

Yardwaste Collection

- No bags or boxes will be accepted
- Must be in an open 33 gallon max container
- Clearly marked - **YARDWASTE**
- Free stickers available at the office for bins
- All bins must have drainage holes and solid handles.
- Plants, twigs, and any bush trimmings smaller than 1" diameter, must be placed in open containers not exceeding 45-pounds
- Pumpkins, gourds, hay bales, and other vegetation

Yardwaste bins are
\$15/each

These are 25 gal and can be purchased at the Borough Office.



Chipping & Leaf Collection

- Chipping is any limbs/branches 1" - 12" in diameter and more than 4' in length
- Must be stacked neatly at refuse collection area with all cut end facing the street/alley.
- Leaves must be placed curbside in piles.
- No limbs, grass or yardwaste mixed with leaves.

Refuse Collection

- All refuse must be placed in proper containers and/or bagged and at the collection site the night before collection.
- 3 - 33 gallon containers or bags per week
- A bag, can or container cannot exceed a capacity of 33 gallons and/ or weigh more than 45 pounds when full.
- Grass clippings will be accepted as part of the refuse collection. Any bags of grass clippings will count in the refuse limit of 3 -33 gallon containers or bags per week.
- Paint Cans – the lids go in the trash, put kitty litter, dirt or sand in the unused paint and let dry. Once dry place the paint can next to the garbage, so the driver can see that it is dried out.

Extra Bag tags are \$3/each and can be purchased at the Borough Office

Items NOT acceptable for Refuse

- NO tires
- NO white goods
- NO electronic wastes

Refuse bins are
\$20/each

These are 32 gal and can be purchased at the Borough Office.



Large Item Collection

- One (1) over sized refuse item each week that is less than 6' and less than 45lbs.
- Any large item exceeding 6' and more than 45lbs needs to be tagged.
- Mattresses bigger than a Twin need a tag.
- **ALL** mattresses need to be wrapped in plastic and all open edges/seams sealed with tape.
- Mirrors or any plate glass i.e. window, doors. Glass must be taped in all directions to prevent shattering.
- Glass that is broken out of mirrors or just broken needs to be put in a hard container and marked broken glass on the container and sealed.
- Anything gas powered – **ALL** fluids need to be removed.
- Grills must have propane tanks detached.
- Carpet and padding have to be rolled in no longer than 4' lengths and tied.
- Wood boards/ Old lumber must be cut down to 4' lengths and tied.

Large Item tags are \$10/each and can be purchased at the Borough Office

White Goods Collection

- Refrigerators and freezers must have shelves and doors removed.
- Spring and Fall pick up only. Must purchase \$15 tag at the Borough Office for each item.

Recycling Collection

- Recycle can not be in plastic bags.
- Corrugated cardboard ONLY
- Cardboard - should be broken down no larger than 4' x 4' and bundled.
- Larger cardboard boxes may be taken to the cardboard dumpster on East Broad Street at the Highway Garage.
- Plastic bottles & jugs with necks – This includes plastic bottles, jars, jugs and anything else with a neck smaller than its base.
- Glass jars and bottles – This includes clear, green and brown glass bottles and jars
- Metal food and beverage cans
- Newspaper – must be kept dry
- **“WHEN IN DOUBT THROW IT OUT”**

Items NOT acceptable for Recycling

- NO packing material
- NO lids from plastic or glass bottles
- NO lights bulbs
- NO cereal boxes or shoes boxes

Recycle bins are
\$15/each
