On August 17, 2017, at or about 8:51 PM, Owego Police responded to the Railroad Crossing at Main Street and John Street for a car vs. train accident. Upon investigating the incident, **Ming K Liao**, age 70, of Owego NY, drove his 2017 Subaru Forester around the closed railroad crossing gates in an attempt to cross the train tracks. **Liao's** vehicle was struck by a Norfolk Southern eastbound train. **Liao** sustained minor injuries from the impact with the train and the vehicle's airbag deployment. **Liao** was transported to the Wilson hospital for medical treatment. **Liao** was treated and released. **Liao** was issued a ticket for Failure to stop at a railroad crossing returnable to the Village of Owego Court. Owego Police was assisted at the scene by the Owego Fire Department and the Norfolk Southern Railway Police.

On August 20, 2017, the Owego Police Department investigated a report of Arson at 255 Front Street, Owego. The office house, a building used for storage, located behind Rehabilitation Support Services was intentionally set on fire causing extensive damage. The Owego Police Arrested **Brian K. Dornblaser**, age 21, 255 Front Street, Owego, for Arson in the Third degree. **Dornblaser** was arraigned in the Town of Owego Court and remanded to the Tioga County Jail in Lieu of \$20,000 bail. The Owego Police Department was assisted at the scene by the Owego Fire Department, Tioga County Fire Investigation team and the Tioga County Sheriff's Department.
