***

- Eight community service units were permitted in Ontario County.

## Orleans County

*Data for the following municipalities was not available for 2007: the Towns of Barre and Murray; Villages of Albion and Holley. Data was reported for all municipalities in Orleans County for 2008-2009.*

### ***Residential Units:***

- Residential units permitted steadily declined during the last three years (2007 – 2009). In 2007, Orleans County municipalities permitted a total of 63 residential units. That number decreased to 35 units in 2008 and 30 in 2009.
- The Village of Medina permits issued totaled 28 units. The Town of Carlton permits totaled 23 units. The Towns of Clarendon and Gaines permitted 17 and 10 units respectively over the three year period, while the Towns of Kendall and Ridgeway permitted nine units each.

### ***Industrial Units:***

- No industrial permits were reported from 2007-2009.

### ***Commercial Units:***

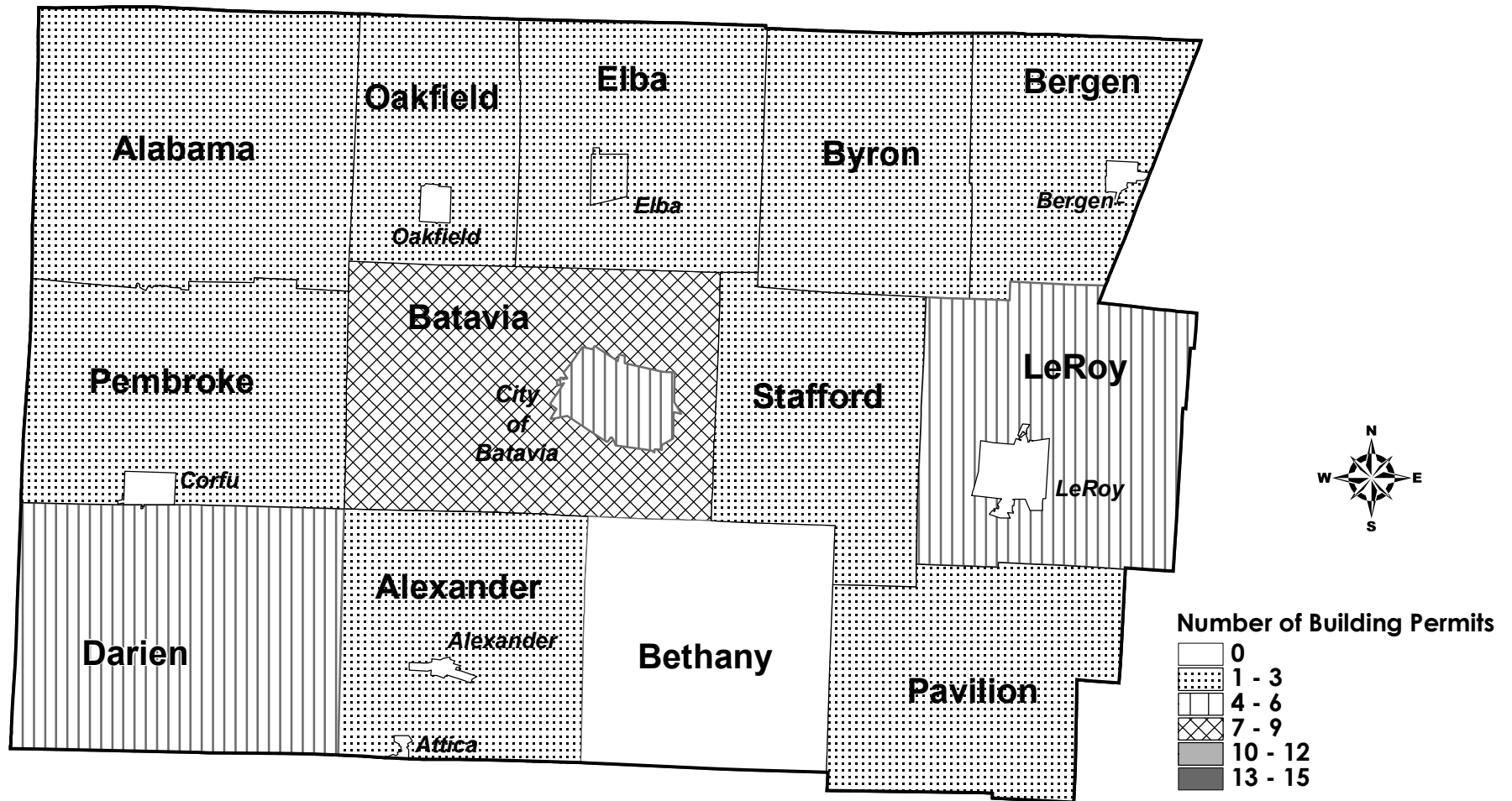

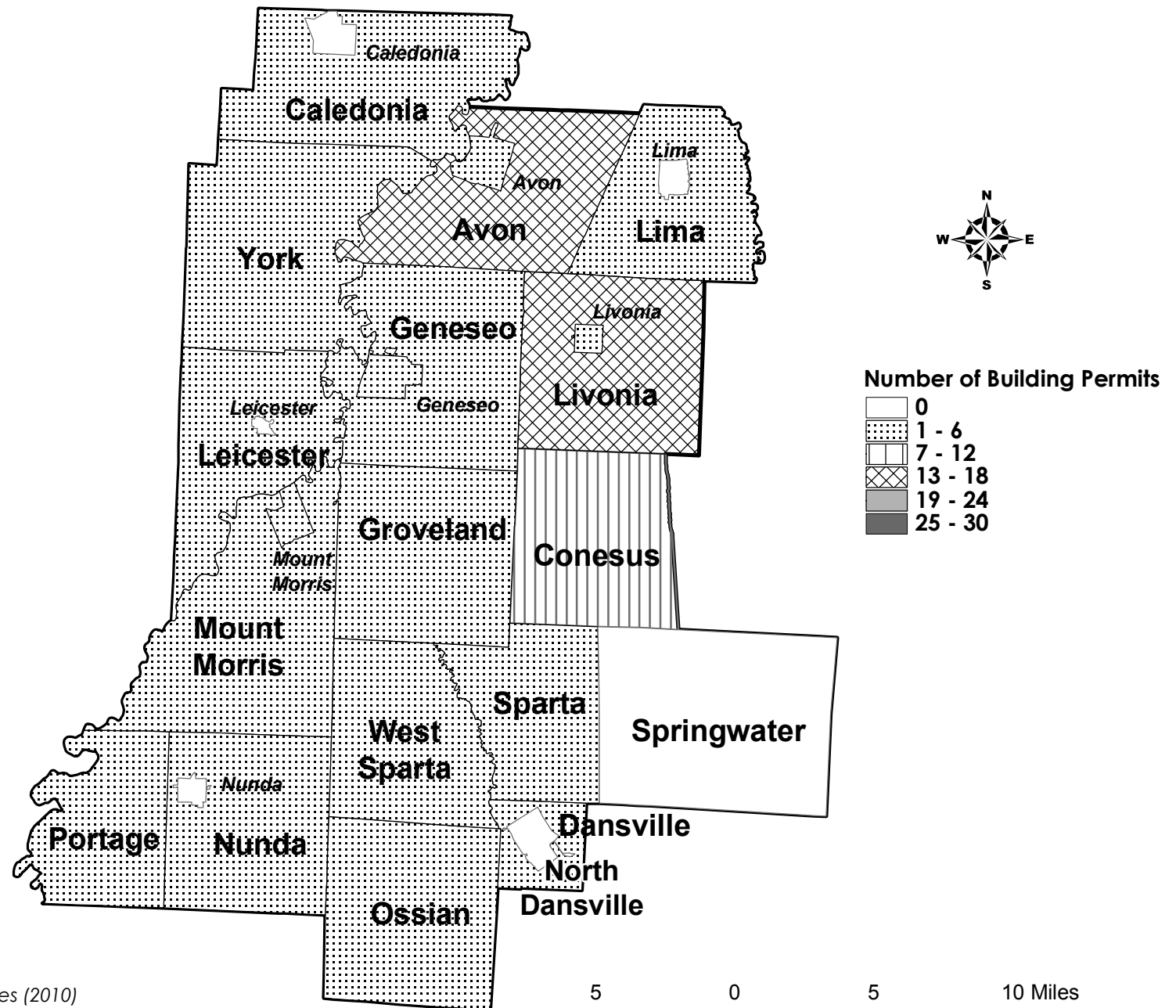

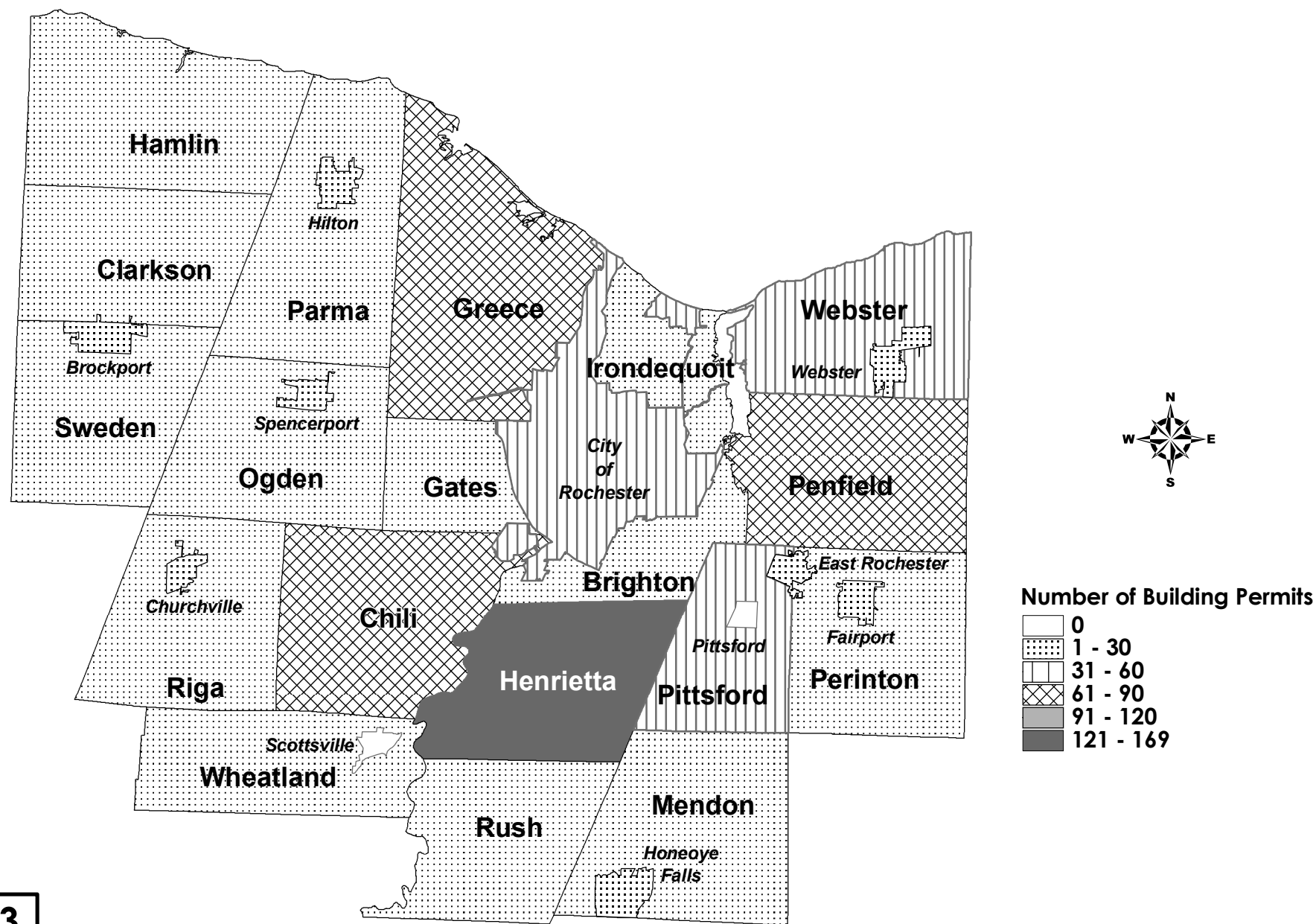

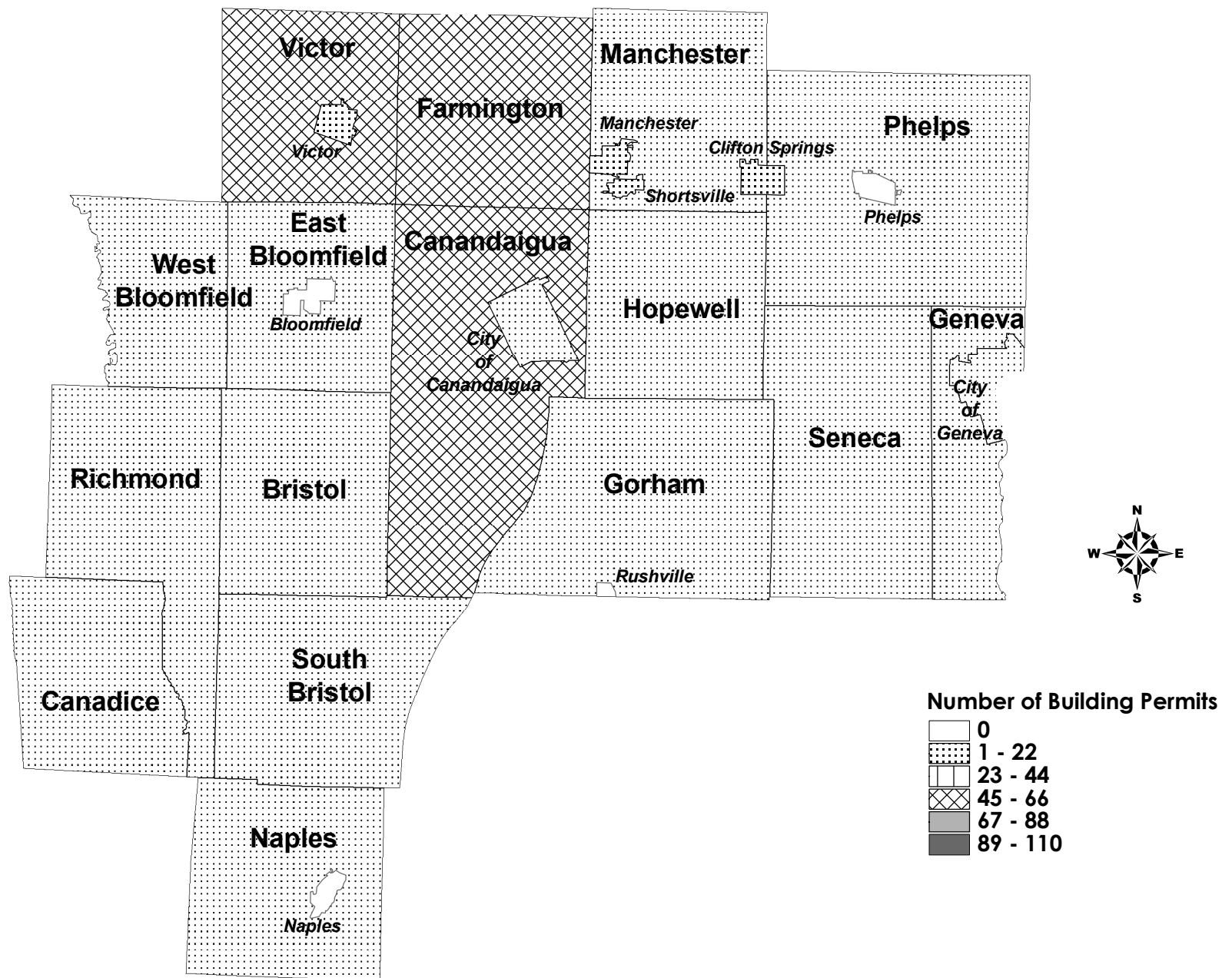

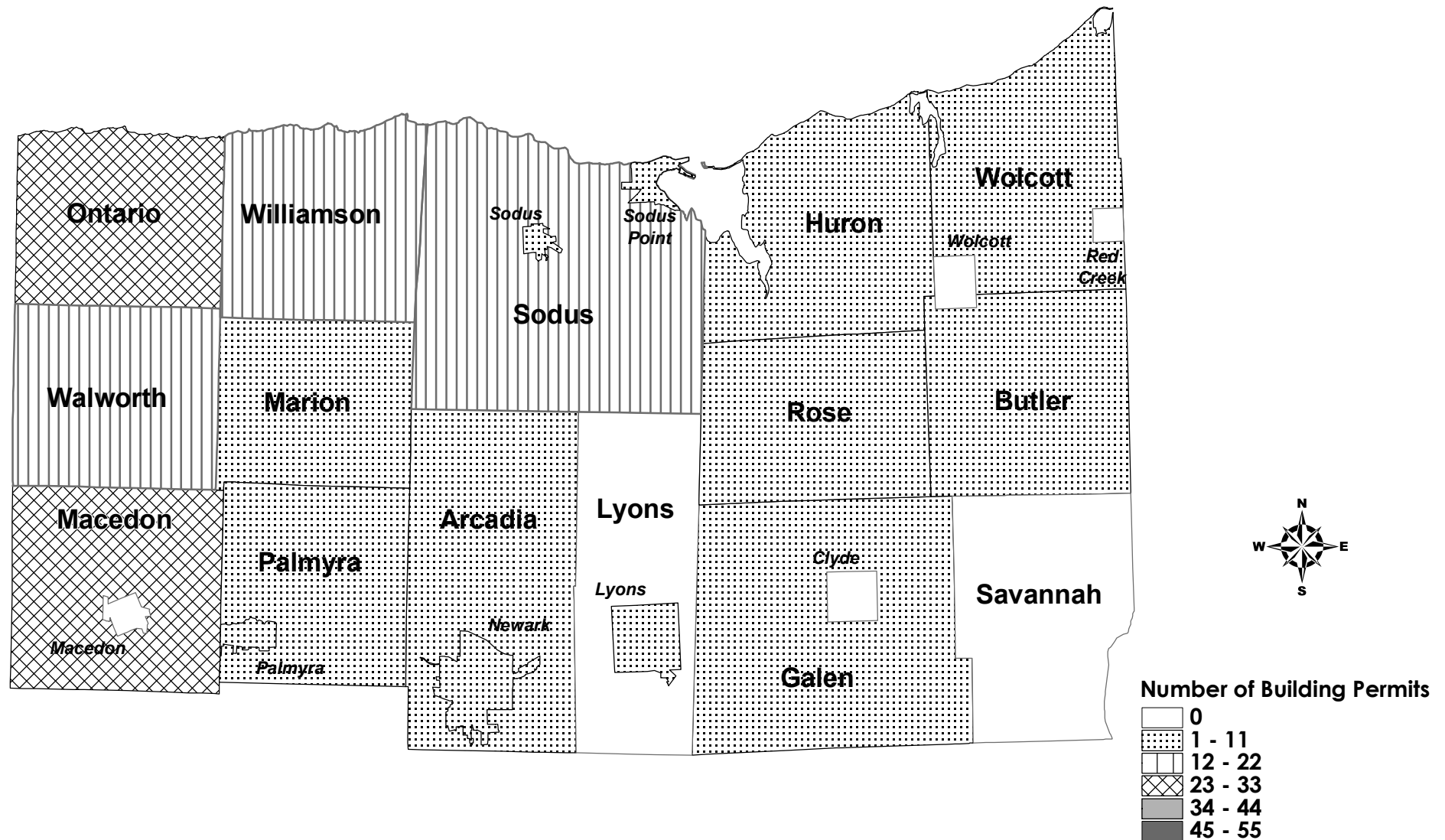

