### VILLAGE OF OWEGO LOCAL LAW NO. \_\_\_ OF THE YEAR 2022

### A LOCAL LAW AMENDING THE VILLAGE CODE TO ADD CHAPTER 160 ENTITLED 'KNOX BOX' TO REQUIRE INSTALLATION OF KNOX BOXES ON RENTAL BUILDINGS LOCATED WITHIN THE VILLAGE OF OWEGO

Be it enacted by the Village Board for the Village of Owego as follows:

### Section 1. Legislative Intent

It is the intent of this Local Law to amend Chapter 160 of the Village of Owego Village Code by adding provisions to require installation of a Knox Box on the exterior of commercial, business, and multi-family buildings located within the Village. This Local Law is intended to provide the Village Fire Department with access to these type of buildings to facilitate rapid response in emergency situations.

### Section 2. Authority

This Local Law is adopted pursuant to Article 7 of the New York State Village Law and Municipal Home Rule Law, which expressly authorizes the Village Board to adopt and amend local laws not inconsistent with the provisions of the constitution and not inconsistent with any general law relating to its property, affairs, or government.

### Section 3. Amendment adding a new Chapter 160 to the Village Code.

The Village Board hereby amends the Village Code by adding the following new chapter entitled "Knox Box":

### § 160-1 Knox Box Installation.

- A. Installation Requirements. All commercial buildings, businesses, mercantile occupancies, multi-family buildings with a common hallway, and multi-family structures having three or more dwelling units located within the Village must install a Knox Box on the exterior of the building or structure in compliance with the following specifications:
  - 1. The Knox Box must be within ten (10) feet of the entrance door normally used by the Village Fire Department to access the building;
  - 2. The top of the Knox Box shall be installed no higher than six (6) feet and nor lower than five (5) feet from the ground level;
  - 3. The Knox Box must be installed in such a manner as to be clearly visible and free from any obstruction, including trees, bushes, vegetation, or any man-made structures;
  - 4. If the Knox Box is equipped with a tamper switch or is connected to the building alarm system, the letter "A" shall be placed clearly on the door of the Knox Box; and

- 5. The Knox Box shall not be painted.
- B. Knox Box Contents. All keys placed inside the Knox Box shall be clearly labeled with identification of the access or device that it operates. The Knox Box shall contain keys for the following areas and/or devices:
  - 1. All points of ingress and egress, including all doors located in the interior and exterior of the building;
  - 2. Entrance suites;
  - 3. All common areas of the building;
  - 4. Padlock keys for personnel and vehicular gates;
  - 5. Mechanical, plumbing or electrical rooms or devices, including elevator controls;
  - 6. Control valves, breakaway padlocks, alarm panels, and roof hatches; and
  - 7. Other areas as directed by the Village Fire Department.

The Knox Box shall also contain the following:

- 1. Name and telephone number of local contact person;
- 2. Codes for any code-locked doors, with identification of the door(s) that it operates;
- 3. Cards for any card access doors, with identification of the door(s) that it operates;
- 4. Copy of building blue prints on a USB drive or in a digital .pdf format readable on a standard electronic device;
- 5. Hazardous material information, for hazards located within the building, on a USB drive or in a digital .pdf format readable on a standard electronic device; and
- 6. Other pertinent information as directed by the Village Fire Department.

### § 160-2 Penalties for Offenses.

Upon their own investigation or receipt of information or complaint, the enforcement officer of the Village of Owego shall cause to be served upon the responsible person for any land or property upon which the violation has taken place or occurred, a written notice in the form approved by the Village Board directing removal or correction of such violation within 45 days after the service of such notice or, in the event that such responsible person cannot reasonably be located, then by the posting of such notice in a prominent place upon the premises. If the violation is not corrected within 45 days from the date of the service or 45 days from the date of the posting of the notice upon the premises then the owner, occupant or person having control of said premises shall be deemed in violation of this article and subject to a fine of not more than \$250 or to imprisonment for not more than 15 days, or to both such fine and imprisonment.

### Section 4. Remainder

Except as hereinabove amended, the remainder of the Code of the Village of Owego shall remain in full force and effect.

### Section 5. Severability

If any clause, sentence, paragraph, subdivision, or part of this Local Law or the application thereof to any individual, firm or corporation, or circumstance, shall be held by any court of competent jurisdiction to be invalid or unconstitutional, such order or judgment shall not affect, impair, or invalidate the remainder thereof, but shall be confined in its operation to the clause, sentence, paragraph, subdivision, or part of this Local Law or in its application to the individual, firm or corporation or circumstance, directly involved in the controversy in which such judgment or order shall be rendered.

Court Processes and procedures were reviewed for accountability and control purposes:

- Fines/traffic violations
- Penal law infractions
- Parking tickets (i.e., expired inspections, registration, illegal parking, etc.)
- Handling of repeat (3 or more) offender tickets

Banking deposits – all revenue received by Court Clerk is deposited on a day to day basis in the night deposit at Chemung Canal Trust Company. This would include all revenues received in person in the Court Office, as well as, all fines received by daily mail. Court Clerk handles all deposits. A computer program from the Justice Department maintains a log of all monies received on a day to day basis.

- Court Clerk accepts no personal checks
- All fines must be in exact amounts
- Cash, money order, certified bank checks and credit cards are accepted
- Village court does not maintain petty cash amount in the office
- Bail and fine amounts are held at Chemung Canal Trust for Justice Boland two separate accounts
- All bank statements are reconciled monthly by Court Clerk
- Court Clerk follows the Court Clerk responsibilities as defined by NYS Court Clerk responsibilities

The findings of the person assigned to perform this review has found that tasks performed in Ms. Gregory's capacity as Court Clerk have shown her to be in compliance with all processes and procedures for the Owego Village Court.

Kim Trahan -I am aware that the money paid out for the application fee will not guarantee that the grant is going to happen and that I would lose that money, but I am willing to go forward if the Village agrees to apply for this project.
