

Selectmen's Meeting

June 14, 2023

Chairman Randy Lessard called the meeting to order at 6:35. Todd Sawyer was present. Jamie Toohey was absent from the meeting.

Todd made the motion to accept the May 24 minutes as written. Randy seconded the motion. Motion carried 2-0.

The board discussed the Five Kezars Road Stream Crossing Replacement project. A contract with Pine Tree Engineering was signed with an estimated engineering cost of \$20,000.00.

Fire Chief Adrien Morin attended the meeting to discuss with the board, road issues that the fire department has been called out to deal with by Oxford County. Todd asked Adrien to be sure that Oxford County had Jim Kidder, acting Road Commissioner, and Todd's number on file when making the road issue calls.

The board also discussed with Adrien that the employees hired to the Public Works department were to be secondary in the event the fire department were unable to respond.

Tom Fillebrown told the board that DEP had made a visit to the Transfer Station.

The board signed the World's Fair Bottle Club Registration application.

The board signed the Bicycle Coalition agreement that will take place for a rest stop at the Sandlot August 26.
