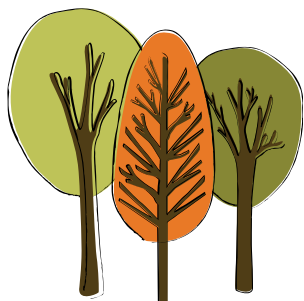




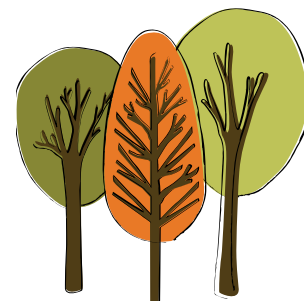
# Attention!!

**Wood or similar items cannot be longer than 4' and must be tied with a maximum weight of 50lbs.**

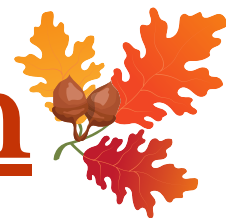
**No heavy car/truck parts**

**You may pay your sewer bill online by going to the Penn Township website at [penntownship.net](http://penntownship.net) and completing the following steps:**

- ➔ Hover over the Municipal Authority Tab located at the top right hand side of the page.
- ➔ At the bottom of the dropdown window, click on "Pay a sewer bill"
- ➔ Next, simply click on the Municipipay icon.
- ➔ Pay your bill! Don't forget to put your account # in the "reference" area.

# Susquenita High School Athletics

## 2021-2022



All Susquenita High School students in grades 9-12 have been issued a Student Athletic Pass which allows them FREE entry to all HOME games. We want all of our HS students involved as part of a cheering block to create a "WE" atmosphere at our games.

Regular admission for all fans from 5-64 years will be set at \$2 for all HOME contests. Children less than 5 years old will not be charged.

Any Middle School or Elementary student must have an adult staying at the game in order to attend.

Senior Citizens age 65+ can obtain a FREE Golden Age pass for all HOME games.

A single person pass for all HOME games may be purchased for \$40.

A Family pass (consisting of immediate family in one household) for all HOME games may be purchased for \$100.
