FALL LEAF PICK-UP

Resident's leaves will be picked up beginning October 17th through November 30th, or the first snowfall.

- Place leaves as close to the curb or roadway as possible without leaves in the actual roadway.
- Park vehicles away from leaf piles so the leaf vacuum can access the curbside.
- DO NOT mix grass clippings, animal waste, rubbish, stones, or brush in with leaves.
Leaf piles found with these materials will not be picked up by the Village.
- Do not place leaves in bags.

Our advice is to **KEEP THE WIPES OUT OF THE PIPES!!!**

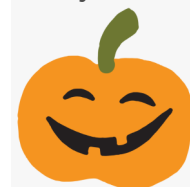
Use them....but don't flush them!
