CITY OF RHOME ORDINANCE NO. 2018-12

AN ORDINANCE OF THE CITY OF RHOME AMENDING CHAPTER 11 "TAXATION", ARTICLE 11.02 "PROPERTY TAX", ADOPTIONG AN AD VALOREM TAX FREEZE FOR RESIDENTIAL HOMESTEAD PROPERTY OWNERS WHO ARE DISABLED OR 65 YEARS OF AGE OR OLDER; PROVIDING THAT THIS ORDINANCE SHALL BE CUMULATIVE OF ALL ORDINANCES; PROVIDING A SEVERABILITY CLAUSE; AND PROVIDING AN EFFECTIVE DATE.

WHEREAS, the City of Rhome, Texas is a Type A General Law Municipality located in Wise County, created in accordance with the provisions of Chapter 6 of the Local Government Code and operating pursuant to the enabling legislation of the State of Texas; and

WHEREAS, Article VIII, Section 1-b, subsection h, of the Texas Constitution allows municipalities and certain other taxing entities to establish an ad valorem tax freeze on residence homesteads of disabled individuals or individuals age sixty-five or older; and

WHEREAS, Section 11.261 of the Texas Tax Code governs the procedure under which a municipality or other taxing entity may adopt and regulate an ad valorem tax freeze; and

WHEREAS, the City Council believes it would be in the best interest of the citizens of Rhome to provide for a tax freeze on the amount of property tax rate on the homesteads of disabled individuals or individuals age sixty-five or older, beginning with tax year 2019.

NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT ORDAINED BY THE CITY COUNCIL OF THE CITY OF RHOME, TEXAS:

SECTION 1

Chapter 11 "Taxation", Article 11.02 "Property Tax" of the Code of Ordinances of the City of Rhome, Texas, is hereby amended to add Section 11.02.006 as follows:

Sec. 11.02.006 Ad Valorem Tax Rate Freeze.

(a) Effective with tax year 2019, the total amount of ad valorem taxes imposed on the residence homestead of a person who is disabled or is sixty-five years of age or older shall not be increased while it remains the residence homestead of that person.

- (b) If the person who is disabled or is sixty-five years of age or older dies the total amount of ad valorem taxes imposed on the residence homestead shall not be increased while it remains the residence homestead of that person's surviving spouse if:
 - (1) the surviving spouse is disabled or is 55 years of age or older when the individual dies; and
 - (2) the residence homestead of the individual:
 - (A) is the residence homestead of the surviving spouse on the date that the individual dies; and
 - (B) remains the residence homestead of the surviving spouse.
- (c) Notwithstanding subsections (a) and (d), taxes on the residence homestead may be increased to the extent the value of the homestead is increased by improvements other than repairs and other than improvements made to comply with governmental requirements.
- (d) A tax limitation imposed under this section expires if on January 1:
 - (1) none of the owners of the structure who qualify for the limitation provided by this section for a disabled individual or an individual 65 years of age or older and who owned the structure when the limitation provided by this section first took effect is using the structure as a residence homestead; or
 - (2) none of the owners of the structure qualifies for the limitation provided by this section for a disabled individual or an individual 65 years of age or older.

SECTION 2 PROVISIONS CUMULATIVE BUT CONFLICTING ORDINANCES REPEALED

This Ordinance shall be cumulative of all provisions of all existing ordinances and of the Code of Ordinances of the City of Rhome, Texas, as amended, except where the provisions of this ordinance are in direct conflict with the provisions of such existing ordinances and code, in which event the conflicting provisions of such ordinances and Code are hereby repealed.

SECTION 3 PROVISIONS SEVERABLE

It is hereby declared to be the intention of the City Council that the phrases, clauses, sentences, paragraphs and sections of this Ordinance are severable, and if any phrase, clause, sentence, paragraph or section of this Ordinance shall be declared unconstitutional by the valid judgment or decree of any court of competent jurisdiction, such unconstitutionality shall not affect any of the remaining, phrase, clauses, sentences, paragraphs or sections of this Ordinance since the same would have been enacted by the City Council without incorporation in this Ordinance of any such unconstitutional phrase, clause, sentence, paragraph or section.

SECTION 4

This Ordinance shall be in full force and effect from and its passage, and it so ordained.

Summary - Background:

The discharge of treated domestic wastewater into or adjacent to water in the state must be authorized by the TCEQ. Domestic facilities that dispose of treated effluent by discharge into waters in the state are required to obtain a Texas Pollutant Discharge Elimination System (TPDES) permit. TCEQ wastewater (TPDES) permits are on a five (5) year cycle and must be submitted to TCEQ 180 day prior to the permit expiration date 12/1/2021. Kimley-Horn will prepare all documents to be submitted to TCEQ. The follow tasks will be performed by Kimley-Horn

- 1.TCEQ Permit Application Consultant will prepare applications for TCEQ permit. Application will include administrative and technical sections including color maps and figures as required in the current version of the application.
- 2. Review Meeting Client and Consultant will attend a review meeting at the Consultant's office or by conference call to review the draft permit application for up to two (2) hours. Consultant will prepare final permit application based on comments from the review meeting.
- 3. Address TCEQ Comments Consultant will prepare one revised permit application, if required, based on comments from the regulatory agency.
- 4. Public Notice Consultant will prepare and submit publication for public notice requirements for TCEQ permit. Consultant will complete the Public Notice Verification Form required by TCEQ and submit the Public Notice Verification Form, proof of publication, and publisher's affidavit to TCEQ.

Consultant will coordinate the posting of the permit application and preliminary decision in a public place for viewing

Legal is reviewing the proposed agreement.

The cost is \$15,000 and is available in the W/WW budget.

Recommendation: Authorize City Administrator to execute the contract with Kimley-Horn and Associates to prepare the renewal application permit for municipal discharge permit for the West WWTP.
