Wood or similar items cannot be longer than 4' and must be tied with a maximum weight of 50lbs.



Susquenita High School Athletics 2021-2022



All Susquenita High School students in grades 9-12 have been issued a Student Athlectic Pass which allows them FREE entry to all HOME games. We want all of our HS students involved as part of a cheering block to create a "WE" atmosphere at our games.
