Zoning Information for the Village...

Zoning information for the Village of Kent City can be received via our website @www.kentcitymi.org. You can also contact Tom Knauf, Zoning Administrator @616.678.7232. or vkc.zoning@kentcitymi.org. The Zoning Administrator is in the office on Tuesdays and Thursdays.



Ordinance Reminders:

The Village has ordinances in effect for the following issues:

- Grass & Weeds Inoperable Vehicles Trash & Junk -
- Parking on Streets or Village Lot Snow Removal Streets & Sidewalks -
- Noise

Signs: The Zoning Ordinance requires a Sign Permit for any sign placed or erected within the Village of Kent City, with a few exceptions. Prior to placing any signs within the Village, please contact the Zoning Administrator. Signs placed within the public right-of-way are routinely confiscated and held for 10 days unless prior permission by the Zoning Administrator has been granted for placement of the sign.

Fencing & Walls: Permits are not required to construct a fence or wall; however, they must comply with the provisions of the Zoning Ordinance. The ordinance regulates the height and location of fences and walls. Barbed wire and above ground electrically charged wire are prohibited in residential districts.

A free one-page information sheet is available at the Village Office or on the web site. We will mail or fax upon request.

Permits Authorized By The Zoning Administrator:

Dwellings/Additions to existing structures

Swimming pools & hot tubs / Gazebos

Razing(demolition) & moving a building

Fences/Walls Signs Porches & decks/Sheds Freestanding Antenna & towers

**Zoning Permits—are required prior to any form of construction or excavation.

Once again Village Property Tax Season is upon us! Tax bills for summer are due Monday, September 15th by 4:00pm. After that date all unpaid

2014 bills will receive penalty/interest of 1% per month or any part of a month and will be turned over to Kent County Treasurer for Collection.

How to pay your tax bill:

- ► In office during regular business hours : Mon-Thurs 8:00am-4:00pm (exact change)
- ▶ Payment Drop Box– located in front of the office for after hours.

Yard waste is the number one question we get calls about.

The Village provides the service of picking up brush and grass

<u>clippings</u>. The Yard Waste Policy is available on the website or by contacting the Village Office for a copy. This service does not include trees that you have taken down or major trimming. The Village has a secured area where you can dump tree debris. Contact the DPW Manager @ 616-293-0693 to make arrangements.

Other issues: Before planting trees, bushes, and sprinkler heads make sure they are on your property and not in the Village right-of-way.
