

## TOWN MEETING WARNING


The legal voters of the Town of Saint George, Vermont are hereby warned and notified to meet at the St. George Town Center, 21 Barber Road, St. George, Vermont on Saturday, June 5, 2021 at 11:00 a.m. to transact the following:

- Article 1            To elect a moderator
- Article 2            To elect a Selectperson for a term of three years that expires in 2024
- Article 3            To elect a Lister for a term of three years that expires in 2024
- Article 4            To elect an Auditor for a term of three years that expires in 2024
- Article 5            To elect a Cemetery Commissioner for a term of three years that expires in 2024
- Article 6            To Elect a Town Clerk for a term of three years that expires in 2024
- Article 7            To Elect a Town Treasurer for a term of three years that expires in 2024
- Article 8            To authorize the Selectboard to appoint a Constable rather than by election, in accordance with State statutes, Title 17 V.S.A. §2651a
- Article 9            To authorize the Selectboard to appoint a Collector of Delinquent Taxes
- Article 10           To authorize the Town Clerk to approve additions to the voter checklist pursuant to Title 17, Vermont Statutes Annotated, Section 21 44 (b)
- Article 11           To authorize the collection of personal and real estate taxes as provided by law and as set forth below:
  - a. Taxes to be collected; one-half on October 1, 2021 and the remaining one-half on April 1, 2022
  - b. Interest to be charged on unpaid taxes at the rate of one percent (1%) per month (or fraction thereof) for the first three months, and one and a half percent (1.5%) per month for late payments more than three months from due date
  - c. In addition to interest, a penalty of eight percent (8%) of the tax bill shall be imposed for any late payment. A postmark of October 1, 2021 and April 1, 2022 are acceptable as on time for payment of taxes. Taxpayers are responsible for ensuring that taxes are paid from mortgage escrow accounts
  - d. A service charge of twenty-five dollars (\$25) will be assessed for checks returned for insufficient funds

Article 12 To authorize the imposition of property taxes to raise the funds to satisfy the Town budget as warned or as may be amended at Town meeting


Article 13 To authorize the Selectboard to sell one or both of the remaining unsold permitted lots in the Town Center subdivision for such amounts and for such purposes as the Selectboard may determine in its discretion, provided that all proceeds thereof shall be held in a special account segregated from the general fund and available for expenditure only upon majority vote of the legal voters of the town present at a regular or special town meeting
