June 28, 2023

Chairman Randy Lessard called the meeting to order at 6:30 p.m. Todd Sawyer and Jamie Toohey were present.

Bids were opened for the Mill Hill Road Reconstruction Project -2023.
The bids were as follows:

Todd made the motion to accept the lower bid from Wilson Excavation. Jamie seconded the motion. Motion carried 3-0.

Ted Colburn attended the meeting and told the board of the Community Resilience Partnership site visit on July 27th 9:30-11:00. There was discussion on the next application for the Community Resilience Partnership concerning the purchase of heat pumps for the town garage, second solar systems and LED lights for the municipal building.

There was discussion on the Boston Cane requirements. CEO John Bell will research and get back to the board.

Andrew Lutwin and Margaux Babineau attended the meeting to ask permission from the board to operate their hot dog cart at the Sandlot. Randy made the motion of conditional and revocable approval to operate the hot dog stand with the town listed as additional insured and that they would attend the July 26 meeting. Todd seconded the motion 3-0. Motion carried 3-0.

April Swett discussed with board the road condition on Five Kezars. Todd explained that they are working on a temporary fix for that issue.

Todd made the motion to accept the minutes for June 16 with changes. Randy seconded the motion. Jamie abstained as she was absent from the June 16 meeting. Motion carried 2-0.

Board was given the year to date Expense and Revenue report.
