# J. Discussion and any necessary action regarding University of Texas at Arlington proposal for updating Comprehensive Plan

Alan Klein, with the University of Texas at Arlington, Institute of Urban Studies, presented an outline of creating a comprehensive plan for the City utilizing graduate students. Mr. Klein discussed the components, phases, and the timeline of the comprehensive plan project. Klein concluded by answering questions from the Council.

Motion made by Council Member Eason, seconded by Council Member Mackowski to appoint Kaitlyn Dilts to the Parks and Recreation Board. Motion carried 3-0-1 with Mayor Pro Tem Priest, Council Member Eason, and Council Member Mackowski voting for and Council Member McCabe abstaining.

Motion made by Council Member Eason, seconded by Council Member McCabe, to terminate the current contract with American Municipal Services and enter into a new contract with Linebarger Attorneys at Law for Court Collection Services and to approve Resolution 2018-14. Motion carried unanimously.
