ORDINANCE NO. 818

AN ORDINANCE TO AMEND CHAPTER 350 OF THE PALMYRA BOROUGH CODE OF ORDINANCES TO REVISE PARKING REGULATIONS REGARDING HANDICAPPED PARKING AND STREET SWEEPING.

BE AND IT IS HEREBY ORDAINED AND ENACTED by Borough Council of the Borough of Palmyra, Lebanon County, Pennsylvania, as follows:

Section 1. The Code of Ordinances of the Borough of Palmyra, Chapter 350, Vehicles and Traffic, Article III, Parking Regulations, §350-26, Special Purpose Parking Zones; Parking Otherwise Prohibited, shall be amended to add the following regulations:

<u>Highway</u>	<u>Side</u>	<u>Authorized Purpose or Vehicle</u>	<u>Location</u>
North Locust Street	East	Parking for Handicapped	10 North Locust Street
South Lincoln Street	West	Parking for Handicapped	404 South Lincoln Street

Section 2. The Code of Ordinances of the Borough of Palmyra, Chapter 350, Vehicles and Traffic, Article III, Parking Regulations, §350-26, Special Purpose Parking Zones; Parking Otherwise Prohibited, shall be amended to delete the following regulations:

<u>Highway</u>	<u>Side</u>	<u>Authorized Purpose or Vehicle</u>	<u>Location</u>
North Chestnut Street	West	Parking for Handicapped	501 North Chestnut Street
North Harrison Street	East	Parking for Handicapped	136 North Harrison Street

Section 3. The Code of Ordinances of the Borough of Palmyra, Chapter 350, Vehicles and Traffic, Article III, Parking Regulations, §350-27, Parking Restricted for Street Sweeping, Subsection B, Paragraph (1) shall be amended to provide as follows:

- (1) The first Wednesday of each month:
 - (a) North Railroad Street from Main Street to Ridge Road.

(b) **South Railroad Street from Main Street to Walnut Street.**

Section 4. All other sections, parts and provisions of the Palmyra Borough Code of Ordinances shall remain in full force and effect as previously enacted and amended.

Section 5. In the event any provision, section, sentence, clause or part of this Ordinance shall be held to be invalid, illegal or unconstitutional by a court of competent jurisdiction, such invalidity, illegality or unconstitutionality shall not affect or impair the remaining provisions, sections, sentences, clauses or parts of this Ordinance, it being the intent of Borough Council that the remainder of the Ordinance shall be and shall remain in full force and effect.

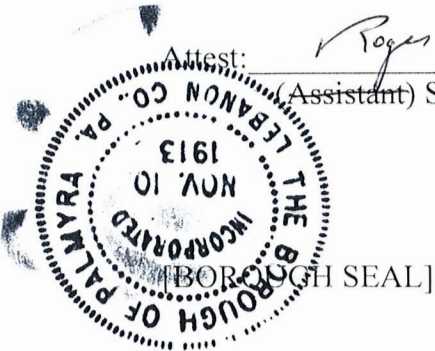
Section 6. This Ordinance shall take effect and be in force from and after its enactment as provided by law.

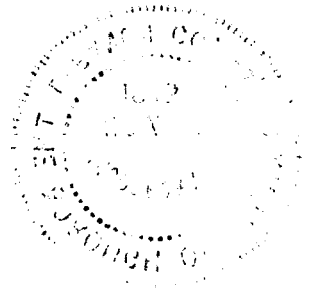


