A copy of the approved permit and plans must be on site at all times. Line locations for water and sewer utilities shall be requested from Public Works 48 hours prior to commencing work at 817-636-2462. Once call ticket number (811) must be given to Public Works. All construction will be in conformance with all city codes and applicable local, state, and federal laws. Contractor agrees to comply with this Permit and the Right-of-Way Management Standard Notes.

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| 1. | The City of Rhome's Public Works Department SHALL also and separately be notified for municipal utility locates 48 hours at (817) 636-2464 prior to stating any construction, excavation, digging, or any penetration into the ground. INITIAL HERE: |
| 2. | 811 shall be required to be notified 48 hours prior to excavations, to allow for contract franchise utility (phone, gas, and electric) companies to allow for line locates. INITIAL HERE: |
| 3. | A separate permit shall be required if the with is to be executed within the TXDOT Right-of-Way (HWY 287, BC Rhome, HWY 114) and a copy shall be sent to the City of Rhome. INITIAL HERE: |
| 4. | This permit is only valid for one-hundred eighty (180) calendar days from the approval date listed above. |
| 5. | The permit must be onsite by any contractor or subcontractor at ALL times. |



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Right-of-Way Management Standard Notes

1	The right-of-way user, their contractor or representative, shall notify the Department of Public Works forty-eight (48) hours prior to the start of the construction (817) 636-2464
2	All construction shall be in conformance with all city codes, technical specifications and standards; and applicable local, state, and federal laws
3	Erosion control measures (ie. Silt fences) and advanced warning signs, markers, cones, and barricades must be in place before work begins.
4	Contractors working for the permittee's responsibility to verify the location, both horizontal and vertical, of all existing utilities, which may be in conflict with the proposed construction
5	Contractor must adequately protect existing structures, utilities, trees, shrubs and other permanent objects.
6	Ditched shall be opened at the end of each day to assure adequate drainage
7	Trench safety system to meet, as a minimum, the requirements of OSHA Safety and Health Regulations Part1926, Subpart P
8	No open excavations shall be left open overnight. No open excavation shall be left open overnight. All excavations which cannot be back sealed overnight shall be covered, as a minimum, with steel plating when in paved areas; three-quarter inch plywood, wood planking with OSHA orange plastic expanded mesh barrier around perimeter and unpaved areas, or approved by the City of Rhome.
9	For locations where open cut construction is required in the streets contractors shall furnish and maintain adequate barricades, warning and direction signs, flags and lights. All signs, barricades, pavement markings, traffic signals and channelizing devices used to handle traffic shall be shown on a traffic control plan (to be approved by the city) and shall conform the latest revisions of the Texas Manual on Uniform Traffic Control Devices for Streets and Highways (TMUTCD), "Part VI-Traffic controls for Street and Highway Construction and Maintenance Operations, latest edition.
10	The condition of paving shall be as good as or better than prior to starting
11	On completion of all work, the contractor shall notify the Department of Public Works to schedule a final inspection of the project (817) 636-2464