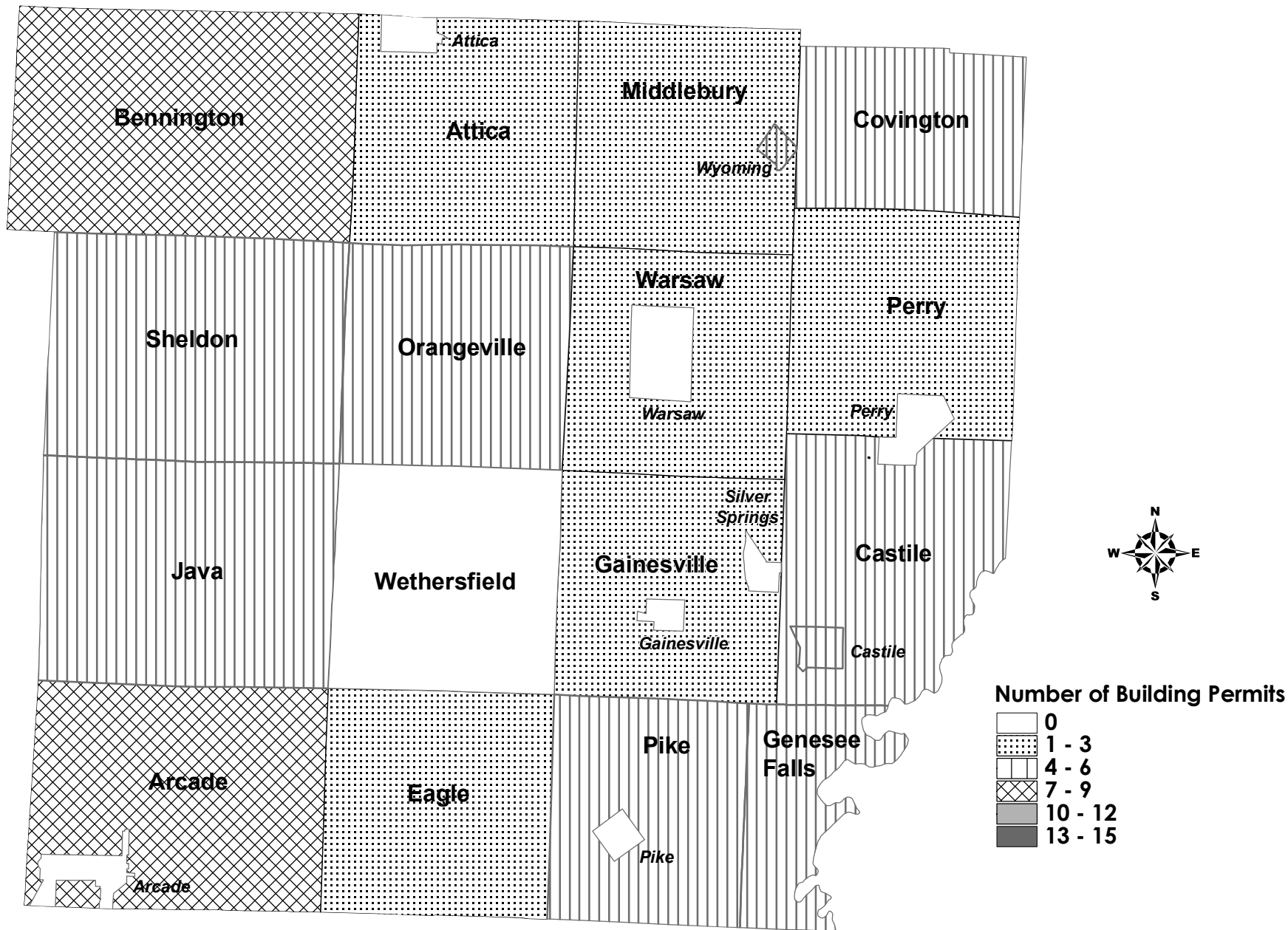

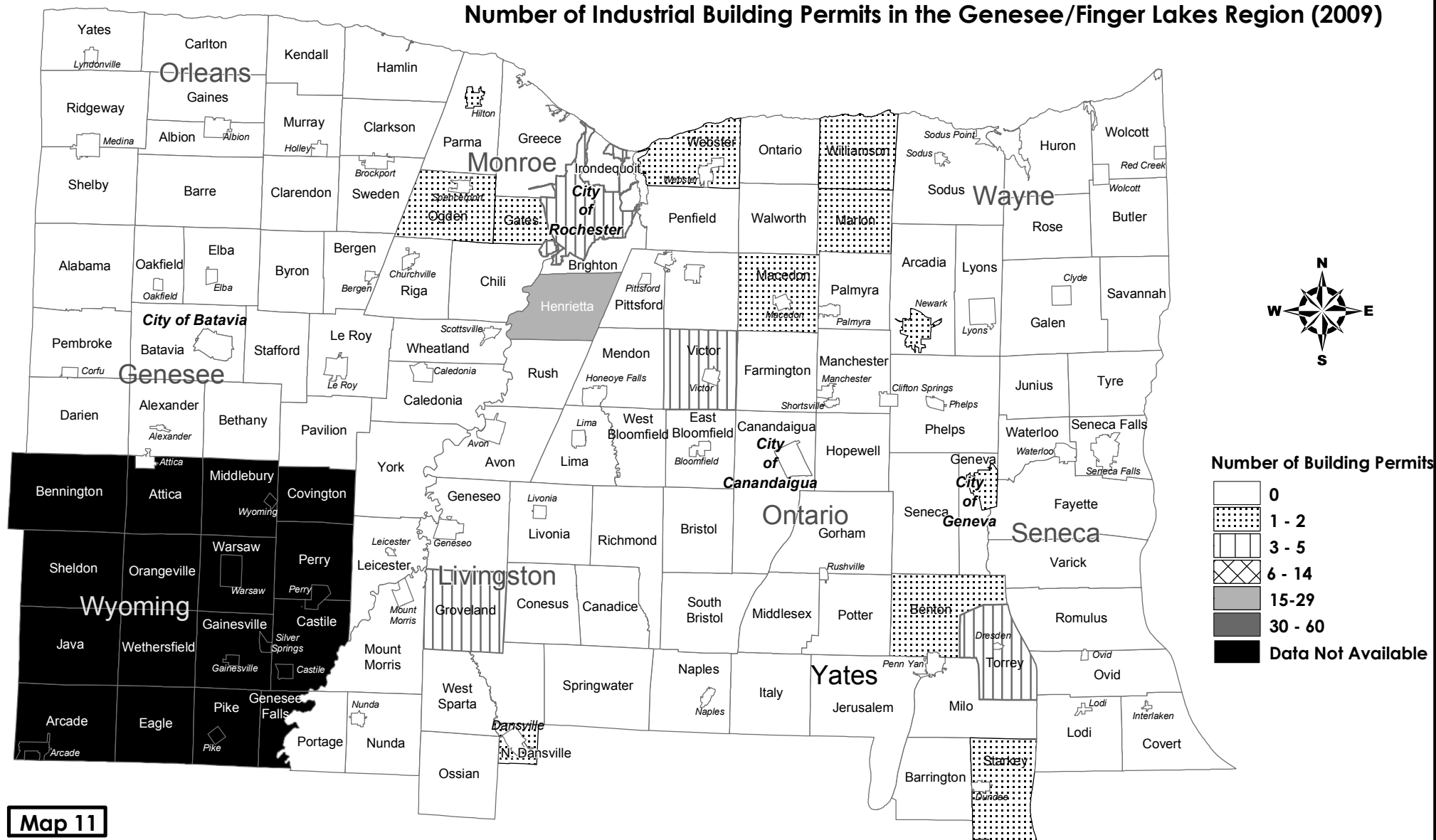


# Number of Residential Unit Permits in the Genesee/Finger Lakes Region (2009)

# Number of Industrial Building Permits in the Genesee/Finger Lakes Region (2009)

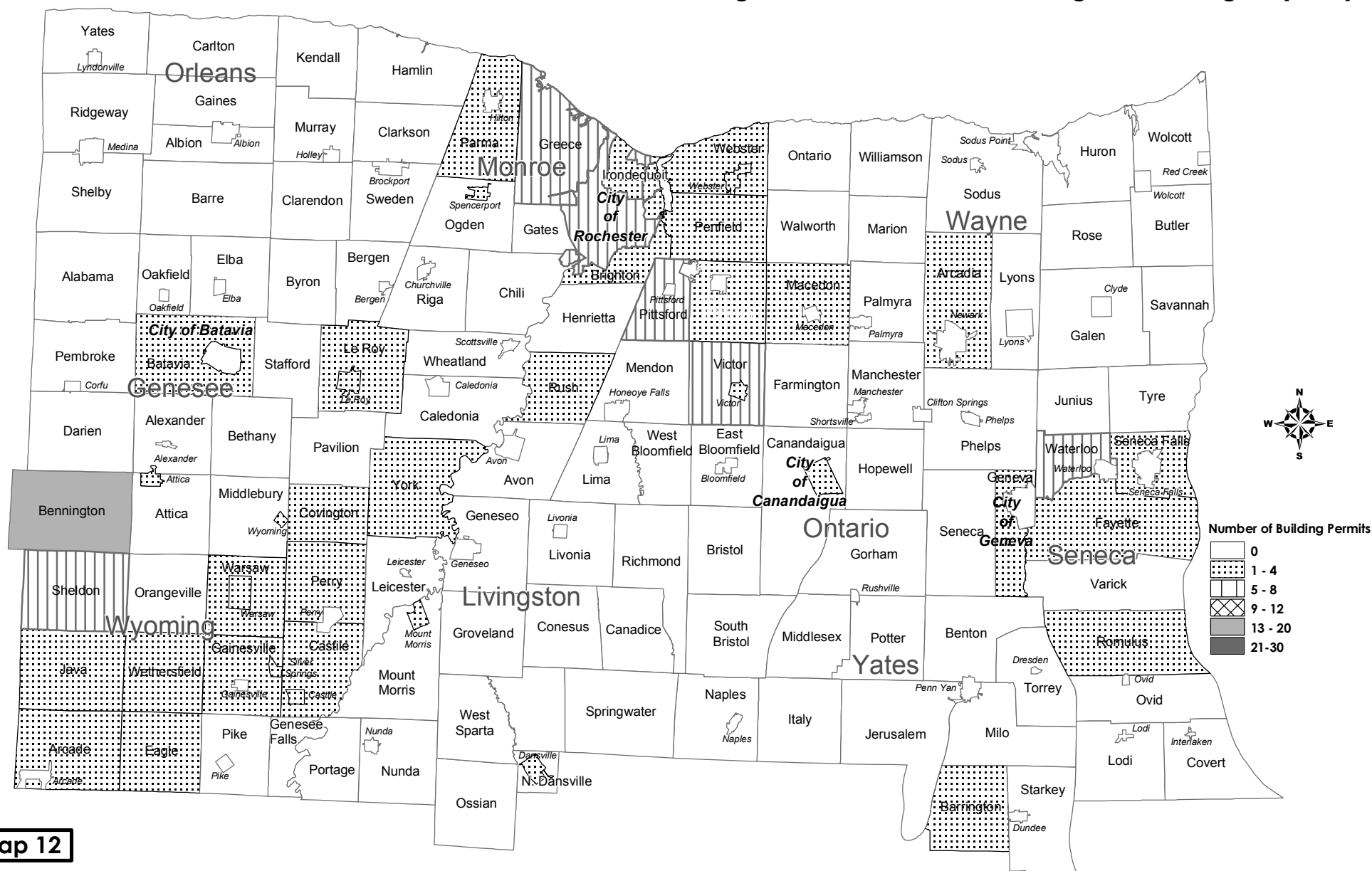

