

## **Town of Saint George 2026 Annual Town Meeting Warning**

The legal voters of the Town of Saint George, Vermont, are hereby warned and notified to meet at the Little Red Schoolhouse, 35 Barber Road, St. George, Vermont, on Tuesday, March 3, 2026, at 6:00 p.m. to transact the following:

Article 1: To elect a Town Moderator

Article 2: To hear the reports of the Town Officers

Article 3: To elect a Selectperson for the remainder of a three-year term expiring in 2028

Article 4: To elect a Selectperson for a 2-year term expiring in 2028

Article 5: To elect a Selectperson for a 2-year term expiring in 2028

Article 6: To elect a Selectperson for a 3-year term expiring in 2029

Article 7: To elect an Auditor for a three-year term expiring in 2029

Article 8: To elect a Cemetery Commissioner for a 3-year term expiring in 2029

Article 9: To authorize the collection of personal and real estate taxes as provided by law and as set forth below:

- a. Taxes to be collected; one-half on October 1, 2026, and the remaining one-half on April 1, 2027
- b. Interest to be charged on unpaid taxes at the rate of one percent (1%) per month for the first three months for any late payments from the due date, and one and one-half percent (1.5%) per month for any late payments more than 3 months from the due date. Postmarks dated October 1, 2026, and April 1, 2027, are acceptable as on-time payments for each due date. Taxpayers are responsible for ensuring that taxes are paid from mortgage escrow accounts.
- c. In addition to interest, a penalty of eight percent (8%) of the tax bill shall be imposed for payments received after April 1, 2027.
- d. A service charge of twenty-five dollars (\$25.00) will be assessed for checks returned for insufficient funds.

Article 10: "Shall the voters authorize total fund expenditures for operating expenses of \$486,673, of which \$300,000 shall be raised by taxes and \$78,890 by non-tax revenues and \$107,783 by utilization of prior reserves."

Article 11: Open agenda for non-binding discussion and input from residents on Town matters.


