Derek C Schmidt, 22, Owego NY, arrested for Driving While under Influence of Alcohol and Drugs (**Misd**), Driving While Intoxicated with .08% Blood Alcohol Content (**Misd**), and Unlawful Possession of Marijuana, following an investigation into a Motor Vehicle accident with rollover on Dean Street. Schmidt struck two telephone poles causing damage to the poles.

Owego Fire EMS arrived on scene and she was transported to a Hospital for further treatment (Name withheld due to HIPAA Laws).

On 04/25/17, about 3:19 PM, Owego Police Officers were dispatched to a residence on North Avenue for a reported fire. Upon Officer's arrival on scene, smoke was showing from front of the residence. Officers were able to make contact with the residents whom were evacuated along with family pets. Owego Fire Department arrived on scene and the fire was extinguished with only minor damages to the front porch area. During the incident, North Avenue traffic was impacted near Talcott Street.