# Number of Commercial Building Permits in the Genesee/Finger Lakes Region (2009)



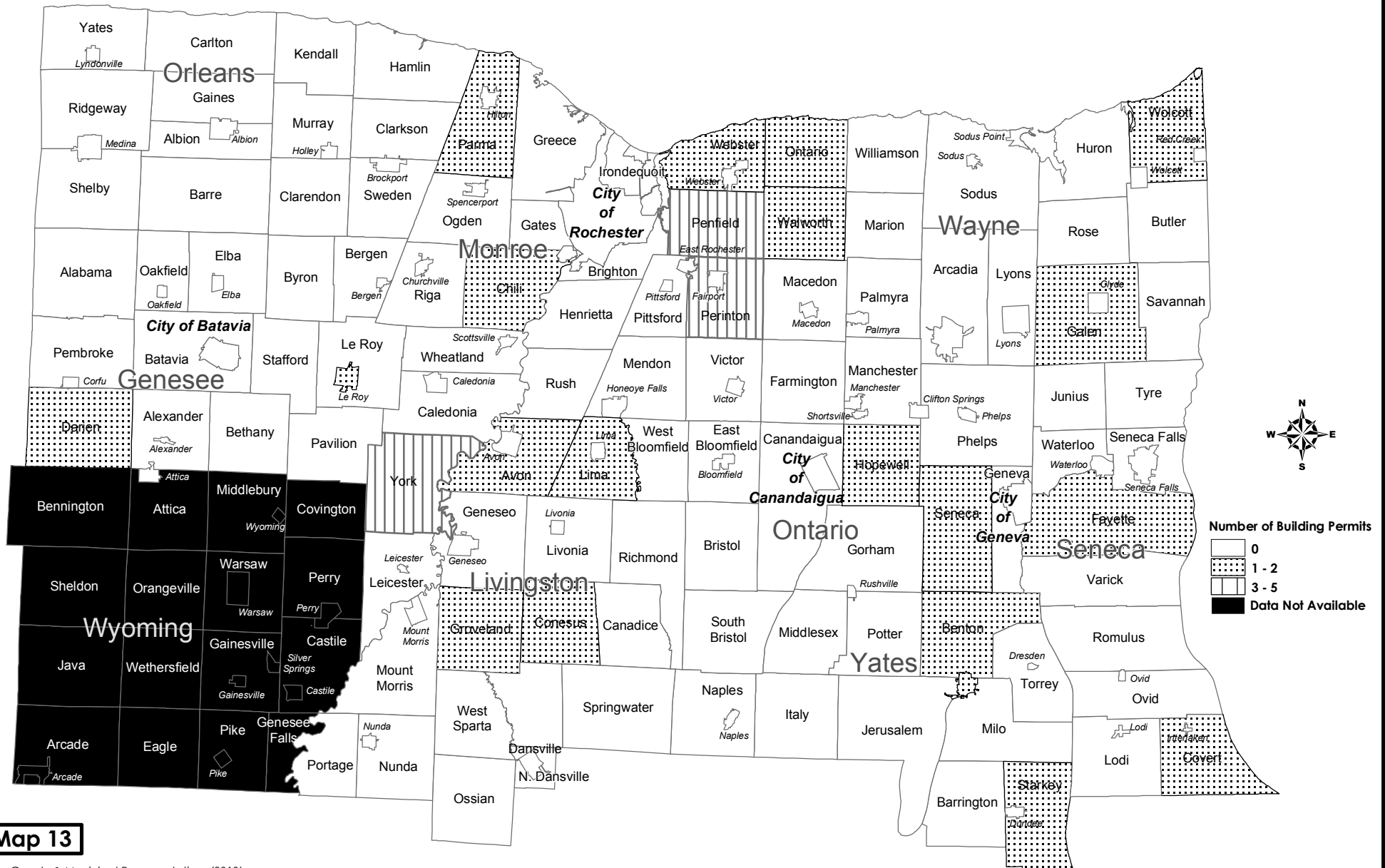

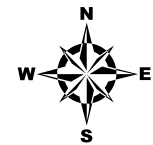

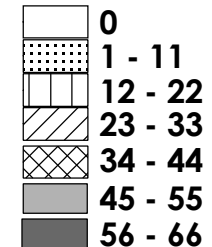


# Number of Residential Building Permits in the TMA