Mike Henry discussed both projects. Natalie is nearing completion and the job site looks good and has been well maintained. Carol Lewis said she often goes by the site and they have done a very good job and would recommend Grade Line for other projects. The Fiscal Officer shared some recent photos. The Natalie job will finish by month's end. Canyon View continues to have issues. The main will remain in the right-of-way for an additional 200 feet necessitated by the private forced main discovered in the right-of-way. A Motion was made by Kopas and seconded by Lovano to approve the Minutes of May 27, 2020 with all in favor. The Fiscal Officer reviewed the payment received from Northfield Center for the Natalie Project of \$44,048.84. The Fiscal Office and Engineer discussed the final payment authorization for Natalie to Grade Line in the sum of \$169,969.84 and the first draw for the Canyon View Road project of \$109,276.53 to Terrace. The Engineer reviewed the invoices and quantities and the payments that have been made on the Canyon View Road Project from OPWC. The Fiscal Officer also explained the public liability insurance on the Pay Resolution of \$1,575.00 and the General Liability Insurance of \$3,803.00. The Engineer discussed that Terrace Construction did not have to cut the asphalt on Canyon View Road in order to connect to the water main which is good news. A discussion was had about the status of both projects and the complete breakdown of the bill related to Natalie, which will be forwarded to each of the Townships for payment with a copy to the Board of Trustees. The Fiscal Officer and Engineer then discussed hiring Grade Line, Inc. to paint the hydrants on Natalie at a cost of \$700.00, fix the pavement on Fairhaven at a cost of \$2,900.00 caused by the leak earlier this year, as well as the pavement at Crestview in the amount of \$1,500.00 where an earlier pavement repair has failed installed by Cleveland. A Motion was made by Lewis to approve Pay Resolution 109-20 and seconded by Klimkewicz with a roll call showing all in favor.

The Board discussed the plans for Northfield Center to run approximately 440 feet of eight inch water main under I-271 to connect to their existing road building along Olde Eight Rd. in Northfield Center. The Fiscal Office and Engineer will continue to work with Northfield Center Township for a ball park figure on what this project may cost. The Board then began discussing the flushing of hydrants with Macedonia. As of the existing hiring freeze in the City of Macedonia, the plan would be that the Water District would hire the responsible young persons upon the recommendation of Macedonia Fire Department would flush all the hydrants within the North Hills Water District and flush the hydrants in the City of Macedonia. The actual costs for such services including employee benefits like PERS, worker's compensation would all be paid by the District and reimbursed by those who utilize the services.

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The City of Macedonia Fire Department is reviewing responsible persons to be able to perform the flushing services under the supervision and training of the City of Macedonia Fire Department. The vehicle that would be used would be a Northfield Center Township vehicle that is controlled by the Macedonia Fire Department with the fuel and expenses allocated to each party. The Board asks that these young persons also check the hydrants and do potential spot painting on hydrants that need painting or touch up work. Generally, these people have also provided a written report of issues with the hydrants so that we have a complete list each year. A discussion was had about whether flushing was needed every year which has been typically done by the Board, however, there have been some years where not all hydrants have not been flushed. A Motion was made by Schade and seconded by Lovano to authorize the Fiscal Officer to enter into an Agreement with the City of Macedonia and the North Hills Water District to hire certain young persons to flush all the hydrants within both communities and allocate such costs to each communities for reimbursement based on the actual cost of such service. A roll call showed all in favor.

The Board then moved to Aqua Ohio and its interest in creating an interconnection. Aqua Ohio approached the Board in 2018 and had a discussion between the Engineer, the Fiscal Officer and at least two members of the North Hills Water District who continue to service as members. Aqua Ohio is interested in making an emergency interconnect between Cleveland Water System and their wellfield on Boyden Road. The Board directed the Fiscal Officer to ask them for a written proposal on what they are seeking to do with a drawing of their system and how this inter- connection will interact in their system as well as the North Hills Water system.

Maybe it is a user fee and only for emergencies. This should be re-evaluated each year. Kopas stated it is important if it is legally required, does not like their definition, and if not, feels it may be just be a setup to use our system. Engineer stated the OHIO EPA said it is their recommendation, but it is not required. They do not provide any additional resources in the area. Fiscal Officer to look further into this in regards to if it is required. The Engineer does not see this as being a permanent connection and what the residents input is. Lewis stated now that there is a new fire main, residents had their own water system here for many years, may not be aware of what is going on

Fiscal Officer to try to communicate with these residents. Fiscal Officer reported that they received final payment on Natalie from Sagamore Hills.

A Motion was made to approve the Minutes of August 26, 2020 by Schade, seconded by Lewis with all in favor. Pay Resolution 111-20 was introduced by Lewis and seconded by Lovano. There is a correction to check no. 4885 as it should have been noted written to Daryl L. Kirkpatrick and the numbering of the first four checks needed to be corrected. The Fiscal Officer will make the corrections on the final Pay Resolution. A roll call showed all in favor. The Fiscal Officer reviewed the 2020 August real estate tax settlement total distribution of \$97,232.63 which showed the deductions expected to be \$1,646.16. The gross amount from Ohio due is \$13,399.93 for a total of \$108,986.40. The Ohio funds are still pending. The Board reviewed the ongoing repairs and in particular, the outstanding issues related to the driveway at 765 Ravenhill, the concrete pavement driveway at Village Club Drive and the full pavement repair at Holzhauer. The Engineer noted that TC Concrete is expected to start the repairs at Village Club Drive and 765 Ravenhill next week and Gradeline will be working on the Holzhauer repair at a similar time frame. All other major repairs have been completed, but for landscaping repairs that are still necessary. The Board reviewed the eleven outstanding repairs and the status of this work. The Fiscal Officer will direct the reimbursement due from Cleveland. The Board is concerned about the outstanding insurance claims related to the break at 8960 Brandywine Road, 14 E. Aurora Road and 4977 Brandywine Road. The Fiscal Officer will provide an update to all Board Members of the outstanding insurance claims. The Fiscal Officer reviewed the proposal of Charles E. Harris & Assoc. to prepare the annual notes for 2020 at \$750.00 and 2021 at \$800.00 and the Board authorized the Fiscal Officer to proceed. One permit was issued for 226 E. Aurora Road for \$1,000 depeosit and a \$3,000 two inch permit. The Board also asked about the one residential permit at 37 Beechwood for \$25.00 which was also issued this month. Resolution 112-20, a Resolution to Accept the Amounts and Rates Determined by the Budget Commission and Authorizing the Necessary Tax Levies and Certifying them to the Summit County Fiscal Office was moved by Schade and seconded by Klimkewicz, with a roll call showing all in favor. The Engineer reviewed the status of Canyon View which is expected to finalize at about \$755,000.00. The final bill has not been generated by the contractor, but is expected shortly. The Board also discussed the finalization of the Natalie Project. The Fiscal Officer will forward copies of all payments and receipts from the Townships to all Board Members related to the completion of the Natalie Project. The Engineer

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was also asked about the Twinsburg Road Project with Summit County, which has not yet been awarded. The Engineer will update the Board.

A brief discussion was had about the number of breaks this summer which has appeared to have diminished. Member Carol Lewis explained that she has seen many breaks throughout the system in Cleveland and asked the Engineer if there was something in particular replated to this. The Fiscal Officer and Engineer expressed concerns related to the annual flushing.
