Eric Mchet Riscart, Miami FL

After a 2-month Investigation on January 6th, 2022 the Village of Owego Police Department arrested Eric Mchet Riscart, 31, for 28 counts of Possession of Forged Instruments in the 2nd degree - Class D Felonies, Possession of Burglary Tools - Class A Misdemeanor and 5 counts of Petit Larceny - Class A Misdemeanor's. Mchet had in his possession 28 fraudulent credit cards that he was using to purchase diesel fuel in large quantities which he was placing in a 400 gallon hidden compartment tank located in the rear of his pick-up truck. Mchet Riscart identified as a Cuban Citizen who entered the US through Mexico, he has ties to Miami Florida and New Jersey. Mchet Riscart was arraigned in Tioga County CAP Court before Nichols Justice Grinage, who released Mchet Riscart on his own recognizance under New York State Bail Reform. Owego Police were assisted by New York State Police, New York State Environmental Conservation Police and Vestal Police Department.