Transportation Analysis Zones outside of Monroe County (2009)

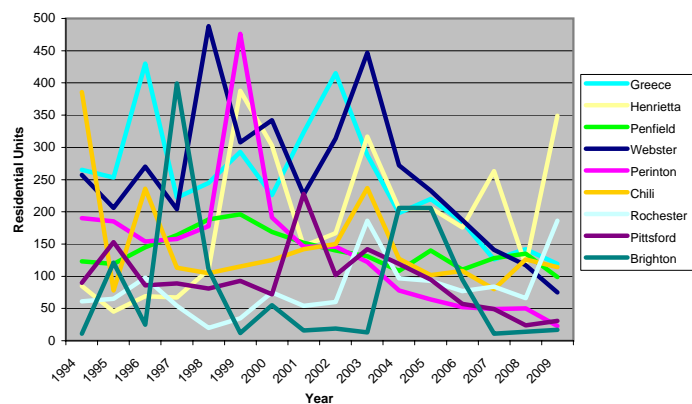

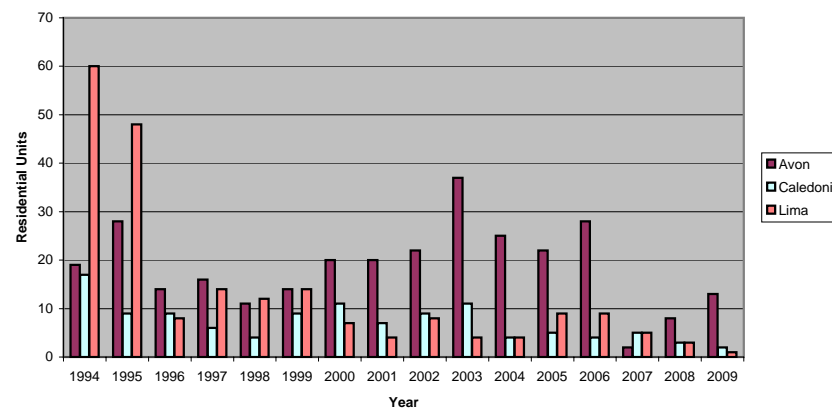

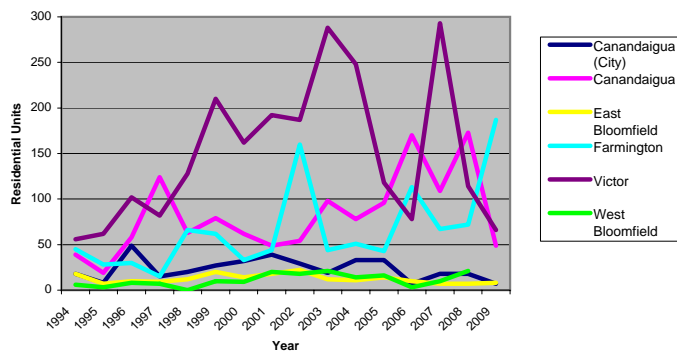
**Towns with the Largest Numbers of Permitted Residential Units in Monroe County (1994 - 2009)**



