

**The City of Rhome, effective immediately,
is implementing its Stage 4 – Emergency Contingency Plan
(Resolution 2013-05R)**

What does this mean to Rhome water users?

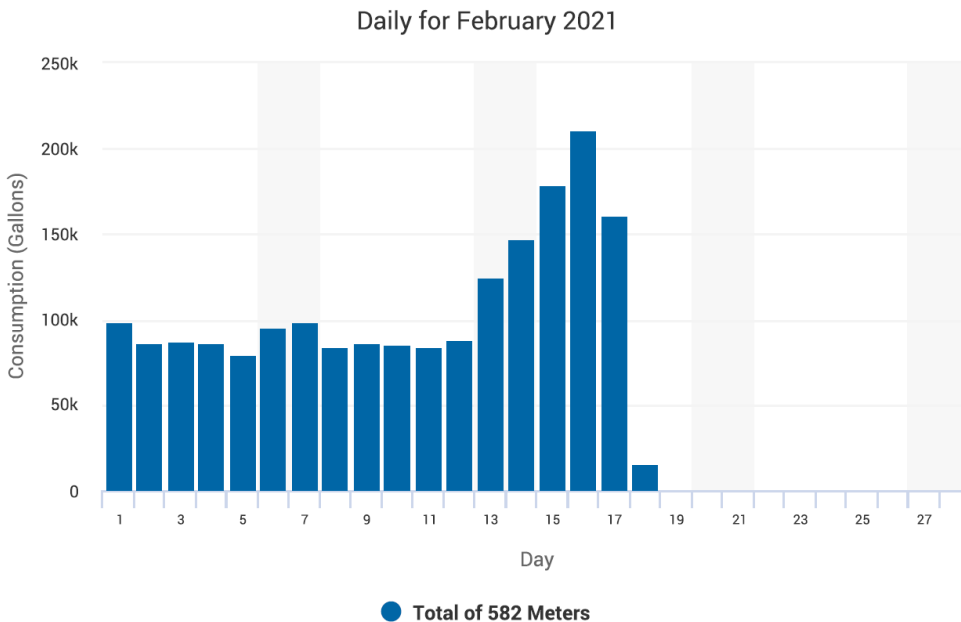
- ✓ All residents must limit their water to no more than 500 gallons of use per day.
- ✓ All high-users, defined as over 1000 gallons per day, will have their water turned off.
- ✓ All residents should limit their water usage to essential uses, defined as drinking and restrooms.
- ✓ Keep in mind the average high use per person is about 100 gallons per day. With a household average of 2.5, that would represent approximately, 250 gallons per day. Keeping under 500 gallons per day is not unreasonable during these extreme emergency circumstances.

✓ **We are not yet on a boil water notice, but we may be by tomorrow/FRIDAY, FEB 19, 2021**

- ✓ Finally, please see below chart. Many folks are leaving faucets dripping, as you should...but please note you do not need to leave ALL faucets dripping. Faucets leaking usage over the last several days represents an additional avg of 100 gallons per day.

*Recent average daily use around 90K per day. With the onset of this Winter/Freezing event, avg usage soared to 190K (approx.) demonstrating an increase of around 100K mostly due to dripping faucets, though some has probably been due to freezing/bursting pipes as well.