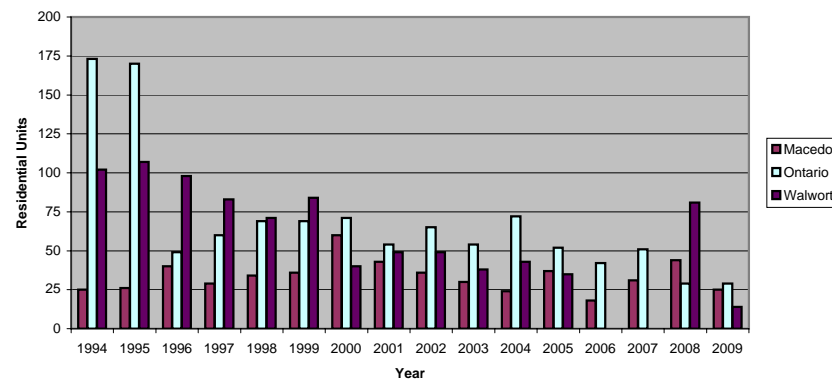
**Number of Permitted Residential Units in Livingston County TMA Towns (1994 - 2009)**

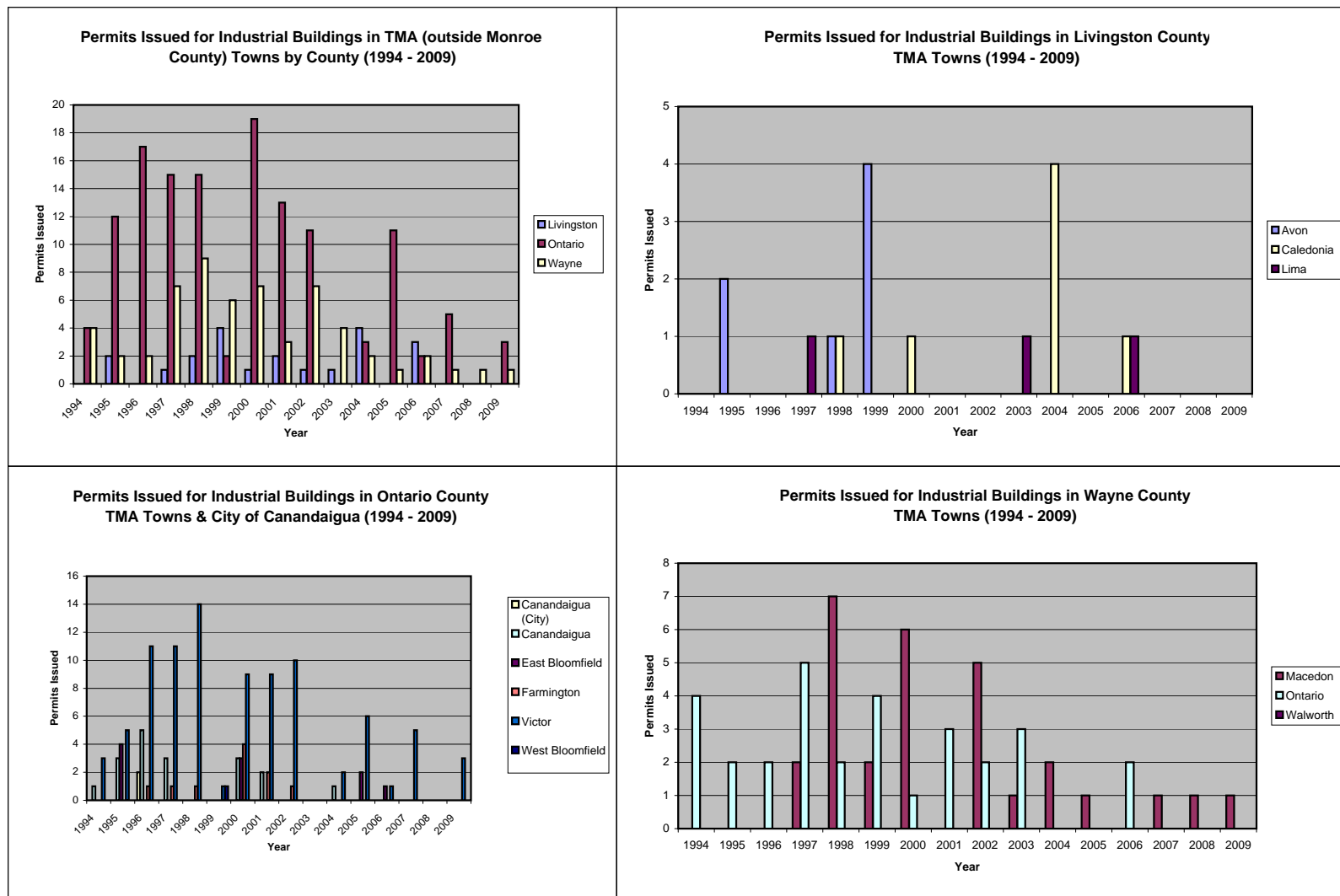
